



- *Rev. Johnson Olive had accepted the pastorate of Swift Creek Baptist Church for the year 1885. Rev. Olive died at his residence in Apex, North Carolina on Saturday, January 24, 1885 and is buried in the Apex Cemetery. At the time of his death, he was pastor of Swift Creek, Cary, Holly Springs, and New Bethel Churches. He never preached at Swift Creek as pastor.

- Many of the early pastors served four churches at a time preaching at each one week-end a month. The first full time pastor at Swift Creek Baptist Church was Rev. Paul Pridgen, Jr. in 1954.

- As was the custom of the times in the early years, pastors were "called" on an annual basis. The call was for the calendar year. This practice continued at Swift Creek Baptist Church until 1952. Rev. Paul West, Jr. was the last pastor to face an annual call.

- △△△ Interim pastors who have served since 1979 are Dr. James Heaton, Steve Roy, Joe Zimmerman, Donald McNair, and Gerald Richards.

- △△△ In 2004, Swift Creek Baptist Church called its first full-time Minister of Children and Youth, Mr. Christopher Dawson. Part time Ministers of Youth since 1979 include Bill Howard, Douglas Lax, Joseph Kennedy, Jr., Melissa Livengood, Patrick Smith, Tim Wiles, David Price, James Upchurch, and Christopher Dawson.

- In 2004, Swift Creek Baptist Church licensed Christopher Dawson for the ministry. △ Carlisle Franks, who grew up in the Church, was ordained to the ministry by Calvary Baptist Church in Goldsboro, NC.

There was an 1846 Land Grant of 63 1/2 A [△] ENOCH BOOKER which adjoined his own land and that of [△] Whitney U and also that of Green Beckwith [[△] GREEN BECKWITH], David Holland [[△] DAVID HENRY HOLLAND] and [△] MARK BARKER. The land on [△] HOG BED BRANCH a drain of [△] WHITE OAK CREEK

MARK BARKER also rec'd Land Grants in 1787 & 1789 NW of Holly Springs, NC and East of [△] Great White Oak Creek (AKA [△] Big White Oak Creek)

In 1780 [△] JAMES HOLLAND, SR and [△] SAMSON HOLLAND rec'd adjacent Land Grants on [△] UTLEY CREEK SE of the Barker Tracts

In the 1700's The Green Family had extensive land holdings - especially [△] SILAS GREEN and this was near the land of Whitney U.

Margot, I looked up the name Isaac Beckwith in Watson's Wake Co deed abstract book. I didn't find him. However, I did find that an "Isaac Beckworth" purchased land in Wake Co [Wake DB Q:67]. The abstract reads "William Barker Sr of Wake Co to Isaac Beckworth of same, June 30, 1798, for 15 pounds, a tract of 100 acres lying on the waters of Little White Oak Cr adjoining James Holland, Bolin Beckworth, Arthur Wood, Sampson Holland, and Etheldred Jones. Wit: William Bridges, Britain Utley". Note the adjacent property names. This tract is in the same general area as the Enoch Booker grant previously discussed. I suspect that "Isaac Beckworth" may actually be "Isaac Beckwith" with a spelling or transcription change.

△

The tract of land mentioned in the deed is also very close to the Green Family holdings. I would note the following. If Green Beckwith owned land in 1846, he had to have been at least 21 years old, and be b. before 1826. The Revolutionary War soldier you mentioned is most probably General Nathaniel Greene. He was b. 1742 and d. 1786. FYI, Green's Path passes through western Johnston Co and is shown on the 1770 John Collet map. It is believed to have been named for a preacher in the early part of the 18th century. Any of these could have been a source for the first name of Green Beckwith. Of course, it may also have been something entirely different.

△

In the 18th c. Granville grants were limited to 700 A. Grants from the State of NC, were limited to 640 A. There are only a few exceptions, e.g., prominent citizens and officials. Some larger grants were issued for Revolutionary War service in the NC military preserve, located in several parts of present day Tennessee. All that said, an individual could obtain multiple grants and could make other purchases from neighbors. This allowed him to accumulate large holdings. For example, the Etheldred Jones mentioned in the above grant accumulated some 12,000 A in southern Wake Co from some 20+ grants. Also, I've just finished a piece of work on the Mark Myatt holdings, also in southern Wake Co. Some 20+ smaller grants were aggregated into a single 7,000+ A tract, which was then divided amongst his six children.

7. WESLEY FLOWERS MILLS, son of Shadrach Mills and Patsy Wilson, was born ca 1831 in Wake Co., NC, and died 19___. He married 29 Jul 1851 Delaney Harwood (b ca 1830, d aft 1898), daughter of John Harwood. They were married by JP Young Booker in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was Oliver Mills.

In 1853 and 1858, Wesley was involved in a few court cases. For more info see ch. COURT DATES ETCHED IN TIME (May 1853-pg. 517), (Aug 1853-pg. 532), and (May 1858-pg. 503).

Wesley served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. For info see ch. GRANDSONS OF NAAMAN MILLS: SOLDIERS IN THE CIVIL WAR.

Wesley was a farmer. They resided in Chatham Co, NC (Grove P.O.) on FC/1860; (Pittsboro P.O.) on FC/1870; and (Williams Twp.) on FC/1880. In 1870, Wesley owned real estate valued at \$200 and a personal estate valued at \$400.

In Wesley's compiled military service record from the Civil War, he is described as being 6 feet, 3 3/4 inches tall. On 26 Jun 1901, he applied for a soldier's pension from the State of NC, for wounds that he had received during the Civil War. His application was approved.
