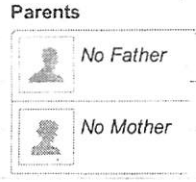

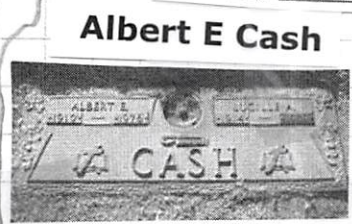

# Longtime friends remember good neighbor and columnist

Annie Lynn Howell's twinkling eyes and bemused smile were familiar to many who knew the lifelong Apex resident.

"I always considered her Santa Claus. She brought Christmas every time I saw her," said Molly Weston of the 81 year old lady who died last week.

Weston and others who knew Mrs. Howell said whenever she came to visit them she always brought something with her --

homemade seafoam candy, pickled watermelon rind, and of course, the scrapbooks for which she was so well-known.

"Whenever someone was shut in, Mrs. Howell would come lugging those scrapbooks," said resident Ann Grebing. The scrapbooks of Mrs. Howell were full of newspaper clippings and other mementos which Grebing said are priceless.

"Lynn Howell was a very unique person," said Grebing. "She was so benevolent, always doing for someone else."

"She went about doing good. Everyday it was 'Who can I cheer,'" said Lib Covington, a neighbor who knew Mrs. Howell for almost 40 years.

Covington also said she remembers Mrs. Howell for her openness. "You could stop by her house any time of the day and feel welcome," she said.

Besides her benevolence to

others, many in Apex knew Mrs. Howell for her weekly columns in the Western Wake Herald, to which she contributed for over 20 years.

Before her recent illness, Mrs. Howell would come each week to the newspaper office bringing her hand-written community news -- a widely read item in the paper.

Although her failing eyesight made composing her columns a difficult task, Mrs. Howell wrote every week in order to keep her readers up to date, she said.

Occasionally apologizing for her handwriting -- and also for her tendency for extended conversations -- Mrs. Howell would remark with a little grin, "The only thing about me that still works well is my

mouth."

In earlier years Mrs. Howell, a graduate of East Carolina Teacher's College, taught first grade at Western Wake Elementary School and also at Apex Elementary School. After retiring as a full-time teacher, Mrs. Howell continued in the school system as a substitute teacher.

Molly Weston and others who were in Mrs. Howell's later classes remember her fondly for making a day without their regular teacher a special day with the stories and games she shared with them.

Most of all, people remember Mrs. Howell for her generous spirit.

"I knew her all my life as a good friend and neighbor," said Doris Seymour. Seymour said among the most valued things given her by her friend were verses like the following:

*I would rather have one little rose from the garden of a friend than to have the choicest flowers when my stay on earth must end.*

*I would rather have one pleasant word in kindness said to me than flattery when my heart is still and life has ceased to be.*

*I would rather have a loving smile from friends I know are true than tears shed round my casket when this world I bid adieu.*

*Bring me all your flowers today, whether pink or white or red; I'd rather have one blossom now than a truckload when I'm dead.*

Monk drove for the day. We picked up Ned Perry in his home in Cary at 9:00 AM and had a brief visit in his home. Met his wife who has some health issues. Still she was pleasant. They gave both Monk and myself a copy of the book "A Part of Southern Franklin County Relations 1800-2004" by <sup>△</sup>Lillian B. Horton.

Drove to Franklin Co, NC where Ned had arranged for us to meet in the home of Ben + Hilda Perry. I had long wanted to meet Ben as he and I corresponded years ago. We stayed 2 hours & had a delightful visit.

wife = nee HILDA LEWIS - Her mother's name also nee LEWIS

The area of <sup>△</sup>Perry's Pond came from State of NC 1778

<sup>△</sup>Las Perry owned 3,000 Acres when he died.

I asked Ben about ownership of the shoreline of Perry's Pond. He claims to own it. There has been much controversy over this with the 10 owners who surround the pond. Ben has had surveys & tells a long story about this. Later Ned said the turbulent raising of the dam created an ambiguous situation.

I showed Ben my maps of Dennis TSP and entered numbers (13) - (18) in blue as we talked. As with Simon Rogers it was hard to get Ben to focus on my maps as to specific tracts. Here are notes:

(13) <sup>△</sup>GAY land - landlocked but they have always had a path for access.

