The Dishman to Upchurch Ancestors of Betty Lowe Hatter

James/ Thomas Dishman married Kiziah (possibly Doublehead) (1775 – 1850) (Guion Miller Rolls gives his name as James Dishman.)

Jefferson Dishman married Lydia Upchurch about 1802 in Virginia. She was daughter of George Upchurch and Rachel Bethshares.

Their known 11 children and their spouses:

Mary/ Polly Jane Dishman (12-21-1803 – 1843) and Charles Campbell Ramsey married 01-21-1827 in Morgan Co, TN. His parents were William Ramsey and Catherine Gray.

Sinah “Siney Brown” Dishman (1805 – 07-16-1870) married **Riley Brown** (1824 – 11-19-1857). His parents: Abraham Brown and (?).

Archibald Dishman (12-18-1806 – 06-22-1879) married Jane Cooper (05-04-1804 – 04 Jul 1879)

Marcus/ “Markey” Dishman (1807 – 1894) married Serilda Martha Smith (1813 – 1869). Her parents: William and Mary (?) Smith.

Mr. Asahel Dishman (1808 - ?)

Thomas Jefferson Dishman (1809 – 1860) married Elizabeth (?) (1809 - ?)

Milus/ “Miles” Dishman (1811- 1880) married Susannah Raines (1816 – 1858). Milus’ second wife was Margaret McCulley (1830 – 1880)

Joseph Dishman (06-12-1812 – 11-08-1903) married Millie Ann Williams (1817 – 1880). Joseph’s second marriage was to Rhoda Gooding (12-?-1839 – 1900). Rhoda’s parents: William and Mary (?) Gooding.

Elender/ “Nellie” Dishman (09-27-1814 - ?)

Moses Upchurch (1817-08-? – 1864) married Millie Upchurch (1817 – 1861). His [Hers?] parents: Moses Upchurch and Catherine Barker

Burrel/ “Big Bird” Tremont Dishman (10-27-1820 – 05-23-1901) married Nancy Upchurch (04-09-1825 – 1884) on 22 Nov 1843. Her parents: John C Upchurch and Sarah Bertram.

Many of these Dishman families lived in Dry Holler in the southern part of Wayne County and Tennessee.

My Dishman line branched off with their daughter Sinah Dishman (1805 – 07-16-1870). Sinah had John Dishman with “Unknown”. Sinah later married **Riley Brown** (1824 – 1857).

John Dishman (1829 - ?) married Mary “Polly Ann” Morgan (1835 -?). Their children: Silas and Burel Tillman.

Silas Marion Dishman (02-25-1851 – 02-05-1923) who married Elmina Hancock (02-17-1849 – 10-17-1914). Their Children: Polly Jane, Louis Jefferson, Burel Tillman, Milly Ann, Leann, Lenda, Sarah, and Mollie.

After “Minie” died, Silas married a much younger lady, Pearl Owens. Their children: James Roy, Carolyn, Ollie Leona and William Odell.

At one time, Silas had a store that was located just over the hill from the Dishman Cemetery where he is buried in Dry Holler.

Silas and Elmina's daughter, Mary/ Polly Jane Dishman (10-XX-1871 – 01-17-1937) married William Jones (03-XX-1865 – 01-18-1937). Their children: Jane, Lula, Mary, Laura, Tom, Myrtie, Sherman and Harrison.

Louisa/ Lula Clementine Jones (08-16-1889 – 01-23-1966) married John Nathan Lowe (07-02-1865 – 09-27-1938). John is buried at the Buck Cemetery in Wayne County, KY and Lula is buried at the South Mound Cemetery, in New Castle, IN. Their 14 children: Stella, Dortha, Hubert, Albert, Hazel, Dan, Hattie, Walter, Sarah, Lillie, Wendel, Dallas, Carols and Edith.

Walter Sherman Lowe (01-20-1921 – 05-03-1963) married Doratha Vernon Doss (11-16-1915 – 04-10-1984) in Brydstown, TN on 02-25-1941. They had seven children before they divorced: Anna, Billy, Betty, Norma, Sue, Katie, and Lytha. (They have another brother Robert Myers.)

Betty Jean Lowe married Bobby Gene Hatter. They had two sons, Jacky and Robby.

A. Lydia Upchurch born 1782 – 11 children →

31. Lydia Upchurch was born ca 1782 Brunswick County, Virginia and died ca 1845 Wayne County, Kentucky. Her husband was Jefferson (Jeptha) Dishman. Jefferson was born 1770-77 in North Carolina and died ca 1847 Wayne County, Kentucky. He was the son of Thomas Dishman and Kizzie Doublehead. Thomas's existence and parentage have been disputed by the present day descendants of Samuel Duchemin.

Jeptha was listed in the 1810 Iredell County, North Carolina census as Jephthru Dishman 1 male 26-45, 1 female 26-45, 2 males 0-10, 3 females 0-10.

Jeffery Dishman was listed in the 1820 census of Wayne County, Kentucky. Included in the 1820 listing were 4 males 0-9 years old, 2 males 10-15 years old, 1 male 26-44, 1 female 0-9, 2 females 16-25, 1 female 26-44, 1 female 45+, with 3 people engaged in commerce.

Jefferson is listed in the 1830 census living in Morgan County, Tennessee. Included in this listed were 1 male 5-10, 2 males 10-15, 1 male 15-20, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 20-30, 1 female 50-60.

In 1840 they were back in Wayne County, Kentucky. Jefferson is listed with 1 male 50-60, 1 female 20-30, and 1 female 30-40. Their children

312. Sinah Dishman was born 1805 Iredell County, North Carolina and died 7-16-1870 Wayne County, Kentucky. Her husband was Riley Brown who was born 1815 Kentucky and died by 1860. Sinah had two children before she married Riley. Sinah and Riley were living in Division 1 of Wayne County, Kentucky in 1850. In this census, Riley was born 1824. Sina was living in District 3, Wayne County, Kentucky in 1860 and 1870. Mary Dishman born 1840 was living with her in 1870. She is buried Lowe Cemetery, Wayne County, Kentucky. Her eldest two children are at home in 1860, her youngest son is not home in 1860. Her children
