

Burkely Upchurch, Sr.**XID – 65**

Commentary: Burkely Upchurch SR was born about 1795 in Dunn Township, Franklin County, NC. He was the son of Richard Upchurch, head of Upchurch clan # 4. He lived all of his life in Franklin County and died there in 1863. He married Alsey Pace in 1815. They had children together. There are numerous citations in this Biofile that show Burkely's involvement in the community.

D. Page 2 I think I can be very comfortable with the above as proof that Berkley was father of my Ambrose what with deed from Ambrose, Martha M. Alford & Ursula Upchurch to William Privett and other document linking Ambrose to Berkley.

Ambrose Amos Upchurch inherited 120 acres from Burkely Upchurch & got 520 acres
 from his father-in-law John Pearce. Ambrose willed this land to two of his sons “Bill” [William
 Gaston Upchurch] and James Upchurch [James W Upchurch] and they managed it (farmed?) for
 a couple of years knowing there was a mortgage but then learned this was actually a 2nd
 mortgage. They lost the property.

Ambrose Amos Upchurch did have two sons named James Upchurch. The first born
 James [born 1852; XID – 647] died at age 19. The second born James [born 1867; XID – 2914]
 lived to have a family.

Ambrose Amos Upchurch married Harriet Pearce who was the daughter of John Pearce.
 John Pearce was extremely wealthy and owned 40,000 acres of land and many slaves. He had 6
 girls and settled 500 – 600 acres of land on each plus a house and outbuildings and 8 slaves. He
 had 4 boys and settled about 2,000 acres on each. John Pearce had a large black carriage with
 servants fore and aft. He and his wife were poisoned by slaves who cooked their food in 1863 at
 the time Lincoln freed the slaves. His grave is in the Moccasin Creek area.

Will by deposition

28 Apr 1815 – Britton Upchurch being deposed before Thomas Dunn, J. P. reports – Sep 1814 Britton Upchurch with Jesse Averit at General Muster in Louisburg, NC and it was established that Jesse Averit was to take a tour of duty in place of **Burkley Upchurch** in Norfolk, VA. Jesse Averit stated if he did not return his property was to go to William Owens & his wife Temperance & that old Baker was to get nothing.

Also: 5 May 1815 – Elizabeth Alford deposed before Thomas Bunn, J. P. says Jesse Averit told her his property should go to Temperance Owens.

This document concerns a deed made 5 Mar 1870 in Franklin Co, NC. From it one may conclude that at his death in 1863 **Burkely Upchurch, Sr.** designated 7 heirs to receive equal shares (8 4/7 acres each) of a 60 acre tract. In the 1870 deed three heirs (children of **Burkely Upchurch, Sr.**) transfer their 25 5/7 acres (8 4/7 x 3) to William Privett, husband of Auma Upchurch, a sibling of the three heirs. The three are Ambrose Upchurch [Ambrose Amos Upchurch], Martha Alford [Martha M. Upchurch] and Urguly Upchurch [Ersula Upchurch]. It would be helpful to locate the document which lists the 7 heirs in order to more definitely fix the names of the 8 (9) children of **Burkely Upchurch, Sr.**
