After voting not to call Norris for another year, in that same meeting the church called J. N. Booth. Booth was called in a manner which few modern ministers would consider. According to the minutes, "Bro. H. N. Parker moved that we now go into an election for Pastor. Three brethren were voted for. Bro. Booth got the majority of votes and his election was made unanimous to take effect the 1st Sunday in January. Bro. Robert Yates was requested to notify him of his election." Booth apparently was given an indefinite call, for there is no reference in the minutes to another call at the end of 1888. For nearly two years his name appears in the minutes as "Moderator" and as "Pastor," but there is no other reference to his work. At the regular church conference in November, 1889, perhaps in a move to avoid having the church take the initiative in terminating the relationship, he "moved that he would resign his place if it was acceptable [sic], and it was accepted." A committee was then appointed "to confer with the ministers to see who will accept," and a called meeting of the church was set for the third Sunday in November "to find out who we will call." Interestingly enough, the minutes close with the usual formula: "Union of the church inquired into; all in peace."

CHAPTER 1 - 1877-1902

Booth's gang was not at full strength on April 14. Rebel courier John Surratt was in Elmira, New York, and it was impossible to command his return on a few hours' notice. Surratt had been away since March 25, the day he left for Richmond. The Confederacy's days were numbered, but Secretary of State Judah Benjamin had a final mission for the courier: Go North once more, pass undetected through Union territory, cross the border into Canada, and deliver dispatches to General Edwin Gray Lee, a cousin of Robert E. Lee, and head of Confederate Secret Service operations in Montreal. Surratt left Richmond on March 31 and on April 6 checked in at St. Lawrence Hall, unofficial headquarters of the South's covert operations there. Lee gave Surratt another mission: Go to New York to spy on the Union's prisoner-of-war camp at Elmira, in preparation for a raid to break out the Confederate soldiers languishing there. Surratt arrived in Elmira on April 13 and devoted the next two days to spying and shopping. He drew detailed sketches of the prison, counted the guards, tallied their small arms and cannon, and estimated the number of prisoners. He also made time for a personal mission. Surratt, a fastidious dresser—although not in the same league as Booth—visited clothiers in search of suits and shirts. On April 14, while Booth was planning the assassination, Surratt's most pressing concern was finding some fresh, white shirts to spruce up his wardrobe.

Funeral services set for Jennings Booth

William Jennings Booth, Sr., 79, one of the Apex area's most prominent citizens, died Monday night at N.C. Memorial Hospital in Chapel Hill as a result of long-standing illness.

Funeral services will be held Thursday at 2 p.m. at Salem Baptist Church, and burial will be at the Salem Baptist Church cemetery.

Booth, a life-long resident of Wake County, was a former Wake County Commissioner, and former member of the Wake County Hospital System's Board of Directors.

Booth founded Apex Lumber Company in 1928, and built the business into one of the largest enterprises in the Apex area. He remained active in the business despite his recent illnesses.

Booth served on the Wake County Commission from December, 1962 through

December, 1974. He also served on the Wake Hospital Board from 1962 until 1974.

Booth was a former president of the Apex Area Chamber of Commerce, and was a member of the Apex Development Corporation which was instrumental in recruiting the Apex area's first industry, Apex Manufacturing Company, in the early 1960's.

He served as president of the C.C. Jones Memorial Park Association, and had 47 years perfect attendance at the Apex Lions Club, where he also was a past president. Recently the club honored Booth with the Melvin Jones Award, one of the highest

honors the club can bestow on a member.

Booth also was a member of The Fidelity Bank board of directors, and a Trustee of Wake Technical College. He also was a trustee of the Southeastern Lumberman's Insurance Fund, as well as a member of the Southeastern Lumber Manufacturer's Association, a group he was active in since its beginning.

Booth was a life-long member of Salem Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon.

Because of his service to the hospital system, one of the patient wings at Wake Medical Center in Raleigh was named

Booth Hall in his honor.

Booth is survived by his wife Addie Capps Booth, a resident at Kinton's Nursing Home in Fuquay-Varina; a son, William J. Booth, Jr., of Apex; a daughter, Mrs. Margaret B. Perry of Apex; four brothers; Edward Booth of Durham, N.C.; Leon Booth of Durham, Bernie Booth of Ft. Myers, Florida; and Worth Booth of Mars Hill, N.C.; a sister, Hazel Hummer of Richmond, Virginia; and five grand-children.

The family will receive visitors tonight (Wednesday) at Apex Funeral Home from 7 to 9 p.m.

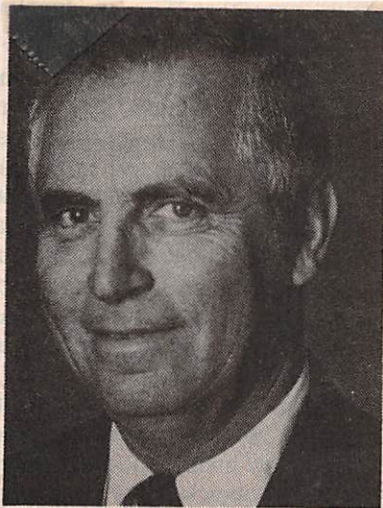
