'Flying Legion' passes on

The skies over Lizard Lick won't be the same now that the "Flying Legion" has acquired a new set of wings.

James "Jimmy" Buchanan of Marshburn Road passed on as suddenly as he came into this world. Unlike a lot of us, his flight through life touched many people.

I remember the first time I saw Jimmy. I was about 12 years old. He made a great impression on me as I watched him walk away from his overturned airplane in a cotton field, just west of Lizard Lick. It was the first time I had ever seen a plane close up and especially upside down.

A few years ago, he gave me the ride of my life as I filmed Lizard Lick, Wendell and Hephzibah Church for our video records. His twin-wing flying machine was his pride and joy, and he never said no to those who asked for a ride.

Jimmy served aboard a ship in the South Pacific during WWII and was honorably discharged June 11, 1946. There is a landmark in downtown Wendell called Buck's Service Station. There are none living in Wendell today who

can say, "I remember when there was no Buck's Service Station."

Jimmy carried on the family tradition. He maintained a service station, not a filling station. This new generation will never experience the difference.

I hope his family will preserve this historic corner as a tribute to Jimmy, and everyone will write their story about meeting a true American hero in our own community.

May God bless Jimmy's family as they carry on his name with integrity and honor.

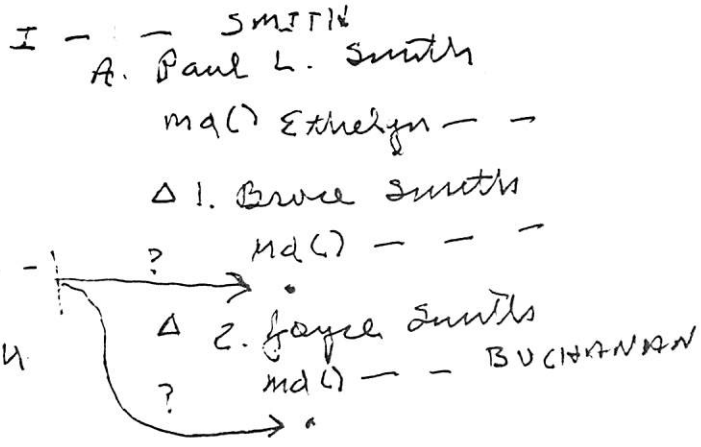
Mrs. Smith was preceded in death by her husband, Paul L. Smith.

The skies over Lizard Lick won't be the same now that the "Flying Legion" has acquired a new set of wings.

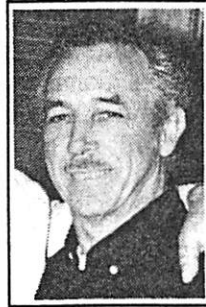
James "Jimmy" Buchanan of Marshburn Road passed on as suddenly as he came into this world. Unlike a lot of us, his flight through life touched many people.

I remember the first time I saw Jimmy. I was about 12 years old. He made a great impression on me as I watched him walk away from his overturned airplane in a cotton field, just west of Lizard Lick. It was the first time I had ever seen a plane close up and especially upside down.

A few years ago, he gave me the ride of my life as I filmed Lizard Lick, Wendell and Hephzibah Church for our video records. His twin-wing flying machine was his pride and joy, and he never said no to those who asked for a ride.

Jimmy served aboard a ship in the South Pacific during WWII and was honorably discharged June 11, 1946. There is a landmark in downtown Wendell called Buck's Service Station. There are none living in Wendell today who

can say, "I remember when there was no Buck's Service Station."

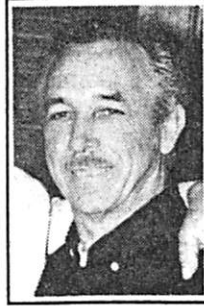
James "Jimmy" Buchanan of Marshburn Road passed on as suddenly as he came into this world. Unlike a lot of us, his flight through life touched many people.

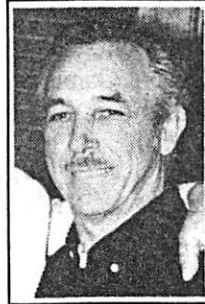

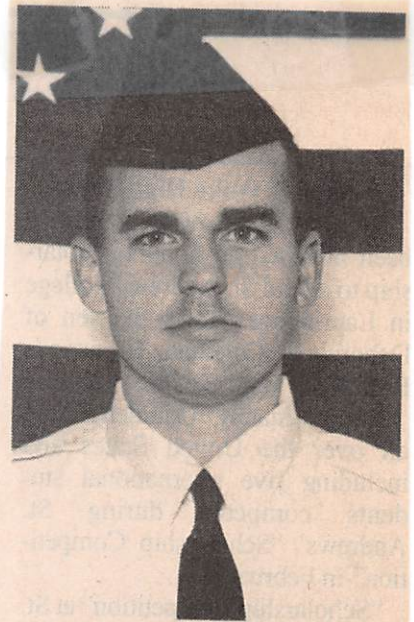
