**XID – 68**

(Also known as Britain, Britton, Briton)

**Commentary:** Britton Upchurch I, was born about 1787 in Dunn Township, Franklin County, NC. He was the son of Richard Upchurch III, head of Upchurch clan # 4. He married Elizabeth Massey in 1808. He was a beneficiary of his father's estate that was settled in 1818. He moved to Gwinnet County, Georgia about 1823. There he later received land grants from Cherokee Lands. His Biofile is rich in records showing his presence in both NC and Georgia.

At least part of property was near Moccasin Creek in Franklin Co, NC. Other purchasers of the 293 ¾ acre property – Jubal, Eaton (Joseph Norris's son-in-law), Clabourne (Claburn) Upchurch.

[Note: My records show a Harvel Upchurch but not a Harold Upchurch – There may two such individuals or only one. Also my records do not show a daughter Nancy Upchurch. See Item 9H. It is possible that Rachel's "Nancy" (10C) is the wife of Harrison Upchurch and not the daughter of Britton Upchurch – RPU]

Britain Upchurch had 3 sons. Nancy Upchurch was his daughter -in-law and the wife of Harrison Upchurch, In the 1840 census it does appear he had a daughter. It listed 2 females one 50 – 60 (his wife Elizabeth) and one 20 – 30 which could have been a daughter. I listed Britton's son as Harold but it probably is Harvel. Census records were hard to read. Britton's wife Elizabeth died 1850 in Gwinnett Co, GA.

The heirs on 25 Feb 1814 sold the land to Benjamin Bunn of Wake Co, NC (41, Page 118).

**Britton Upchurch, I** was given a Cherokee Land Grant (Lot 572, 1<sup>st</sup> District, 4<sup>th</sup> Section in Gwinnett Co, GA – per History of Gwinnett Co – Vol. 1, page 158) and moved his family to GA sometime after 1823. He and Elizabeth Massey had three sons and possibly a daughter. Two of the sons died as a result of the Civil War.

28 Apr 1815 – **Britton Upchurch** being deposed before Thomas Dunn, J. P. – reports – Sep 1 & 14. **Britton Upchurch** was with Jesse Averit at General Muster in Louisburg, NC & it was established that Jesse Averit was to take a tour of duty in place of Burkley Upchurch in Norfolk, VA. Jesse Averit stated if he did not return his property was to go to Williams Owens and his wife Temperance & that old Baker was to get nothing.

Also: 5 May 1815 – Elizabeth Alford deposed before Thomas Bunn, J. P. says Jesse Averit told her his property should go to Temperance Owens.

