

Calvin W. Upchurch**XID – 1121**

Commentary: Calvin W. Upchurch was born in 1837 in the Cross Roads district of Wake County, NC. He died in Wake County in 1906. He was the son of Kearney Upchurch, the grandson of James Upchurch VIII, and the great grandson of Richard Upchurch III – the head of Upchurch Clan # 4. He married Adeline S. Freeman in 1859. They had one child, Corinna, who was born in 1860. Calvin served in the Civil War under General Robert E. Lee. One report suggests he had a son Walter born in 1868, and a daughter born in 1870. Confirmation of these births need confirmation. Calvin applied for residence in the Old Soldiers Home in Raleigh, NC and it is likely he died there.

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, August 6, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured, at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 3, 1863. Confined at Fort Delaware, Delaware, until transferred to Point Lookout, Maryland, on October 18, 1863. Died in hospital at Point Lookout, on November 17, 1863, of “diarrhoea chronic.”
- △ TIPPET, L. M., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 17, September 9, 1862, for the war as a substitute for William B. Fowler. Died in camp at Upperville, Virginia, November 2, 1862.
- △ ★ TRAWICK, JAMES M., Corporal
Born in Wake County where he resided as a farmer and enlisted at age 27, July 22, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Corporal. “Died August 9, 1862, in camp near Richmond, Virginia, from exhaustion in the Seven Days’ battles around the city.”
- △ UPCHURCH, CALVIN W., Corporal
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 16, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Corporal. Present or accounted for until wounded in action at Payne’s Farm, Virginia, November 27, 1863. Detailed in Captain Samuel B. Water’s Company, Provost Guard, Raleigh, March 10, 1864. Absent on detail through December, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, March 1, 1865.
- △ ★ UPCHURCH, DALLAS H., Private
Transferred from Company H, 31st Regiment N.C. Troops on March 10, 1862. Discharged on August 5, 1862, by reason of disability.
- △ UPCHURCH, JAMES W., Sergeant
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 22, July 16, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Sergeant. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Paroled at Elmira and sent to James River, Virginia, for exchange on February 20, 1865. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, February 27, 1865, and furloughed for 30 days on March 7, 1865.
- △ WALKER, JESSE J., Private
Resided in Ashe County and enlisted in Wake County at age 28, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until sent home sick May-June, 1863. Reported as absent sick until September 6, 1863, when he was reported as absent without leave. Reported as absent without leave on company muster rolls through December, 1864. Roll of Honor states that he “went home on sick furlough and deserted to the enemy about March 1, 1864.” Federal Provost Marshal records indicate that he “came into Federal lines Plymouth, North Carolina” and took the Oath of Allegiance at Fort Monroe, Virginia, March 14, 1864.
- △ WALL, JAMES, Private
Resided in Wake County where he listed at age 30, July 18, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until wounded in action at Payne’s Farm, Virginia, November 27, 1863. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, December 10, 1863, of gunshot wound.
- △ WALT, GEORGE F., Private
Paroled at Greensboro on May 22, 1865.
- △ WATKINS, CLINTON, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 18, 1861, for the war. Wounded in action at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862, and captured and paroled near Keedysville, Maryland, September 20, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 27, 1865.
- △ WATKINS, GASTON, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, July 18, 1861, for the war. Died at Fredericksburg, Virginia, September 30, 1861.
- △ WATKINS, JAMES H., Private
Resided in Wake County and enlisted in Wayne County on May 3, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until transferred to Company K, 14th Regiment N.C. Troops (4th Regiment N.C. Volunteers), December 31, 1862.
- △ WATKINS, KINCHEN B., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 22, July 18, 1861, for the war. “Deserted July 25, 1863, in Wake County.”
- △ WEATHERS, J. D., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted on November 7, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for until reported on February 29, August 31, 1864, muster roll with the remark that he was “absent prisoner of war since May 12, 1864.” Reported as absent prisoner through December, 1864. Roll of Honor states that he “died in prison at Elmira, New York.” No Federal Provost Marshal records were found relative to his capture or confinement and death.

Resided as a farmer in Ashe County prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Discharged at Richmond, Virginia, September 3, 1862, by reason of “hernia and spinal irritation.”

Resided in Ashe County as a farmer prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Discharged on September 3, 1862, by reason of “hernia.”

