Page 7 On July 20, 1763, Timothy Ryal Medlin sold to William Cade 100 acres on the north side of the Little River in Johnston County.

In 1763, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) was included on a list of insolvents in Granville County.

In 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) (Madlen) (Meddelon), planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to John Franklin on north side of Crooked Creek in Bute County adjoining William Maynard and Julius Alford, witnessed by William Maynard, James Bolton, and Julius Alford.

Bute County, which bordered Virginia, was formed from Granville County in 1764 and was named after John Stewart, Earl of Bute, who was the first Lord of Treasury under King George III. Bute County occupied the part of Granville County formerly known as St. John's Parish. The Medlin families slowly migrated from southeastern Bute (later Franklin) County down into the heartland of North Carolina.

On August 15, 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) purchased 100 acres of land in Johnston County on the south side of Moccasin (Mockerson) Creek.

In 1766, William Owen Medlin (Sr.), Joseph Medlin, Timothy Ryal Medlin, and William (Owen) Medlin (Jr.) were listed as taxpayers in Bute County.

On April 25, 1767, John Medlin (Madlens) received a land grant from Governor William Tryon for 100 acres on Rich Land Creek, joining Joseph Dunn, Weirs line, and Henry Atkinson in the section of old Cumberland County that was later partitioned off in 1784 as Moore County.

Page 8 On February 15, 1768, Timothy Ryal (Royal) Medlin, planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to Andrew (Drury) Cade in Johnston County on the north side of the Little River and a fork of Julises Branch, adjacent to land owned by Drewry Cade, witnessed by James Batten and Joshua Mize.

On June 3, 1768, in Bute County, 380 acres were sold to John Young at the sale of the estate of John Medlin (Modglin), deceased, held by Julius Nichols, late sheriff, as recorded in August 1768 court by deputy sheriff William Moore. Joseph Wright was listed among the buyers.

On February 6, 1769, William Owen (Oen) Medlin (Meddelen), planter in Johnston County, sold 100 acres on the south side of Moccasin Creek adjacent to Elisha Strickland in Johnston County to Demsey Sumner, witnessed by James Bolton, Julius Johnson and Drury Cade.

In February 1769 in Johnston County Court, William Owen (Oen) Medlin proved a deed from Sampson Bracewell and Christian Bracewell to Pettipool Massey. Needham Bryan was present and was appointed a justice for Johnston County by commission from the governor.

On March 10, 1769, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) bought 177 acres of land in Bute County on the south side of Crooked Creek from Julius Johnson, witnessed by James Alford, Robert Chamblee, and James Strickland.

On March 20, 1769, John Medlin sold to Joseph Dunn the 100 acres of land granted on Richland Creek in old Cumberland County (later Moore County).

Dear Mr. Enterprise,

I read in the Atlanta Constitution where you publish the "Upchurch Bulletin" including descendants of Michael Upchurch. I recently discovered the maiden name of my Great-G-G-Grandmother Rowena Branam (Branham, Brannon) to be Rowena Upchurch. She and my G-G-G-Grandfather, Kinion Branam, were married in Hancock County, Georgia on February 10, 1831.

Other references to Upchurch I have found is a Clayborn Upchurch, Hancock Co., in the 1830 Ga. Census, and a marriage between Abner Upchurch and Lucinda Upchurch on January 27, 1832, Hancock County.

Having only known for a couple of weeks of the Upchurch name being in my family tree, I have not had the time to research the Upchurch any further than mentioned above. I would appreciate any information that you may have on the Upchurch family in Georgia, or any connection they had with the Michael Upchurch of VA.

My connection to the Upchurch family, as mentioned above, is through Rowena Upchurch who married Kinion Branam in 1831. They had 9 children, (4 males, 5 females), and lived in Putnam County, GA until their deaths in the 1870's. One of their sons was Wiley Branam married Martha A.J. Fitts in 1861 and they had 9 children. One of their sons was Walter J. Branam who moved from Putnam County to Dodge Co. and married Lena E. Smith in 1895. Walter and Lena had 5 children, the oldest daughter being Eudell, my Grandmother. Eudell married James E. Bracewell and their oldest son, Justin, is my father. My name is Ronald Bracewell, Sr. I have three children and am an Asst. Professor of Physical Science at Middle Georgia College in Cochran, Georgia.

