Jesse had clearly in his mind that his grandfather Claburn Upchurch, I "Cleaborn" moved from NC to GA. Jesse recalls key items about his family: [Note – The writer JTU clearly writes his name as Jessie in this letter]

- I. Richard Upchurch, III Head of Clan
  - A. Claburn Upchurch, I had 4 boys & 2 girls Lived Henry Co, GA
    - 1. James Upchurch [James Monroe Upchurch, I] married ( ) Elizabeth McGarity [Sarah Elizabeth McGarity} lived and died in Henry Co, GA had 5 boys, 4 girls.
    - 2. William Upchurch [William Claburn Upchurch] married ( ) Catherine --- --- and moved to TX Hallasville or Hemphill [Has to be Hallettsville, Lavaca Co, TX RPU] before the "Old Revolutionary War" [Had to be Civil War RPU]
    - 3. \*Jasper Upchurch went to TX with William Upchurch (#2) and stayed 6 years came back to Henry Co, GA in 1860 before war broke out. He died 1911 (Henry Co, GA) Father of Jessie Tyre Upchurch
    - 4. \*Britt Upchurch [James Britton Upchurch] married () <u>Susan Elizabeth</u> <u>Chaffin</u>. They moved to AR 1859. <u>She</u> lived corner of Choctaw Ave. & Vine St in Hackett, AR until she died about 1912.
    - \*Married sisters



[Note: The above report by Jessie Tyre Upchurch that her Uncle William Claburn Upchurch moved to TX brings conflicting information which needs to be resolved:

- a. There is a William Upchurch age 37 (born about 1823) (GA) on the 1860 census of Lavaca Co, TX and he has a wife Catherine --- ---.
- b. However, I previously assumed this TX Upchurch was William Green Upchurch son of Charity Upchurch. [William Green Upchurch is a 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin of William Claburn Upchurch]. c. Subsequent records of locations and children of William Claburn Upchurch and William Green Upchurch tend to suggest that Jasper Upchurch went to TX with William Green Upchurch not William Claburn Upchurch. Jasper Upchurch not found on TX records RPU 26 Feb 2004]
- (1) Susan E Chaffin married 5 Jan 1850 Britton Upchurch born 1825 in Hancock Co, GA. Britton Upchurch was son of Claburn Upchurch who moved to GA in 1822.
- (2) See letter 10 Jul 180 Elna Era Burkhalter to RPU Britton Upchurch born 1825 (Hancock, GA) married 5 Jan 1850 Susan Elizabeth Chaffin.
- (3) See letter 5 Oct Grace Upchurch to RPU Susan Elizabeth Chaffin was buried with her husband Britton Upchurch in Pleasant Hill Cemetery two miles east of Hackett, AR. Dates on her stone are 22 Sep 1829 7 Sep 1914. On his stone 3 May 1825 26 Jul 1897. Note on a chart shows she was born near Atlanta, GA.
- (4) See notes of RPU call 23 Dec 1983 to Grace NMN Upchurch Susan Elizabeth Chaffin died in Hackett, AR. Grace remembers when her grandmother Susan died. The local school was closed and the funeral was held in the Baptist Church. Grace felt very important.
- (5) See letter 18 Apr 1984 Marion Maude Upchurch to RPU I have a faint recollection of my grandmother, Susan Elizabeth (Chaffin) Upchurch. I remember going to her funeral and that she always kept rock candy.
- (6) See Britton for his family on census Cole TSP, Sebastian Co, AR 30 Jul 1880. In home is his wife Elizabeth S Upchurch [Elizabeth Susan Chaffin] age 50 born GA, father born VA, mother born GA.
- (7) See letter 22 Jul 1984 Jacquelyn Jane Johnson to RPU Susan Elizabeth Chaffin was named Elizabeth Susan Chaffin by her father in his will. Susan Elizabeth Upchurch was a sister of Lucinda Chaffin. They are daughters of Tyre Chaffin born 23 Jan 1797/ Lucinda Chaffin married 1<sup>st</sup> Seaborn S Chaffin (son of Joel Chaffin) and after he died in Civil War she married Jasper Upchurch, a brother of Britton Upchurch who married Susan Elizabeth Chaffin.

Jesse Tyre Upchurch was born in Henry County, GA April 26 1894, died November 23, 1970 and buried at Bethany Baptist on GA Hwy 81 about 3 mile east of McDonough. He married Arried Minda Turner (March 17, 1889, d May 10, 1969) on December 1, 1909 in Rockdale County, GA. They lived in Rockdale County (Jesse was a farmer), until his father passed away. Jasper Upchurch (Oct 16, 1830 - Oct 12, 1911). then he moved back home and lived with his mother, Lucinda Abigail Chaffin (September 28, 1838 - July 11, 1924)

Jesse and Minda first child, Lucinda Vesti Upchurch [my mother] was born January 8, 1911. All of the other children was born in Henry County, GA. 2nd, Minnie Ruth U. July 2, 1914 - August 8, 1986 3rd, William Lamar U, December 24, 1917 still living in Macon, GA. 4th, Mary Frances U, January 29, 1921, still living in Conyers, GA 5th, Tyre Ellis U, April 1, 1924 still living on the farm that Jesse U purchased in 1940. Lucinda know as 'Lucy' by friend and family passed away April 26, 1988. On February 1, 1930, she married Doyle Akin Jinks 9June 1, 1903 - September 16, 1973. #10 child was Lucinda Abigail b Sep 28, 1838 d July 11, 1924, married married Mar 21, 1858 to Seaborn S Chafin, Rockdale Co had 3 daughters. Seaborn was killed in Civil War. Then she married Jasper Upchurch on Dec 30, 1867. [was this marrying for money? Lucinda had gotten the farm from her father, Tyre Chaffin in his will]

I read where Claborn Upchurch was one of the first members of Bethany. Therefore his children could have been members.

Jasper & Lucinda Upchurch as young married couple lived near the old Sharon Baptist Church. She lived on the land that her father Tyre Chaffin had left her when he died 1878. She had 2 small young daughters from her married to Seaborn Chafin who killed in the Civil war. Jasper, also served in the Civil War.

In the "Will Book" page 80,

Henry County, Last will and Testament of Tyre Chaffin, sign 23 March 1853. To my wife Frances of 35 years during her natural life or widowhood, only remainder of my estate after payment of my debts. After which everything sold and divided between my children viz: John J. Chaffin, Nathan P. Chaffin, Moses B. Chaffin, Emily F Jones, William F. Chaffin, Elizabeth S Upchurch [Susan Elizabeth Chaffin - married James Britton Upchurch, son of Claburn Upchurch, I], Jefferson T Chaffin, John W Chaffin, David J Chaffin, Lucinda A Chaffin, and George M Chaffin. Appoint wife Frances and son William T Chaffin Executors. Witness David Knott, Elihue Copeland, Asa R Brown. Probates 1 April 1878. A A Lemon, Ordinary

With Jasper & Lucinda living close to Sharon Baptist, they were members there. Tyre Chaffin help start Sharon church in 1825.
