

- 103- OLIVE CHAPEL CHURCH COMMUNITY IS IN EXTREME WESTERN WAKE CO. - THERE WERE UPCHURCH FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNITY BY 1780's [JOHN U, III]
- 270m. PRESENT AT JAN 1858 MERCHANTS MEETING IN RALEIGH, NC: W. C. U [William Clinton U]; UPCHURCH & ROYSTER
- 282- JOHN J. U [John Jordan U] had a machine shop on Morgan street in Raleigh, NC in the 1840's
- 290- W. C. U [William Clinton U, I] was a Raleigh, NC Grocer who in the 1840's provided the Standard Newspaper with paper to be published.
- 358 In 1850, several families living in the vicinity of New Ruin organized a Baptist congregation and about midway the race track road built Olive's or Olive Chapel, named for Rev. Johnson Olive, their neighbor and first pastor. The church's influence on the community became so strong that it was not many years before the bar at the tavern closed down, the betting on races ceased, and promoters of both, in the words of a church historian, "either moved into the church or out of the community." The tavern building became a country store, operated by John Upchurch and his descendants.¹⁴²
- 358m [JOHN RUFUS U ? - RPU]
- 521m In the summer of 1865 one Emily U applied for aid based on the fact that she had formerly relied on the Millwain Paper mill destroyed by Yankees
- 562 Branson's N.C. Business Directory from 1867-1872 included Alfred U's & T.G. Jenkins Carriage & Buggy factories [Partners vs 2 companies? - RPU]
- 563 Bailey P. Williamson + Orlando Shay operated the North State Foundry during the Civil war but dissolved the partnership in 1865
- 567 W. U, Grocer, [William Clinton U, I] was one of several Raleigh business operations that continued to operate during the Civil war or soon reopened
- 568 Pictures 3 buildings on Fayetteville street in Raleigh, NC which housed 4 businesses in the 1870's, one of these housed Edwards & Broughton (see right) upstairs and the WILLIAMSON, UPCHURCH, TITOMAS GROCERY downstairs [U could be William Clinton U, I or William George U - RPU]
- 572 Multistoried buildings started in Raleigh, NC by 4 years after the Civil war included the 3 STORY BRICK STORE AT WILMINGTON & MARTIN for UPCHURCH & DODD [W^m GEO. U]
- 574 The Raleigh Board of Trade organized in 1871 included William U [William Clinton U, I or William George U - RPU]
- 607m Incorporators of the Raleigh Baptist Female Seminary in 1870-71 included W. G. U [William George U]
- 652 About 1867 lots were platted in APEX - J. R. U bought one [JOHN RUFUS U ? - RPU]
- 664 Describer Green Jewel - was on a major road connecting Raleigh and Pittsboro. It's Post office was an early one to be reopened after the Civil war - MISS A. D. U was first post-war Postmaster [A. D. U = JOHN RUFUS U ? - RPU]
- The area had at least 7 stores in 1872: JOHN U [JOHN U = JOHN RUFUS U ? - RPU] + J. W. BOLLING, HOWELL & PERRY, R. H. JENKS, W. S. JENKS, J. W. MITCHELL, B. M. YATES

Next we drove to the Bethany Church Area and stopped to inspect property once owned by Waylon U. It is in the SW corner of the intersection but not quite to the crossroads. Jean recalls visiting here in her youth and remembered the graveyard which stood on the south side of the house and that there were graves of several infants. Jean got the occupant of the house to come out for a visit and she showed us the gravestones which are on adjoining property. We read some names on the stones looking over the fence as follows:

WILBERT CARLYLE 8 NOV 1911 - 25 OCT 1914

S/O M/M A. C. BROUGHTON ↑

JOHN LEA WEATHERS 1866 - 1913

TEMPLE A. GRIFFIN 1869 - ?

WIFE OF J. L. WEATHERS

It was out back of the house that the mother* of John Robinson Bell, Jr was murdered. One story is that thieves stole goods and were moving away in a buggy and the female was killed accidentally as an attempt was made to stop the thieves. Another version is that the mother* was killed because of infidelity.





THIS BOOK HAS SEVERAL UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES INCLUDING UPLHURCH INTEREST

- Many SMITH family members of Central NC have the middle initial "A" or sometimes "Ar". It turns out their name was originally ARROWSMITH later shortened to Ar. Smith or A. Smith.
- The original Arrowsmith in NC was RICHARD ARROW SMITH b abt 1745 d after 13 JAN 1819 (Wake Co, NC). There are citations for him in the 1700's in Johnston Co, NC & Cumberland Co, NC. However by the 1790 Census he was living in Wake Co, NC presumably in St Mary's TSP where his descendants were soon found in large numbers. The area of Cumberland Co, NC where he was located became Harnett Co, NC as he owned tracts on NEILLS CREEK & on BUIES CREEK. In 1797, while a landowner in the Auburn Area, St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC. he was member of a jury charged with rerouting the Raleigh - Smithfield Rd possibly below the juncture of Steep Hill Creek & Swift Creek so as to eliminate 1 of 2 bridges.
- Richard Arrow Smith had a GS Benjamin A. Smith who had a GS Lonnie Hilliard Smith who lived in Franklin Co, NC & ind into the H Family
- Joseph Broughton, Sr b 1770 (VA or NC) d 1814 (Johnston Co, NC) had a son Joseph Broughton, Jr b 4 FEB 1812 (Johnston Co, NC) who moved to St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC where his descendants intermarried with the descendants of Richard Arrow Smith b abt 1745. Many of the Broughton family moved to Raleigh, NC Needham Bryan Broughton, II, Printer and Gene Leader & his nephew Joseph Melville Broughton, Jr who became Gov of NC & a U.S. Senator

