 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died December 15, 1862, in hospital at Richmond, Virginia.
- △ BRINKLEY, WILLIAM A., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 15, 1862, for the war. Reported on company muster rolls as absent sick from September 5, 1862, through May 15, 1861. Absent without leave from that date until furloughed by the Medical Examining Board on August 15, 1864. Absent on furlough from that date through December, 1864.
- △ BRITT, ALEXANDER A., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until wounded at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, on July 2, 1863. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, July 19, 1863, with "gunshot wound left hand." Reported as absent wounded through August, 1863. Present or accounted for until October 28, 1864, when he is reported as absent without leave. Absent without leave from that date through December, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Raleigh on January 31, 1865, and returned to duty on February 14, 1865. Captured at Burkeville, Virginia, April 6, 1865. Confined at Newport News, Virginia, where he died June 26, 1865.
- △ ★ BUNN, DALLAS, Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, July 15, 1862, for the war. Absent sick from August 27, 1862, through February, 1863. Reported as absent without leave on the August, 1863, muster roll. Shot for desertion on September 5, 1863.
- △ BUNN, GEORGE A., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 15, 1862, for the war. Reported as absent sick from August 27, 1862, through February, 1863. Present or accounted for until captured at Strasburg, Virginia, on October 19, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and transferred to Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, for exchange on March 17, 1865.
- △ ★ BUNN, JAMES D., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at Chancellorsville, Virginia, on May 3, 1863, and paroled the next day. Present or accounted for until reported on the August 11-31, 1863, muster roll as absent without leave. Shot for desertion on September 5, 1863.
- △ BUNN, WESLEY, Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 33, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862, and paroled October 5, 1862. Requested not to be exchanged and was permitted to "proceed to and remain in any of the loyal states."
- △ ★ DEAL, JAMES M., Private
 Resided in Duplin County where he enlisted at age 35, February 1, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured near Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 10, 1864. Returned on October 14, 1864, to Point Lookout, where he was paroled for exchange October 29, 1864. Reported as absent prisoner through December, 1864.
- △ ELLIS, WILLIAM H., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 35, July 15, 1862, for the war. Reported as absent sick from September 5, 1862, until his death on April 14, 1863, at Richmond, Virginia, of "pneumonia."
- △ FERRELL, CORDA B., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Company muster roll for July 14-October 31, 1862, reports that he was absent without leave. Reported as being absent in arrest from that date until he "deserted brigade guard November 8, 1863." Prisoner of war records state that he was captured November 9, 1863, at Culpeper, Virginia, and confined at Old Capitol Prison, Washington, D.C. Released at Old Capitol Prison after taking the Oath of Allegiance on March 15, 1864, and was sent to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- △ HERRING, HENRY H., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 33, July 15, 1862, for the war. Muster rolls state that he was left sick at Antietam, Maryland, on September 13, 1862, and died September 18, 1862.
- △ HOLMES, JAMES D., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died December 15, 1862, at Staunton, Virginia.
- △ HUBBARD, MARK T., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until he died at Guinea Station, Virginia, March 28, 1863.
- △ JOHNSTON, JESSE V., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 32, July 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 2-3, 1863. Captured in "Western Virginia" on July 30, 1863, and took the Oath of Allegiance.

 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 28, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until reported as "missing from line of battle at Fredericksburg, Virginia, December 15, 1862."

 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 21, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died at Strasburg, Virginia, December 1, 1862.

 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Absent sick from August 27, 1862, through December, 1864.
- △ SCARBORO, GEORGE D., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 20, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died at Richmond, Virginia, September 10, 1862, of "measles."
- △ WATKINS, DANIEL, Private



- *Rev. Johnson Olive had accepted the pastorate of Swift Creek Baptist Church for the year 1885. Rev. Olive died at his residence in Apex, North Carolina on Saturday, January 24, 1885 and is buried in the Apex Cemetery. At the time of his death, he was pastor of Swift Creek, Cary, Holly Springs, and New Bethel Churches. He never preached at Swift Creek as pastor.

- Many of the early pastors served four churches at a time preaching at each one week-end a month. The first full time pastor at Swift Creek Baptist Church was Rev. Paul Pridgen, Jr. in 1954.

- As was the custom of the times in the early years, pastors were "called" on an annual basis. The call was for the calendar year. This practice continued at Swift Creek Baptist Church until 1952. Rev. Paul West, Jr. was the last pastor to face an annual call.

- △△△ Interim pastors who have served since 1979 are Dr. James Heaton, Steve Roy, Joe Zimmerman, Donald McNair, and Gerald Richards.

- △△ Youth, Mr. Christopher Dawson. Part time Ministers of Youth since 1979 include Bill Howard, Douglas Lax, Joseph Kennedy, Jr., Melissa Livengood, Patrick Smith, Tim Wiles, David Price, James Upchurch, and Christopher Dawson.

- In 2004, Swift Creek Baptist Church licensed Christopher Dawson for the ministry. △ Carlisle Franks, who grew up in the Church, was ordained to the ministry by Calvary Baptist Church in Goldsboro, NC.

△ The vestibule and belfry were added when the East Wing was built in 1919. Mr. Cary B. Jones gave the bell which yet today resides in the belfry.

Cold Harbor, Virginia, 31 May-7 June 1864, and died

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.
