Commentary: Buckner Upchurch was born about 1777 in Dunn Township, Franklin County, NC. He was the son of Richard Upchurch III, head of Upchurch Clan # 4. He married locally and continued to live in Dunn Township until sometime around 1823 when he moved to Davidson, NC where he is found on the 1830 census. In 1840, he was in Randolph County, NC. From there he moved in 1843 to Brown County, IL where he later died. Some of his children may have married and stayed in Franklin or Randolph Counties in NC. I visited Brown County, IL and gave a talk there during an Upchurch reunion.

Upchurch Story Buckner Upchurch Family

Buckner Upchurch was born in North Carolina and died in Brown County, Illinois. He was the son of Richard, Jr., referred to herein as (2). The 1850 Census of Brown Co. carries the listing of Buckner and his youngest son aged 11. Buckner states his age as 73 in 1850, making his birth year as 1777. His wife must have died prior to the taking of the census in 1850. Her name has not been learned.

In 1800 Buckner was counted on the census in Franklin Co, NC with a wife and two daus. In 1810 the daus were between ten and sixteen years of age and four sons were under then years. Buckner received land from his father's inventory in 1817. He sold the land in 1820 and moved to Randolph Co, NC. He was found there in 1840 with his wife, one son and two daus between 20 and 30; a son 15 - 20; a son and dau under 5 years. Another son, Silas Upchurch, is listed under his own household. Silas elected to remain in Randolph County. Buckner, his wife and children arrived in Brown County, IL about 1843. On the 1850 census there he lists the only son remaining at home as age 11 and stated he was born in IL. that seems to be an error, as Buckner was in Randolph in 1839, the birth year of his son.

1. Richard or Richardson Upchurch was born 1808 NC died in Brown Co. sometime after 1887. It was in that year that his wife, Elizabeth and son-in-law Martin Clark petitioned the court to declare Richardson a distracted person. A trial by jury brought in the verdict of "distracted". Probably the verdict today would be "unstable". Richardson was a school teacher by profession and may have taught in the schools of North Carolina before continuing teaching in the schools of his new home. Richardson and Elizabeth had ten children.

2. Silas Upchurch was born 1810 NC, date of his death unknown. In 1850 he was listed in Randolph County, NC with his wife, Gilly... born 1812 NC; four sons and a daughter. All four sons served in the Confederate Regt. From NC in the Civil War.

3. Wesley Upchurch born 8-17-1817 NC died 5-28-1898 IL married Mary Patterson. Their first son was born in North Carolina.

4. Sion Upchurch born 1821 NC died 1869 IL married 3-23-1843 Phoebe Briggs born 1827 NC. They were married by Thomas Briggs, J. P., the relationship unknown. Sion left a will, naming his wife, Phoebe and son, Wesley as Executors. George W. Upchurch witnessed the will.
5. Jonas Alexander Upchurch born 3-22-1839 died 11-15-1891 married 3-30-1859 Louisa Jaques born 8-25-1838 died 4-10-1893. Both are buried Brown Co, IL.



(69) In the May, Aug, Nov issues of the N. C. Genealogical Society Journal Forrest D. King authored 3 articles covering Matthew Strickland born about 1648 and the 3 succeeding generations. In the 3rd generation there were two ancestors of Eva Sallaine (Sledge) Upchurch. Jacob Strickland born about 1715 and Sampson Strickland born about 1724. (These have been separately extracted.) Some of these Stricklands ended up in Dunn Township, Franklin Co, NC. Mostly these are covered in the Aug & Nov issues. However, the following entry on page 141 & 142 in the May issue is of special interest – RPU 11 Nov 2008

William Strickland born about 170 was the 3rd generation and a brother of Sallaine's ancestors Jacob & Sampson William appears to have had a son Matthew Strickland born about 1752 who came to Franklin Co, NC. Details from page 141 & 142.

