



working in the fields, or attending school or church. Food was not plentiful "like it is now. We had to make each penny count."


She married Willie High and had three children — two boys and one girl. Her sons now live in South Carolina and New York.

After her husband passed away, she moved to Zebulon. She swore after her first marriage she'd never marry again, but she ended up eating her words when she met Louis Bobbitt while working in tobacco. The two later married.

For most of her years in Zebulon, she has attended St. Paul No. 1. Best estimates are she has been a member for 50 years.

Isham Cyrus Sledge, Sr. was born January 19, 1846, in Nash County, the son of William Powell Sledge of Warren County and Martha L. Rosser. Isham served with the 36th NC Regiment, 2nd Artillery at Fort Fisher during the Civil War. He was taken prisoner January 15, 1865, and confined at Point Lookout, MD. He was released at the end of the War and returned to Nash County. He married Mittie Ann Dean (1855-1927), daughter of Thomas Dean and Martha Stokes, on November 30, 1881.
