On 28 SEP 2005 RPA scanned monuments in Maple-wood Cemetery in Durham, NC & saw a 4' high 5' wide Headstone labeled "CREEK-UPCHURCH". Nearby stone showed the following

Later research revealed that #4 = CHARLIE LINWOOD, U, JR

s/o Charlie Linwood U, Sr & G's/o Josiah Curdson of the Nathan U, I/Buster U Subclass - funeral U Line. #4 md Thelma Lee Cheek who is buried in the same plot (No 32) but apparently without a monument.

A good guess would be that Thelma is a sister of #3 and that both are children of #1 & #2. Plot No 32 is owned by Mrs D.M. Cheek (presumably #2)

Some records show CLU, Sr & CLU, Jr as having the first name CHARLES but the preponderance of evidence shows CHARLIE

DETAILS RE CO "I"

CHEEK, G. P., Private

Enlisted in Orange County on 20 October 1863, for the war. Captured at Rappahannock Station, Virginia, 7 November 1863, and confined to Point Lookout, Maryland. No further records.

CHEEK, Julius M., Corporal

Previously served in Company G, 28th Regiment N.C. Troops. Transferred to this company on 18 March 1863, with the rank of Private. Wounded at Rappahannock Station, Virginia, 7 November 1863. Promoted to Corporal on 1 December 1863. Killed at Cold Harbor, Virginia, 7 June, 1864.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