William Strickland and his unidentified wife may have had at least one child: 30 i. (possibly) Mathew Strickland, born say 1752 in Edgecombe County, North Carolina. He married Mary Perry, daughter of John Perry¹⁴³ in Bute County, North Carolina, on 5 January 1774.¹⁴⁴ He died in Wake County, North Carolina, on 18 July 1828.¹⁴⁵ Mary died on 25 May 1817 at age sixty-five or sixty-six.¹⁴⁶ Mathew first appeared in records as a resident of Granville County, North Carolina, where he purchased land on Little River Creek in Johnston Co, on 1 February 1765.¹⁴⁷ Mathew's land apparently fell into Wake County when it was created from Johnston, Cumberland, and Orange in 1771. Mathew brought Hardy Griffin, an orphan, to the Wake County Court on September 1772 to have him bound to him as an apprentice.¹⁴⁸ The Wake county tax assessor charged Mathew for 1.911 acres and three slaves 1782.¹⁴⁹ The 1790 federal census schedule appears to account for all seven children named in the will.¹⁵⁰ Mathew regularly served on juried during the 1790s. In September 1795, he was delinquent for jury duty.¹⁵¹ but he was later excused.¹⁵² Mathew failed to show up again six months later, and that was the last time he appeared in jury lists.¹⁵³ In February 1810, Mathew and his son John P. were defendants in a suit by John Pace over the use of Buckner Upchurch as a worker. The plaintiff won the suit.¹⁵⁴ Mathew wrote his will in Wake County on 7 May 1826.¹⁵⁵ He died there on 18 July 1828.¹⁵⁶



(75) In the May, Aug, Nov issues of the N. C. Genealogical Society Journal Forrest D. King authored 3 articles covering Matthew Strickland born about 1648 and the 3 succeeding generations. In the 3rd generation there were two ancestors of Eva Sallaine (Sledge) Upchurch. Jacob Strickland born about 1715 and Sampson Strickland born about 1724. (These have been separately extracted.) Some of these Stricklands ended up in Dunn Township, Franklin Co, NC. Mostly these are covered in the Aug & Nov issues. However, the following entry on page 141 & 142 in the May issue is of special interest – RPU 11 Nov 2008

William Strickland born about 170 was the 3rd generation and a brother of Sallaine's ancestors Jacob & Sampson William appears to have had a son Matthew Strickland born about 1752 who came to Franklin Co, NC. Details from page 141 & 142.

William Strickland and his unidentified wife may have had at least one child: 30 i. (possibly) Mathew Strickland, born say 1752 in Edgecombe County, North Carolina. He married Mary Perry, daughter of John Perry¹⁴³ in Bute County, North Carolina, on 5 January 1774.¹⁴⁴ He died in Wake County, North Carolina, on 18 July 1828.¹⁴⁵ Mary died on 25 May 1817 at age sixty-five or sixty-six.¹⁴⁶ Mathew first appeared in records as a resident of Granville County, North Carolina, where he purchased land on Little River Creek in Johnston Co, on 1 February 1765.¹⁴⁷ Mathew's land apparently fell into Wake County when it was created from Johnston, Cumberland, and Orange in 1771. Mathew brought Hardy Griffin, an orphan, to the Wake County Court on September 1772 to have him bound to him as an apprentice.¹⁴⁸ The Wake county tax assessor charged Mathew for 1.911 acres and three slaves 1782.¹⁴⁹ The 1790 federal census schedule appears to account for all seven children named in the will.¹⁵⁰ Mathew regularly served on juried during the 1790s. In September 1795, he was delinquent for jury duty,¹⁵¹ but he was later excused.¹⁵² Mathew failed to show up again six months later, and that was the last time he appeared in jury lists.¹⁵³ In February 1810, Mathew and his son John P. were defendants in a suit by John Pace over the use of Buckner Upchurch as a worker. The plaintiff won the suit.¹⁵⁴ Mathew wrote his will in Wake County on 7 May 1826.¹⁵⁵ He died there on 18 July 1828.¹⁵⁶

Whether one or both married in Franklin Co, NC and stayed there or moved elsewhere or died young unmarried is an open question. Whether they moved west with parents about 1820 is unknown.
