Immediately after the ceremony Mr. and Mrs. Jones left on the Interurban and will be at home at the corner of Montgomery and King streets in this city after February 20.

The bride's wedding gown was of Paris muslin with valenciennes trimming, which she changed for a champagne traveling suit with accessories, after the wedding.

Both young people are well known and highly esteemed in this city, the groom being an employee of the Hollingsworth Carpet company.

We think the name was William C. Calvin after his father's grandfather. His sister and her son Roy called him "Billy". Some family and friends called him "Willie". He was b ca 1900 probably in Sherman, TX, d 1933 (Bar - West Hill Cem, Sherman, TX) [The plot has a large marker with Calvin on one side and Johnson on the other side. Billy is the only Calvin buried there]. He and Ethel Johnson had no issue. He died when "very young" from pneumonia at which time he owned an auto repair garage in Euless, TX. His widow later md - - Rodson.