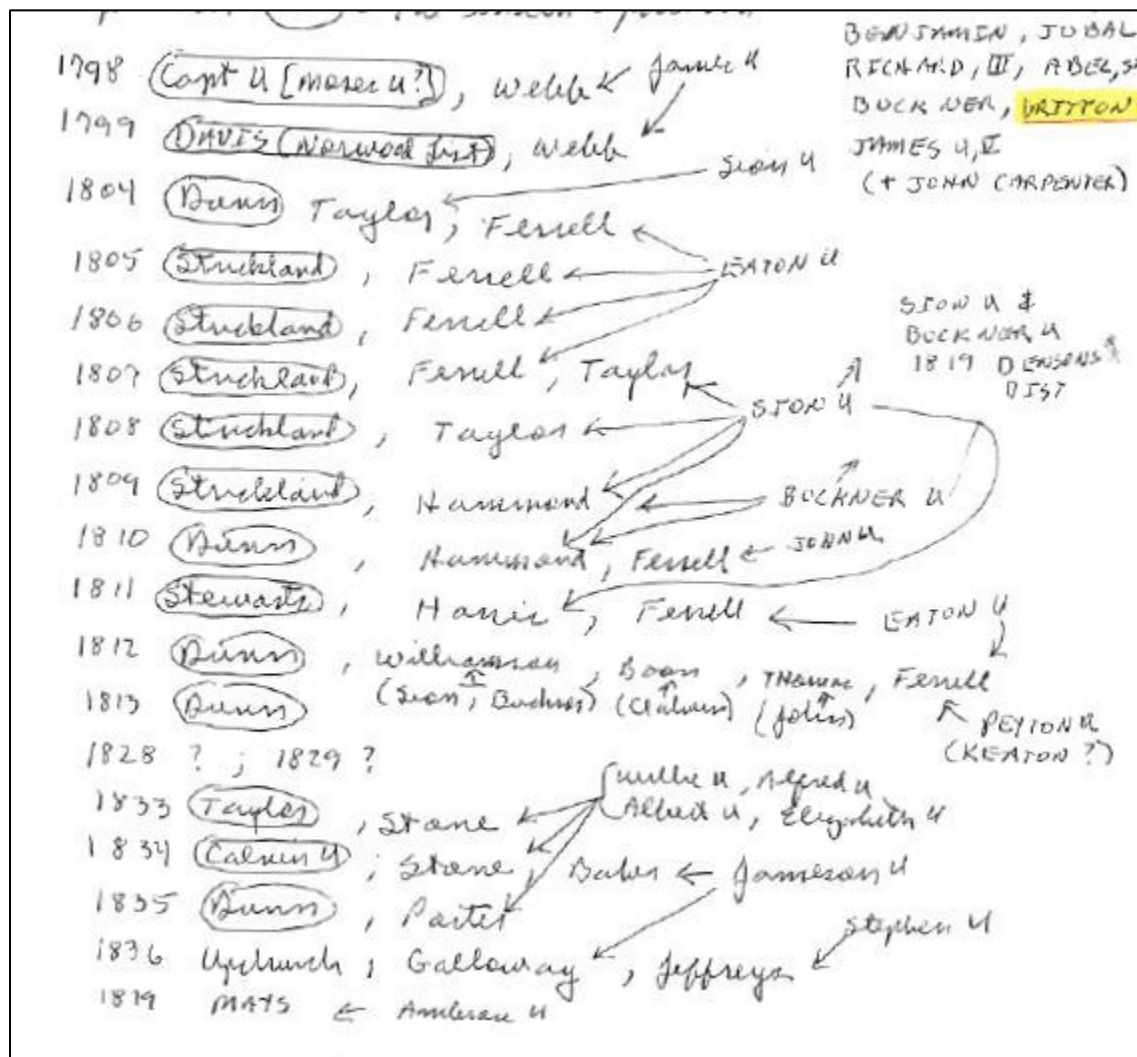

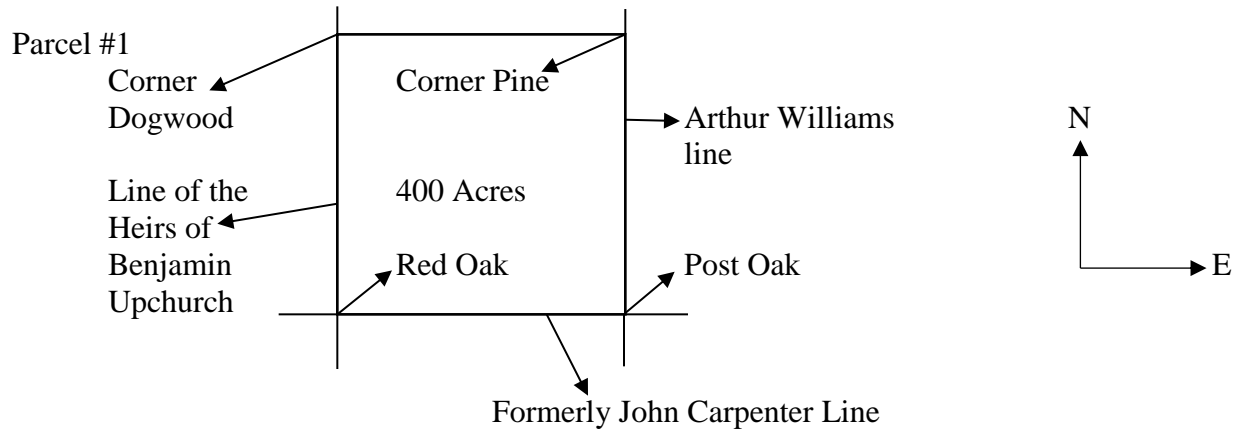

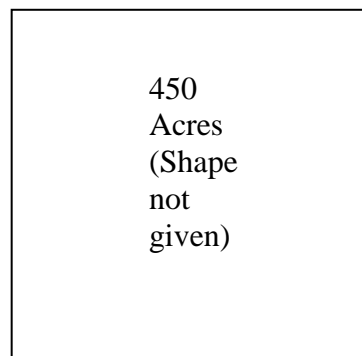
