The note below pertains to the James Bunn Section of Vol 1.

James Bunn had 3 children, one of whom was <u>Amey Bunn</u> born about 1790 (Franklin Co, NC). She married Claburn Upchurch, I, son of Richard Upchurch, III. Records on this couple in Vol 1 have been fully extracted as regards information new to RPU – 12 Mar 2010.

#### A Note to Readers

Very little is known about James Bunn. His name first appears in the First United States Census in 1790. He resided in the Hillsborough District of Wake County, North Carolina. James was married to Susannah (surname unknown). A number of records refer to her as "Sooky" and "Sucky". Apparently, James moved to nearby Franklin County, for at the time of his death about 1795, records in that county indicate that he owned 178 acres of land there that was equally divided among his wife and their three children. A few years after the death of James, Susannah married Jeremiah Denby. A marriage bond for Susannah and Jeremiah, dated September 21, 1810, was recorded in Franklin County.

Although unproven, it is strongly believed that James Bunn was closely related to, and possibly the brother of, Benjamin Bunn who was a resident and land owner in Wake County, North Carolina. Benjamin was the executor of James' will. He was also responsible for the sale of James' estate and property. It is further believed that James and Benjamin were closely related to other Bunn families in Northampton County, North Carolina.

He married <u>Amy Bunn</u> Jun 3 1809 in Franklin Co, NC. <u>Amy Bunn</u> was born abt 1790 in Franklin Co, NC and died bef 1870 in Clayton Co, GA. Claiborne Upchurch is thought to have been a son of Richard Upchurch and Susannah Pace. <u>Amy Bunn</u> is thought to have been a daughter of James Bunn and Mary Haskins. would appreciate any help with this line. Note: This section on James Bunn d. 1795 (Franklin Co, NC) has special importance for the Upchurch Family as <u>Amey Bunn</u> daughter of James married Claburn Upchurch, I. Much on descendants of <u>Amey</u> and Claburn is included but is already in RPU records + I have more – RPU 7 Mar 2010

1. James<sup>1</sup> Bunn died Abt. 1795 in Franklin Co., NC<sup>1</sup>. He married Susannah Unknown. She died Aft. 1811.

Notes for Susannah Unknown:

The 1800 census for Franklin Co., NC, indicated that Susannah "Sucky" was living in that county at that time. She is listed on the Tax List for that county in the years 1804, 1805, and 1806. She conveyed 158 acres of land to Harrison & Jones on 13 Jan 1807 (page 14, DB 14).

Notes for Jesse Bunn:

In the division of his father's land, Jesse received one-fourth of 178.5 acres on 14 Jan 1811. He appears on the 1815 and 1820 Tax List for Franklin Co., NC. On 2 Jan 1823, John F. Spivey conveyed to Jesse, 40.5 acres of land in Franklin County adjoining that of James Strothers and Charity Spivey. Jeremiah Denby, second husband of Jesse's mother Susannah, was bondsman for the marriage of Jesse and Eady. G. Hill, Jr. was a witness.

2. William<sup>2</sup> Bunn (James<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1786 in NC, and died Aft. 1850. He married Lydia Massey 28 Oct 1806 in Franklin Co., NC<sup>3</sup>, daughter of Hezekiah Massey. She was born Bef. 1790.

#### Notes for William Bunn:

William Bunn appears of the Franklin Co., NC, Tax List for the years 1808, 1809 1810, 1815, and 1810. In the division of his father's land in Franklin County, William received one-fourth of 178.5 acres (WB C, page 233). Jeremiah Denby, second husband of William's mother Susanna, was bondsman for the marriage of William and Lydia. G. Hill, Jr. was a witness. Notes for Lydia Massey:

#### Notes for **Amey Bunn**:

The marriage bond (Franklin Co., NC) of <u>Amey Bunn</u> and Claiborne Upchurch indicates that Amy's brother, William Bunn was the bondsman and G. Hill, Jr. was a witness. According to a book by Belle Lewter West titled "Upchurch Family of England, VA and NC," <u>Amey</u> and her husband had 12 children. <u>Amy</u> and Claburn move to Hancock, GA in 1822, then to Henry Co., GA, in 1832, to join a colony of Upchurches who had gone to GA from NC. They died in Clayton Co., GA.