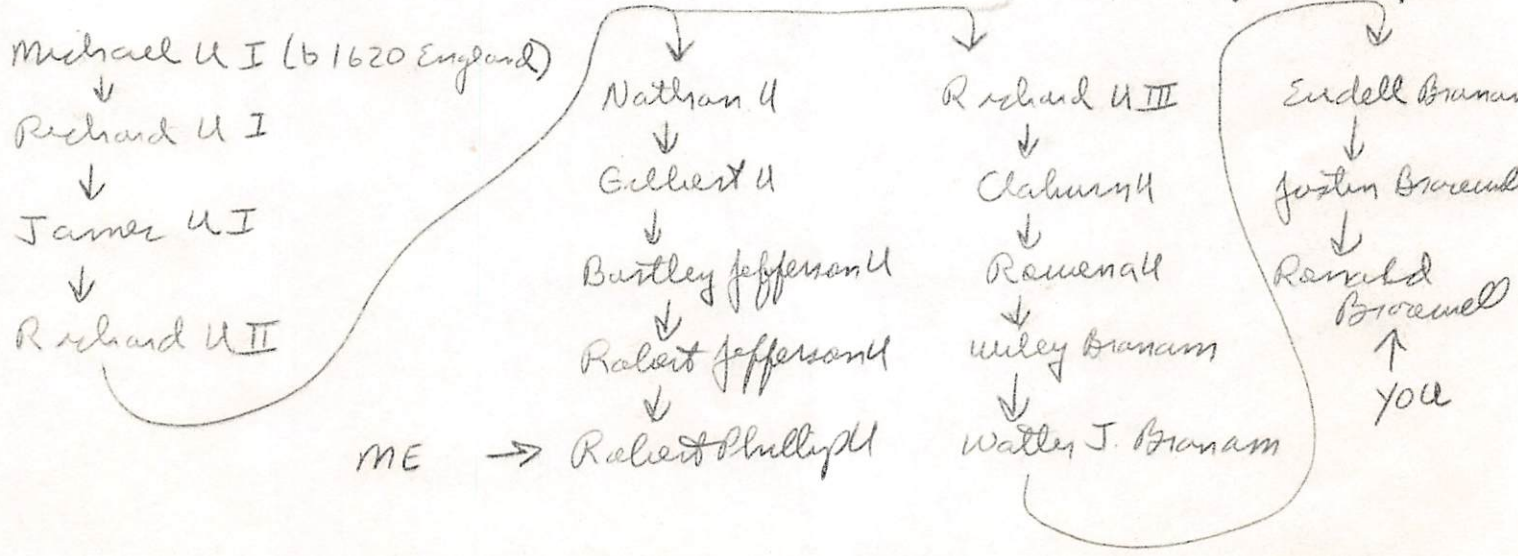

I have about 15,000 names of Upchurch and Upchurch relatives in my files and under KENON BRANON I have the following:

"Kenon Branon md 10 FEB 1831 in Hancock Co, GA  
Reena U b. 1814. Reena was the daughter of  
Clahurn U who moved from Franklin Co, NC  
to GA in 1822." From this our relationship develops:



I was your greatgrandfather, Walter J. Branam, and I am 4th cousin while you and I are 4th cousins 3 times removed!

I will be happy to send you copies of outlines I have for Calum U. Information is still mounting on Calum's descendants and I am publishing this in Upchurch Bulletin as fast as possible. The letter from you is wonderful as it gives a window on the descendants of Reena (Revena) U. Could you send me an outline of all the descendants of Revena U and Kinon Branam. I will be happy to Xerox and return originals if you prefer.

The Clayborn U mentioned by you has to be Calum U.

Re the Alnes U and Lucinda U - Lucinda U was a dau of Calum U and hence your G-G-G Aunt. Alnes U was Alnes Frank Upchurch (an U and an U) but I don't yet know his father.

- △ Blalie Daniel on Dec 18 or 28, 1899 in Dodge Co. I believe this may be the same person.



Page 7 On July 20, 1763, Timothy Ryal Medlin sold to William Cade 100 acres on the north side of the Little River in Johnston County.

In 1763, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) was included on a list of insolvents in Granville County.

In 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) (Madlen) (Meddelon), planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to John Franklin on north side of Crooked Creek in Bute County adjoining William Maynard and Julius Alford, witnessed by William Maynard, James Bolton, and Julius Alford.

Bute County, which bordered Virginia, was formed from Granville County in 1764 and was named after John Stewart, Earl of Bute, who was the first Lord of Treasury under King George III. Bute County occupied the part of Granville County formerly known as St. John's Parish. The Medlin families slowly migrated from southeastern Bute (later Franklin) County down into the heartland of North Carolina.

On August 15, 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) purchased 100 acres of land in Johnston County on the south side of Moccasin (Mockerson) Creek.

In 1766, William Owen Medlin (Sr.), Joseph Medlin, Timothy Ryal Medlin, and William (Owen) Medlin (Jr.) were listed as taxpayers in Bute County.

On April 25, 1767, John Medlin (Madlens) received a land grant from Governor William Tryon for 100 acres on Rich Land Creek, joining Joseph Dunn, Weirs line, and Henry Atkinson in the section of old Cumberland County that was later partitioned off in 1784 as Moore County.

Page 8 On February 15, 1768, Timothy Ryal (Royal) Medlin, planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to Andrew (Drury) Cade in Johnston County on the north side of the Little River and a fork of Julises Branch, adjacent to land owned by Drewry Cade, witnessed by James Batten and Joshua Mize.

On June 3, 1768, in Bute County, 380 acres were sold to John Young at the sale of the estate of John Medlin (Modglin), deceased, held by Julius Nichols, late sheriff, as recorded in August 1768 court by deputy sheriff William Moore. Joseph Wright was listed among the buyers.

On February 6, 1769, William Owen (Oen) Medlin (Meddelen), planter in Johnston County, sold 100 acres on the south side of Moccasin Creek adjacent to Elisha Strickland in Johnston County to Demsey Sumner, witnessed by James Bolton, Julius Johnson and Drury Cade.

In February 1769 in Johnston County Court, William Owen (Oen) Medlin proved a deed from Sampson Bracwell and Christian Bracwell to Pettipool Massey. Needham Bryan was present and was appointed a justice for Johnston County by commission from the governor.

On March 10, 1769, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) bought 177 acres of land in Bute County on the south side of Crooked Creek from Julius Johnson, witnessed by James Alford, Robert Chamblee, and James Strickland.

On March 20, 1769, John Medlin sold to Joseph Dunn the 100 acres of land granted on Richland Creek in old Cumberland County (later Moore County).
