Smith of the County of Grimes and State aforesaid our true and lawful attorney for us and in our names to demand, sue for and recover from Buckner Ray, administrator of the estate of Jesse Gill, deceased, and from all other persons indebted to us, any and all sums of money, debts, claims and demands due us from said estate, and to give, execute and deliver in our names sufficient receipts or acquit?? therefore and to adjust, settle or compound all debts or demands to us from said estate and if necessary to institute proper and necessary suits for the recovery thereof and the same to pursue to final judgment and execution and an attorney or attorneys under him for all or any of the purposes aforesaid to make and substitute and ? at pleasure to revoke. And we do hereby notify, allow and confirm all and whatsoever our said attorney shall do or cause to be done in and about the premises aforesaid by virtue of the presents, as fully as if we were personally present and we do hereby revoke any and all powers of attorney executed, by us heretofore, given by us for the purposes herein before mentioned.

The condition of which above bond is such that whereas the said boundee Nancy Brice has made application to the said Buckner Ray administrator aforesaid, for her distributive share of the estate of Jesse Gill deceased, claiming the same as only heir at law and next of kin of Mahala Laws deceased, and whereas the said Buckner Ray administrator aforesaid has paid over to James Y. Smith the attorney in fact of the said Nancy Brice and her husband (rest of document missing)

NOTE: Note that the mother of Nancy P. Laws is deceased and that the J. S. Laws mentioned is presumably the husband of the deceased AKA James Laws and that the deceased name is styled as MAHALA GILL.

There is an abstract of a will in An Abstract of North Carolina Wills 1760 to 1800, by Olds, for Nathaniel Perry, in Franklin County, but it gives only the date of 1790, with Ephraim as the heir. Abstracts seldom tell much. The Georgians, by J. H. Austin, mentions Nathaniel Perry's LWT dtd 1790 Franklin Co., NC, names issue: Ephraim, Drury and Sarah.

We know the name of Nathaniel's wife by the following notice of a sale: William Green, Esquire, Sheriff of Franklin Co., to Thomas Arendell, 17 February 1794, at public sale for 21/10 - a tract of 262 acres sold as the lands of Rebekah Perry, deceased, now in the hands of Ephraim Perry and Drury Perry, her heirs, whereon she formerly lived lying on the south side of Crooked Creek and bounded by the lands of Thomas Arendell, Wm. Sanders, Benjamin Robinson, Nathaniel Perry, and Drury Perry. Wit: Thos. Brickell, Jordan Hill.

The Nathaniel Perry mentioned in the above, is said to have been old Nathaniel's grandson, son of Drury Perry.

There is another mention of Rebecca elsewhere, a doctor trying to collect for treating Rebecca before she died, which is why we think 1789 is close to the year of her death.

Mrs. Hodges found evidence there was a daughter Mary, wife of James Sanders, in an estate settlement at the archives. Mary pre-deceased her father.

The American Colonies were organized into militia districts for defense, for no regular army existed to protect settlers. When they were threatened, the colonists formed militia companies (trained Bands) for temporary service. There was no central organization.

In 1754 we find Nathaniel Perry, Private, along with four of his brothers, on the muster roll of a regiment under the command of Col. William Eaton, in Granville County, North Carolina, Capt. Osborn Jeffrey's Company. This was the French and Indian War (1754-63) period.

We find Nathaniel listed as a taxpayer, Granville Co., NC in 1755 along with brothers John, William, Francis, Jeremiah & Joshua. John was the only one listed as having a black poll of one negro.

In 1757, Brunswick County, Virginia, we found where Nathaniel Perry of Granville Co., NC sells land on the south side of Meherrin River and Meherrin Parish, for 45 pds to Wm. Parham of Brunswick Co., VA. Wit: James Parham and Absalom Atkinson.