(14) <sup>△</sup>PRIVETTE land - Juan Pinette <sup>△</sup>

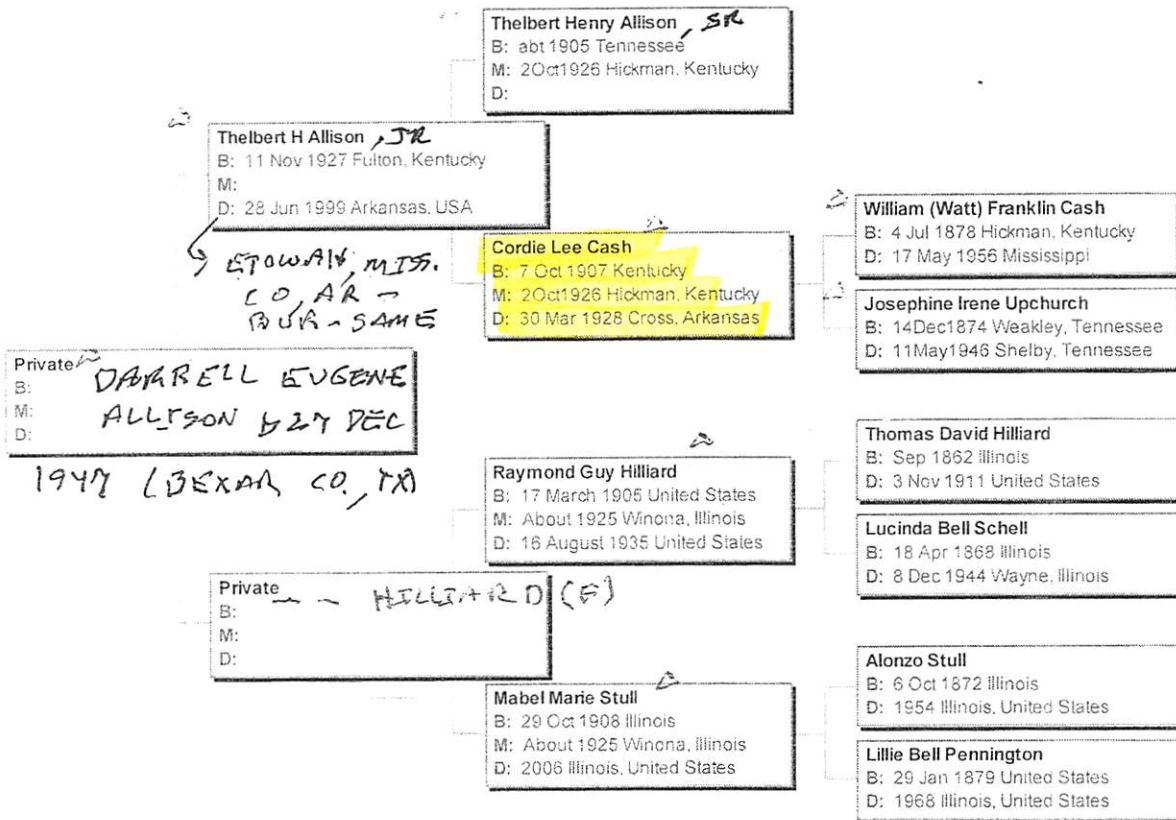

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 25, July 15, 1862, for the war. Absent sick from September 10, 1862, until returned to duty January-February, 1863. # Society raises \$15,000 to save home

Almost \$15,000 has been raised by the Apex Historical Society in its effort to save and restore the Maynard Pearson house on Olive Chapel Road.

The century-old house was home to two mayors, town doctors and a state legislator.

The Victorian farmhouse will, society members hope, be restored and saved for posterity through the efforts of the society and philanthropist Maurice Koury.

The society plans to make the house its headquarters and to furnish it with period furniture, making it available for educational purposes and community events. It will also become a place for storage of historical records.

The goal is to repair bay windows, fix verandas and brick chimneys to make the two story frame home look the way it did when Apex natives John K. Pearson and Woodrow Maynard were boys.

Both men have led their support to the restoration and fund-raising effort.

Pearson sold the house and adjacent land last year to Robert Swain, a Cary developer who is building the Dogwood subdivision behind the house.

Later, the house was obtained by Koury, of Burlington, who has been working with the society to save it.

The exact date of construction of the house is unknown, but it is believed to date back at least as far as 1870, if not earlier. The town of Apex was not incorporated until 1873.

The house was built by Jackson Maynard and Civil Pearson.

Woodrow Maynard, 75, was born on South Salem Street, but remembers visiting the house as a youngster. His uncle, Dixon Maynard, lived in the house and was one of the town's earliest mayors.

His wife's father, Fred Cash, Sr., later become mayor.

The house was the center of a tobacco farming operation, Maynard said. In the early days, Apex was a leading tobacco farming region.

The Historical Society has a deadline to raise \$37,000 by Jan. 31 for exterior repairs. The property owner wants assurances that the community is serious about saving the structure, according to Don Grimes, who is leading the campaign for funds and in-kind services along with his wife, Laura.

He said the initial phase of renovation is expected to be completed by April, again with the knowledge that the property owners want the site cleaned up and presentable.

Grimes said the society may spend as much as \$150,000 ultimately in rehabilitating the house. The majority of the money will go to upgrading wiring and providing central heating and air conditioning.

Grimes said the owner has agreed to convey title to the house to the society at no cost on the condition that plans are made for the necessary improvements and adequate funds raised for that purpose.