Writes on 5 Oct 1861 to thank these of Wake Forest, Forestville and Rolesville, NC for sending articles to the troops. This unit was organized in Wake Co, NC at Forestville, NC on 16 Jul 1861 and assigned to 1st Rgt, NC State troops. Captain Foote joined 16 May 1861 and left 19 Dec 1862. He therefore overlapped the service of Bartley Jefferson Upchurch who enlisted on 15 Jul 1862 and served in Co. G of the same regiment. Letter addressed to: Brother Huffman and reference James S Purefoy, MOG (probably husband of Mary R. Purefoy) who brought the items and also ministered to the troops. 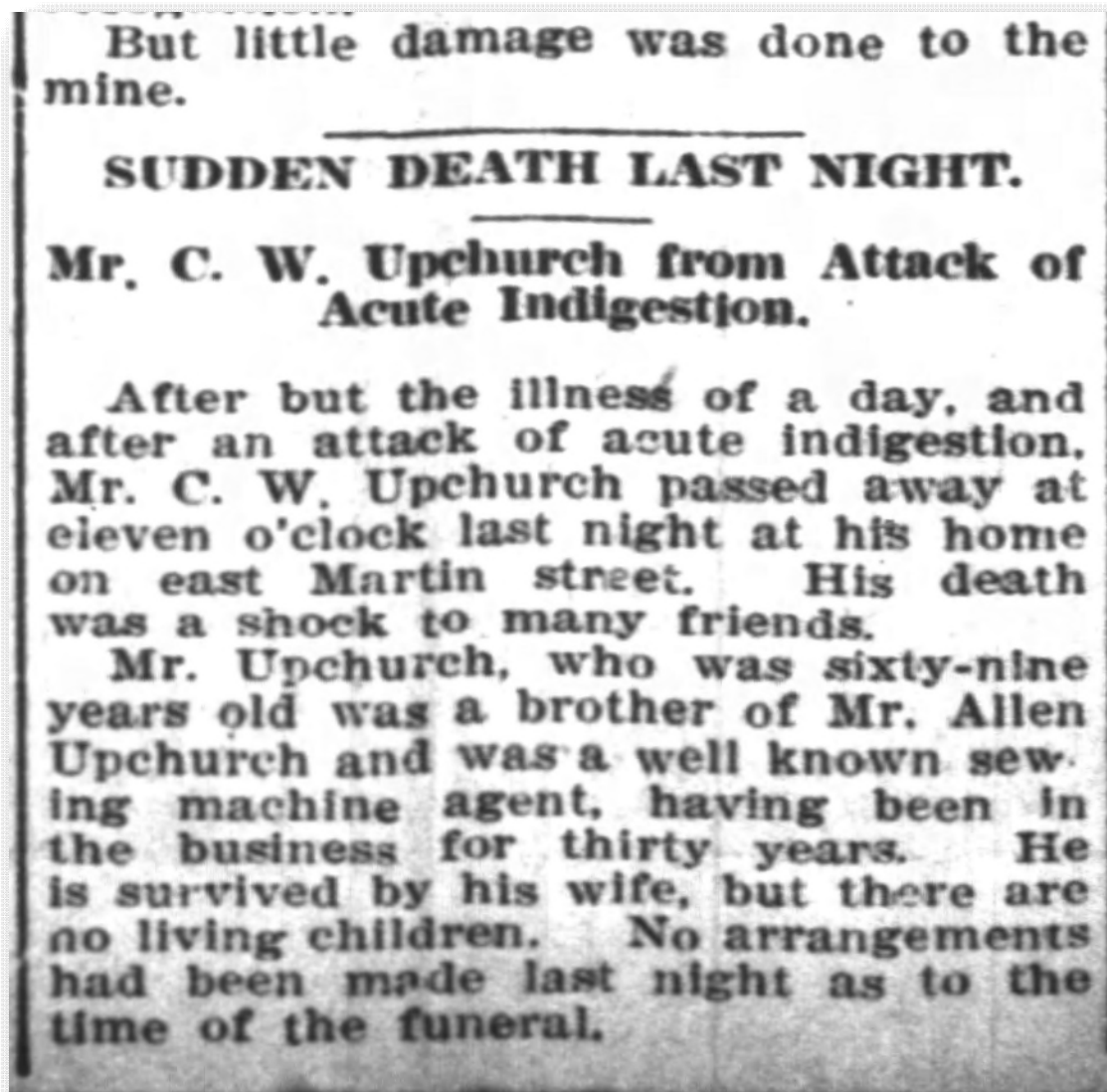

This seems to be Calvin Upchurch. On the 1900 census, his occupation is listed as swing machine agent. We can assume that the word swing is missing an "e". Also his wife, Adeline, is listed in the 1907 Raleigh City Directory as a widow of Calvin. One question is the address. C.W. and his wife lived on East Hargett, not East Martin. But this could be an oversight on the part of the newspaper editor.
