Katie Bland Lawrence was a mother of seven children, step-mother of two, substitute mother to several over the years, from her own younger brother and sisters, to neices and nephews and cousins who came to live in her home at various times, and of course to her step-grandchildren and grandchildren. She not only saw to the physical needs of the children, but to their religious training as well, and she enriched their education by helping them with homework and by providing books for them to read. In the years of my childhood, there was no public library at Apex. My mother ordered and received from the N.C. State Library a bookcase of library books. When we had read them, she would ship them back, and order more. We children really absorbed those books, and the imagery in our minds was as exciting, I am sure, as any T.V. or movie to the children of today.

Although she worked hard at home cooking, canning, cleaning, sewing, gardening, taking care of the milk and butter, and doing all the other things that farm women had to do in those days, Katie also found time to be active in community and church affairs. She worked actively with other women of the neighborhood to organize a "Betterment Association," which later became known as the "Home Demonstration Club," and was its president at least once. Katie was instrumental in bringing Saturday night movies to the Olive Chapel School House, but she was also instrumental in having them discontinued when the kisses of such people as Mary Pickford or Rudolph

Valentino became too "suggestive."

Kathy was also active in politics. She was the first woman to serve on the White Oak Precinct Committee, a position she held until about 1937, when she was succeeded by her son, Arthur C. Lawrence.

Katie was a faithful member of Olive Chapel Baptist Church. She was president of the Woman's Missionary Union for several years, and always taught a Sunday School Class until her health became bad during her last years.

As I remember her, Katie was busy every minute she was awake. Even when she sat down to rest, she would be reading or studying. She influenced many people, and left a rich legacy to all of us who knew her.

HENRY THOMAS AND MARY KATHERINE BLAND LAWRENCE FAMILY

Henry Thomas Lawrence's second marriage was to Mary Katherine "Katy" Bland. She was the oldest child of James Sextus and Isabella Cameron Bland, born April 24, 1875, and died May 11, 1944. James Sextus was the oldest son of James Bland and Catherine Lasater Bland. Isabella was a daughter of Lemuel and Isabella Cameron Cameron. Katy's father's family was from Chatham County, while her mother's family was from Harnett and Moore Counties. Katy was born in Chatham County, but lived most of her early life in Manly and Raleigh.

While she was teaching at a local one-room school, Katy became acquainted with a young widower in the neighborhood, Henry Lawrence. Henry's first wife, Deanna, had died at the birth of her third child. About two years after Deanna's death, Henry began "calling on" Katy, who had moved from Raleigh and was living with her grandmother in Chatham County along with her younger brother and sisters, following the death of their mother. Henry and Katy were married on June 18, 1899.

Her experience as a teacher and as a substitute mother to her younger brother and sisters had well prepared Katy for her new role as step-mother to Henry's two children, Roger and Clara.

It soon became apparent to Katy and to her sister Enolia, who had remained in Raleigh to continue her job in the post office that something had to be done to give their younger brother and sisters better care. They were not happy at their grandmother's home, and also they were not going to school. When she dis-

cussed this problem with Henry, he agreed that they should come and make their home with them. So he added four new rooms to the house, hitched the horse to the wagon, and went to Chatham County to bring them home. So to Henry and Katy's household were added Isabelle, Evelyn, Johnnie and Roberta Bland. Then two of Katy's young cousins, Robert and Eugene Olive, whose widowed father was working and trying to take care of six children, begged to come and live with "Uncle Henry and Aunt Katie." Without hesitation, Henry and Katy welcomed them into their home. So their household during the winter of 1900-1901 consisted of six teen-agers and two 12-year-olds.

Katy kept Clara and Roberta, the two 12-year-olds, home to help her, and the others had chores to do when they came home from school. With all the wood to be cut for six fireplaces and one cook stove, fires to be built, water to be drawn and carried from the porch to the kitchen, cows to be milked, livestock to be fed, beds to be made, and lamps to be cleaned and filled, it seems remarkable that they endured through the winter. In addition to her cooking, sewing, and helping children with their homework, Katy gave birth to her first child in February, Henry Thomas Lawrence, Jr.

Yet conversations with Clara, Roberta and Dr. Robert Olive revealed that the winter of 1900-1901 was one of the happiest of their lives. They felt that it was just one great party. Even Henry and Katy said the same thing — that it was a great year and that they never regretted their decision to accept such a big "family."

Roger left home after his good friend and step-brother Johnnie Bland died; Clara graduated from Meredith and became a teacher; Isabelle Bland married Dr. R.J. Morrison while she was teaching at Cherryville, N.C.; Evelyn Bland worked in the post office in Cheraw, South Carolina until she retired; Johnnie Bland died of typhoid fever when in his early 20s; Roberta met and married Don Hyatt while she was teaching in Murphy, N.C.; Robert Olive became a dentist in Fayetteville, and his brother Eugene became a Baptist minister.

Henry T. and Katy B. Lawrence were the parents of seven children: Henry Thomas Lawrence, Jr., Mary Lois Lawrence, Arthur Craig Lawrence, Alice Belle Lawrence, Dorothy Miriam Lawrence, Grace Evelyn Lawrence and Eleanor Katherine Lawrence.

Second murder victim of week found shot at home

The police tape surrounding the tan-and-brown mobile home on Martin Pond Road is a somber reminder of death and fear to most eastern Wake residents: two murders within two days of each other, only miles apart.

The death of longtime Wendell resident Tony Ray Cole is the second killing in eastern Wake to be investigated by the sheriff's department in the last week. Cole was found shot to death in his mobile home on Sept. 10 at 2:30 p.m., the day after Isabell Scar-

borough was found dead in her residence on Robertson Pond Road.

"(Cole's case) is being treated as a robbery/homicide," said Lt. Richard Johnson of the Wake County Sheriff's Department. "He died by gunshot."

Richardson said the department is currently following up on Cole's last whereabouts.

"There was quite a bit of blood in the room around him," said Maj. Danny Bellamy of the sheriff's department.

Cole's body was found by a friend. Authorities investigated

the crime scene, then took the body to WakeMed for an autopsy.

The Philadelphia native was raised in Wendell, but his parents, daughter, two sons, brother and sister live in Zebulon. Cole was buried in Zebulon.

Investigators have interviewed numerous people who drove down Martin Pond Road the day of the murder between 9:30 and 11:30 a.m.

Cole had been arrested several times in the county on charges including drug-, weapon-and assault-related offenses. The sheriff's department has been investi-

gating both cases because both residents lived just outside the town limits of Wendell.

Wendell Police Chief Joe Privette said anytime you have a murder in the area, people are going to worry. He added that people shouldn't hesitate to report anything they feel is suspicious.

"If you're asking in your mind, 'Should I call the police?' then you should call," Privette said. To report a crime in the town limits of Wendell, call 365-4444. Outside the town limits, call the Wake County Sheriff's Department at 856-6800.
