Bill Branom Passes Away

James W. (Bill) Branom was born January 4, 1916 West of Lehigh, Ok, and died February 22, 1989 at Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 73.

Funeral services were held at the Lehigh Baptist Church Saturday, February 25, 1989 at 11:00 a.m. Burial was in the Lehigh Cemetery with Epperson Funeral service in charge.

Bill was the son of James Washington and Mary Serena Farmer Branom.

Bill attended school at Friendship and Lehigh where he graduated from High School. He entered the C.C.C. then volunteered for Army service and served under General George Patton until the end of World War II.

He married Anna Nelson Scruggs in 1947. They made their home in California where both worked in Defense work. His wife, Anna, died in November of 1984. After her death, Bill retired and moved back to this vicinity. He lived in Lehigh 2 years and was living in Atoka at the time of his death.

Always active in church work, Bill especially enjoyed singing and sang with a group of Sr. Citizens of Atoka. They often visited Nursing Homes of the Area.

Survivors are: one daughter, Marjorie Santi of Oklahoma City; two stepsons, John David of Fullerton, California and Rhonald Scruggs of San Diego, California; one sister, Okla Northcutt, Tulsa, Oklahoma; two brothers, Sherman Branom of Lehigh, and John Quenton Branom of Wichita, Kansas; eleven grandchildren; five great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews and a host of friends.

Truly, Bill was a kind, gentle Christian man who loved his family and the Lord dearly. He will be missed greatly.

Sherman Bland Branom, b. 29 Mar., 1905, in Sherman, Texas (and

named for the town) was the fourth child in a family of eight. (See Branom and Dobson Families)

Ruby Elizabeth Dobson, b. 5 Mar., 1909, Copeville, Tx., became the bride of Sherman, 31 Dec., 1929, at Durant, Ok.. I was a senior in high school, so I stayed in school and graduated in May, 1930, at Lehigh.

Sherm worked in the oil field in Okla. City, seven days a week, 12 hours a day and made \$126.00 a month. We established our first home, the company (I.T.I.O., which became Cities Service) let us have a lot and we built our home. There were nine young married couples in the Handl Camp and we became a close-knit group. Have been getting together for annual picnics the first Sunday in June since.

As both of us grew up on the farm we didn't mind the long hours. But oil prices dropped to 40¢ a barrel and not worth producing. Gov. Bill Murray called out the National Guard and closed down the field. Out of a job, we sold our house and moved back to Lehigh. Sherm got a job, helping F. L. Bowers run the thrasher. Took \$2.00 a day pay in grain--outs and wheat 15¢ a bushel and in the fall corn 15¢ a bushel. We bought ten cows, milked and sold raw milk, then raised a lot of hogs.

On the 3rd day of June, 1932, our son Billy Joe (B. J.) was born. He was a joy and delight to all our families.

Then the oil company called Sherm to come back to work July 1, 1932. Sherm sold 31 Duroc Jersey hogs for \$1.00 each and the poor feller who bought them lost money. Family members looked after our cows and we moved back to Okla. City.

On 4th day of May, 1938, Sheren came to live with us and has been a treasure since.

The oil field work meant changing hours monthly as Sherm was

a pumper now and he didn't like all the changing. Most of all he had Coal County soil under his finger nails and hard as farming was and as little pay, he longed for a plot of land. So we scrimped, saved and bought our first 60 acres in 1937. The place where we now live and have owned since 1940 ^{9700.} sold for \$1 an acre before we married. ^{4000 3300.} I kidded him and told him we might afford it. He said, "No, it's all alcali plots and wouldn't sprout peas." Well, he's made it even grow alfalfa and peas. By soil building practices, planting peas broadcast and turning them under as a green manure crop (he became known as the black eyed peas man). He would let people come gather all they wanted before plowing them under. People even came from neighboring counties. He built twin ponds (stocked with fish) on hillside from barn, house and garden. He put in water lines from pond and we can irrigate and raise anything that will grow in the climate. Anyone can, with water and TLC. We moved back to the farm May 4, 1942.

The best crop we've ever grown has been our children. Both attended Friendship school, with me as their teacher for five years. Both graduated from Coalgate, Bill in 1950 and Sherena in 1955.

Four years later Bill graduated from O.S.U., Stillwater, Ok. Sherena attended E.C.U. one year, majoring in music. She came home, "said" I'm changing. I got a job at Sugg Clinic to be a technician."

Anne M. Moore, b. 25 Aug., 1935, Duncan, Ok., married our Bill 20 June, 1954. They have given us two lovely granddaughters, Deborah Lynn, b. 2 May, 1955, Columbus, Ga., and Stephanie Kay, b. 9 Aug., 1959, Sparta, Wi. She is now Mrs. Martin Wyant, Dallas, Tx.

When we moved back to the farm we tore down two old houses and built our home with a saw, hammer, main strength and awkwardness. Not much to look at, but warm shelter where love abides.

The opportunity to teach came as people were moving to defense work. I enrolled at E.C.U., Ada, and became a war emergency teacher for five years.

Then near tragedy--I had to spend six weeks in a cancer clinic in 1949. It took a while to recover but I was able to go to work as a social worker in 1957 and worked for 17 years. I met and worked with and for so many wonderful people.

Sherm and I have always been active in community affairs, the Church of Christ, and both served on all sorts of boards and projects. Sherm has been a director in Soil Conservation for over 30 years, as well as S.O.D.A., F.H.A., Polled Herefords and Progressive Polled Herefords; me, "Polletts" for 25 years. We've gone on bus tours to ranches all over the state and tours have visited us five times. I have been in Eastern Star for 30 years, Past Worthy Matron, Lamel Study Club, Democratic Club. Extension Club ranks high as "Best On the Job Training" active in Friendship H.M. since we married and lived in Coal County since 1911 except while Sherm worked in the

oil field.

Thankful daily for all Life's Blessings, this is our 56th year together.