- Many SMITH family members of Central NC have the middle initial "A" or sometimes "Ar". It turns out their name was originally ARROWSMITH later shortened to Ar. Smith or A. Smiths.
- The original Arrowsmith in NC was RICHARD ARROW SMITH b abt 1745 d after 13 JAN 1819 (Wake Co, NC). There are citations for him in the 1700's in Johnston Co, NC & Cumberland Co, NC. However by the 1790 Census he was living in Wake Co, NC presumably in St Mary's TSP where his descendants were soon found in large numbers. The area of Cumberland Co, NC where he was located became Harnett Co, NC as he owned tracts on NEILLS CREEK & on BUIES CREEK. In 1797, while a landowner in the Auburn Area, St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC. he was member of a jury charged with rerouting the Raleigh - Smithfield Rd possibly below the juncture of Steep Hill Creek & Swift Creek so as to eliminate 1 of 2 bridges
- Richard Arrow Smith had a GS Benjamin A. Smith who had a GS Louie Hilliard Smith who lived in Franklin Co, NC & ind into the 4 family

- The original Arrowsmith in NC was RICHARD ARROW SMITH b abt 1745 d after 13 JAN 1819 (Wake Co, NC). There are citations for him in the 1700's in Johnston Co, NC & Cumberland Co, NC. However by the 1790 Census he was living in Wake Co, NC presumably in St Mary's TSP where his descendants were soon found in large numbers. The area of Cumberland Co, NC where he was located became Harnett Co, NC as he owned tracts on NEILLS CREEK & on BUIES CREEK. In 1797, while a landowner in the Auburn Area, St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC. he was member of a jury charged with reventing the Raleigh - Smithfield Rd parallel below the juncture of Steep Hill Creek & Swift Creek so as to eliminate 1 of 2 bridges
- Richard Arrow Smith had a GS Benjamin A. Smith who had a GS Louie Hilliard Smith who lived in Franklin Co, NC & end into the 4 Family
- Joseph Broughton, Sr b 1770 (VA or NC) d 1814 (Johnston Co, NC) had a son Joseph Broughton, Jr b 4 FEB 1812 (Johnston Co, NC) who moved to St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC where his descendants intermarried with the descendants of Richard Arrow Smith b abt 1745. Many of the Broughton family moved to Raleigh, NC Needham Bryan Broughton, II, Printer and Gene Stead & his nephew Joseph Melville Broughton, Jr who became Gov of NC & a U.S. Senator



The Baptists were next to organize a congregation. This was in 1812, and a church building of an humble character was erected on Moore Square, or in what was then known as the Baptist Grove. The bell was of the size and sound of those generally in use by tobacco factories. In this Grove the founders of the First Baptist church worshipped. There is high authority for the statement that the members were accustomed each to take a tallow candle to this humble building in order to produce a "dim, religious light" (so conducive to spirituality, it was thought) for services at night. The membership of the church, says Mr. W. C. Upchurch, was never more than eighteen—seven males and eleven females. Of the former there

were Madison Royster, Jas. Nunn, J. D. Briggs, Mark Williams, and W. C. Upchurch; the late Mrs. Alfred Williams was among the female members.

About 1835, owing to differences of opinion among the members, dissension arose, and a new and better edifice was accordingly erected at the southeast corner of Wilmington and Morgan streets. The pastors of this church, in the order named, were Revs. Amos J. Battle, Louis Dupree, T. W. Toby, J. J. Finch, G. W. Johnston, T. E. Skinner.

In 1858 the present imposing First Baptist Church was erected. Rev. Dr. T. E. Skinner, one of our most distinguished theologians (who is yet living and much beloved by all) was the first pastor. The late Rev. Dr. T. H. Pritchard was another of the early pastors.

Among the members of this church in the old days were, Mrs. Alfred Williams, Miss Lucinda Briggs, P. F. Pescud, J. J. Biggs, Miss Sallie Towles, M. B. Royster, Jas. D. Royster, Lynn Adams, W. D. Williams, Caswell Lee, Jas. D. Nunn, Jordan Womble, Jr., Robert Jones, Miss Selina Jenkins.

A prominent feature of the Sunday School of this church is the Infant Class, which numbers one hundred and sixty-five. The class was organized in 1865, with but twelve pupils. Dr. W. I. Royster was the first teacher in charge. It is now conducted by Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Dodd and Miss Elizabeth Briggs.

