

HICKS B. CHAPPELL XID 18905

Commentary: Hicks (Hix) Benjamin Chappell was born in 1831 in South Carolina and died in 1905 in Pickens County, Alabama. He was the second husband of Sara Frances Upchurch-Fullerton. This marriage did not produce any children. She was the daughter of Bartley Upchurch and the granddaughter of Abel Upchurch, head of clan #8. Hicks was a minister and it appears he was called to a church in Pickens County, Alabama where in 1902 he married the widow, Sarah.