Paul Formberg, a senior restoration specialist for the state, supports the project. He says the house is in very good condition considering its age. The project is a rare chance to save a historic structure in an area where most old buildings are being lost, he said.

Grimes said the house is one of only three houses of its vintage still left in the Apex area.

Community volunteers have been working on Saturdays to clean up the property, he said. "We have got a tremendous amount of work done," he added.

PITTSBORO — An Apex man who had been charged in an accident that claimed his fiancée's life a day before they were to be married will not be tried on the death by motor vehicle charge.

Kirk R. Cash, 21, of Rt. 2, had been charged in the death of Jodie Lynn Williamson, 19, of Apex, who was killed Feb. 24 when her 1971 Ford Maverick skidded on an icy patch of U.S. 64 and hit a pickup.

The couple were returning home from Pittsboro, where they had gone to pick up a marriage license. The office had been closed due to inclement weather.

Cash was driving at the time of the accident. He said Miss

Williamson had told him she was afraid to drive on the snow-covered roads.

Cash also had been charged with driving too fast for the icy conditions, driving left of center and having no driver's license.

In Chatham County District Court, the charges of death by vehicle and driving left of center were dropped.

Cash was assessed fines on the other two charges.

Miss Williamson, who had turned 19 the day of her death, was buried Feb. 26 in her wedding gown. The funeral was held at Mt. Pisgah Church, which was to have been the site of the couple's wedding the day before.

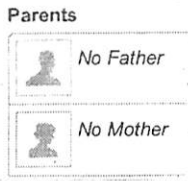

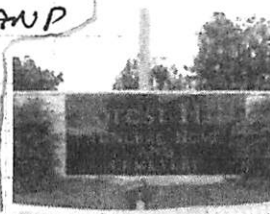

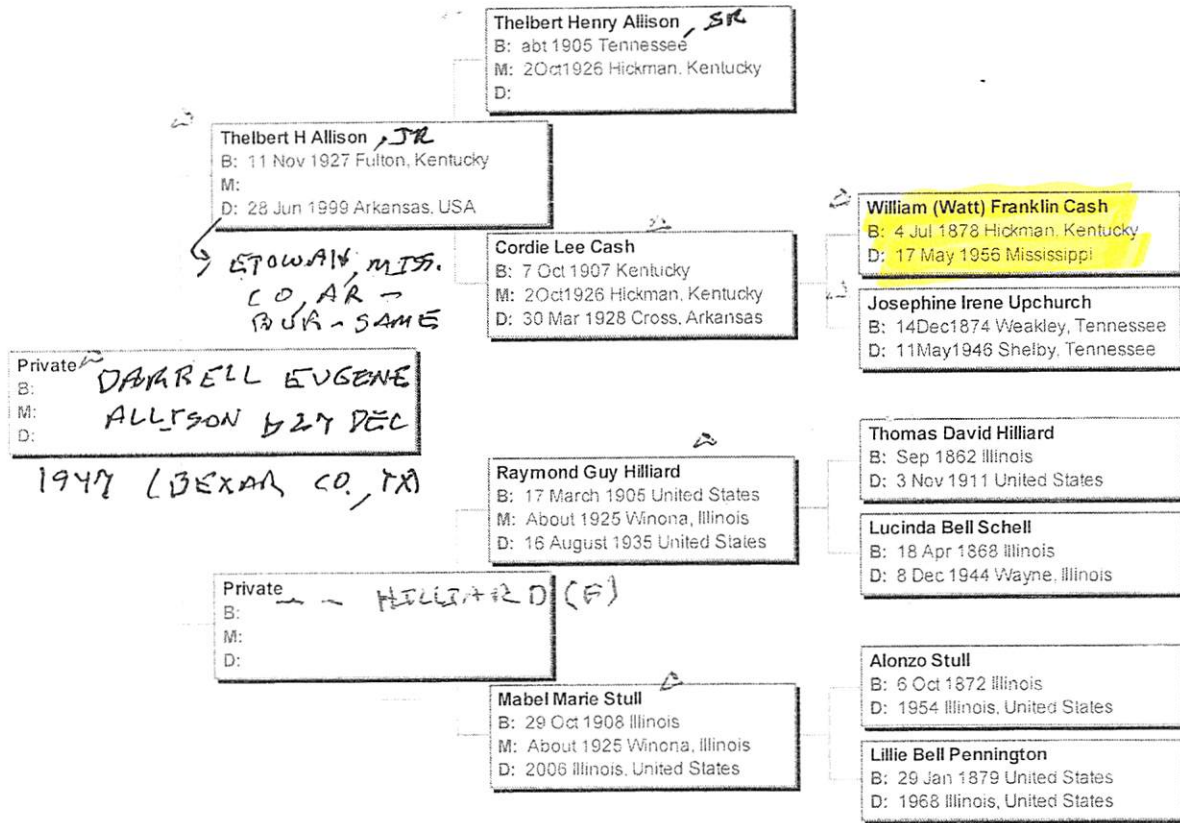