In 1874 a few members of this church, led by Messrs. N. B. Broughton and J. S. Allen, organized a new congregation, and purchased on Swain street a house of worship and denominated it the Second Baptist Church. The congregation assumed in a year or two such proportions that it became necessary to secure a more commodious structure, and a site was accordingly purchased on the corner of Hargett and Person streets, upon which was erected the present edifice,

known as the Tabernacle Baptist Church. Its seating capacity is about one thousand. The Sunday School is the largest in the city and its fame in this department of religious work extends throughout the country, due, in a great measure, to the zeal and popularity of Mr. N. B. Broughton, known throughout the State as foremost in all that makes for the advancement—moral and material—of the people.

Now and then there leaves his rural home some young man, who, recognizing the many advantages for development in a city, not found in a less thickly settled community, comes hither, and by industry and integrity hews his way to the front and leaves his impress for good on generations yet to come. In 1856 one such as this—then a mere lad—came to Raleigh. This was **Needham B. Broughton**, whose father died when he was but seven years of age. His widowed mother succeeded to the sole care of seven small children—four sons and three daughters. **Needham** was the fifth child, and his mother placed him, in early life, in a printing office to be trained to the art of printing, and how well he learned it results have shown. In 1872 he united with Mr. C. B. Edwards in the establishment of a book and job printing office, which is now one of the largest and most complete printing concerns in the South.

In church and Sunday School work **Mr. Broughton** has no superior. A deacon in the Raleigh Baptist Tabernacle, in all the efforts made by this church to attain its present prominence he has always been in the lead. He is the Superintendent of the Sunday School of that church, Secretary of the Baptist State Convention, Trustee of Wake Forest College and of the **Baptist Female University**, besides holding many other positions of honor and trust. For many years he has stood in the front rank with those who have labored and are still laboring for the moral, religious and educational advancement of our city. But his efforts in this direction have not been confined wholly to Raleigh—other sections of the State, yea, the State itself, have shared the benefits of his zeal and ability, put forth for the furtherance of the very best interests of our people. Possessed of strong convictions, and being a man of undaunted moral and physical courage, he has always planted himself firmly against the evil and in favor of the good. He pursues no temporizing policy—you always know where to find him whenever the forces of good and evil range themselves for battle; with pen and tongue and purse he boldly takes his position, and no soldier performs more valuable service than he for any cause in which he engages.


- Many SMITH family members of Central NC have the middle initial "A" or sometimes "Ar". It turns out their name was originally ARROWSMITH later shortened to Ar. Smith or A. Smith.
- The original Arrowsmith in NC was RICHARD ARROW SMITH b. abt 1745 d. after 13 JAN 1819 (Wake Co, NC). There are citations for him in the 1700's in Johnston Co, NC & Cumberland Co, NC. However by the 1790 Census he was living in Wake Co, NC presumably in St Mary's TSP where his descendants were soon found in large numbers. The area of Cumberland Co, NC where he was located became Harnett Co, NC as he owned tracts on NEILLS CREEK & on BUIES CREEK. In 1797, while a landowner in the Auburn Area, St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC. he was member of a jury charged with rerouting the Raleigh - Smithfield Rd possibly below the juncture of Steep Hill Creek & Swift Creek so as to eliminate 1 of 2 bridges.
- Richard Arrow Smith had a GS Benjamin A. Smith who had a GS Linnie Hilliard Smith who lived in Franklin Co, NC & end into the H Family
- Joseph Broughton, Sr b 1770 (VA or NC) d 1814 (Johnston Co, NC) had a son Joseph Broughton, Jr b 4 FEB 1812 (Johnston Co, NC) who moved to St Mary's TSP, Wake Co, NC where his descendants intermarried with the descendants of Richard Arrow Smith b. abt 1745. 

I appreciated your notice of the Upchurch Bulletin. I have no known descent from the Upchurch family, but I do descend from the Avent and Massey families that are closely tied by marriages with the Upchurch family.

I have known many in the Upchurch name, also many others in descent in other family names. All are fine people. By memory, most of the Upchurchs in this area have been generally on a line from Lillington to Durham - along western Wake County and southern Durham County. Wallace Upchurch (dec.) was a ranking officer in the Detective Bureau of the Durham Police Dept. O. C. Upchurch was in the neon sign business. One was the purchasing agent for Durham County. Another was office/counter salesman with a plumbing/heating supply co. Another was in the wholesale grocery business. Roy Upchurch of Henderson was an electrical contractor. Most that I have known were short to average in height, generally slim, thin-faced, friendly, helpful, out-going people always glad to see you. Roy Upchurch was stocky in build. I have not seen him for about 30 years.

There is a village/community of Upchurch. By memory, I place this in western Wake County. There is another group of the Upchurch family south/west of Fayetteville, but since they tie closely with the Avent family I would expect they are of the Wake County Upchurch group also.

Most family and historical books and records of this area contain some reference to the Upchurch family - same for cemeteries. I will list a few that you should check for data of interest; (prices from the books - I guess they are still good)
