(no number) Mary (Polly) Upchurch, 6th child of Samuel and Mary Ellen Upchurch, married 5 Apr 1820 (Gallatin Co, IL) **Nathan Bramlet**. They lived in Saline Co, IL until in the 1850s they moved to Pope Co, IL where Nathan died circa 1858 as his will was entered for probate on 3 Jan 1859. Mary, his wife, was named executor (Will Book 1, page 56). Some of the children were already married when the family moved to Pope Co and possibly remained in Saline Co. According to the <u>Pioneer Family – Bramlet</u> written by Meeks Haley Bramlet, Nathan and Mary had fourteen children. Eleven have been found. (29, Page 219)

When Warner L Bramlet died 5 Aug 1847 he had land investments with his father, Nathan Bramlet, and his Uncle Coleman B Bramlet. (29, Page 219)

Nathan Bramlet born 1799 (SC) [son of Reuben and Elizabeth (Brown) Bramlet] married 5 Apr 1820 (Gallatin Co, IL) **Mary Upchurch** (Polly) born 8 Aug 1802 (TN) died <1870. Elizabeth Brown was from KY. Nathan had a brother Coleman Brown Bramlet who married Susannah Upchurch, a sister of Mary (Polly) Upchurch.

 Nathan Bramlet died Saline Co, IL married Saline Co, IL Mary Rebecca Upchurch "Polly" born 1801 (TN) died Saline Co, IL.
- (1) Mary (Polly) Upchurch, (daughter of Samuel Upchurch, Head of John/Samuel Upchurch Sub-clan) born 8 Aug 1820 (TN) married 5 Apr 1820 Nathan Bramlet who died possibly in 1858 as his estate was entered for probate in the Saline County Court in Jan 1859. Mary and Nathan lived in Saline Co, IL in the vicinity of other Upchurch families in what is known as the Bramlet Settlement until in the 1850s when they moved to Pope Co, IL. Nathan Bramlet, born 3 Feb 1779 in Caldwell Co, KY died circa 1858 Pope Co was the son of Reuben and Elizabeth (Brown) Bramlet of VA. They migrated to IL via SC and KY. The Bramlets and Upchurches are both considered to be pioneers of Saline Co, IL. According to the Pioneer Family Bramlet written by Meeks Haley Bramlet, Nathan and Polly Bramlet had fourteen children but only 12 have been identified. Nathan Bramlet made his will on 24 Nov 1858 and it was entered for probate 3 Jan 1850 in Saline Co, IL (Will Book I-56). Information on the children is from Census records, marriage records, probates and interviews with some of the descendants." (29, Page 162)
