Produce and Truck Farming. Fruits, vegetables, and grains were produced throughout the county for home use, but poor roads and inadequate marketing facilities deterred most would-be produce and truck farmers. Although in Raleigh watermelons were bringing \$150 to \$300 an acre in 1883 (compared to cotton's \$10) few local farmers and businessmen ventured into that lucrative market until the early twentieth century. In 1891 Job P. Wyatt was the only melon grower listed in the Raleigh area. T. A. Bowen, James Dodd, and W. C. and A. B. Stronach were the only truck farmers found around Raleigh that year, while Dr. William J. Hawkins was the sole orange grower.⁸² Δ
