Commentary: Andrew Jackson Butts was the son of Henry James and Susan Upchurch Butts and the grandson of Charles, head of Upchurch Clan 2. Andrew made his way to Missouri and Texas during his life and married three times along the way.

In letters D-1 to D-6 Harriet Simmons (nee Harriet A Upchurch), a widow, is writing to his Aunt Susan Butts (nee --- ---) in Lavaca Co, TX. Susan would appear to be the wife of a son or grandson of Henry Butts, I – or even the wife of Henry Butts, I.

D-1 Harriet refers to "brother's" death – He is Alexander Upchurch; and to "sister" = Mary her sister-in-law

Henry Butts is listed a "Butz" on the 1797 Hancock Co, GA Tax List (James Henry Butts? – RPU). A Henry Butts (James Henry Butts? RPU) is also listed as a property holder on land adjoining property held by James Alford in 1800.