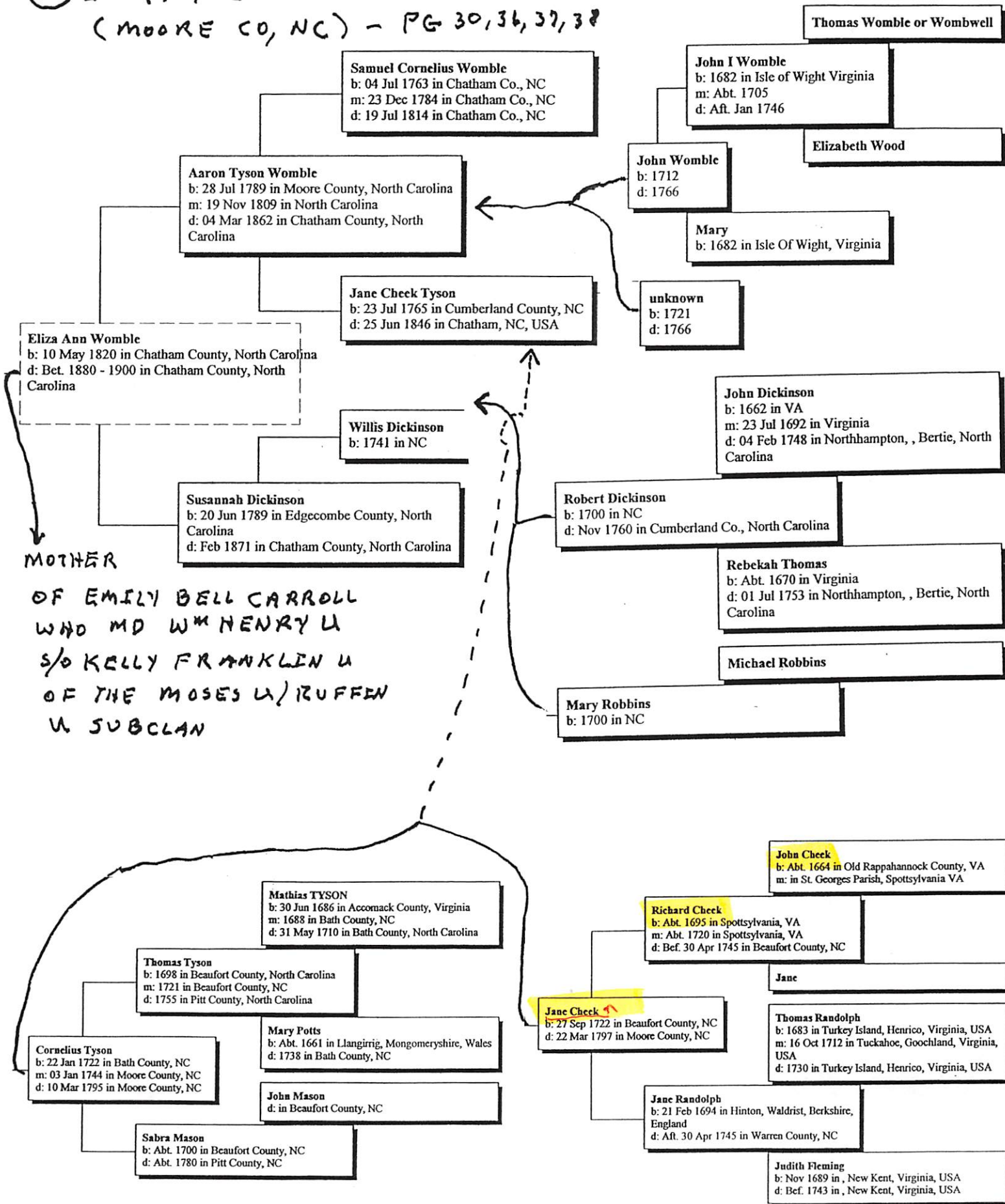

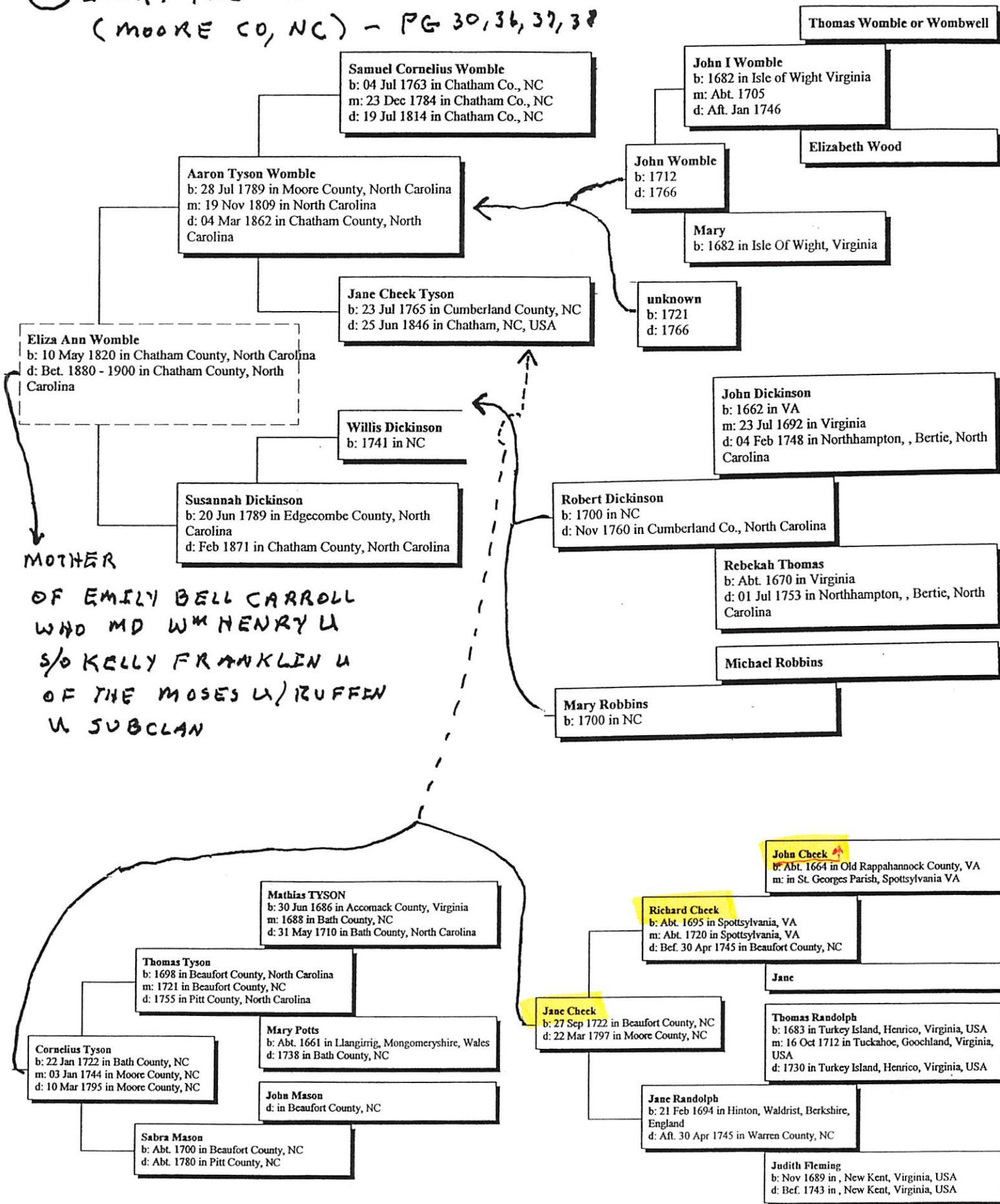

DETAILS RE CO "I"

CHEEK, G. P., Private

Enlisted in Orange County on 20 October 1863, for the war. Captured at Rappahannock Station, Virginia, 7 November 1863, and confined to Point Lookout, Maryland. No further records.

CHEEK, Julius M., Corporal

Previously served in Company G, 28th Regiment N.C. Troops. Transferred to this company on 18 March 1863, with the rank of Private. Wounded at Rappahannock Station, Virginia, 7 November 1863. Promoted to Corporal on 1 December 1863. Killed at Cold Harbor, Virginia, 7 June, 1864.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

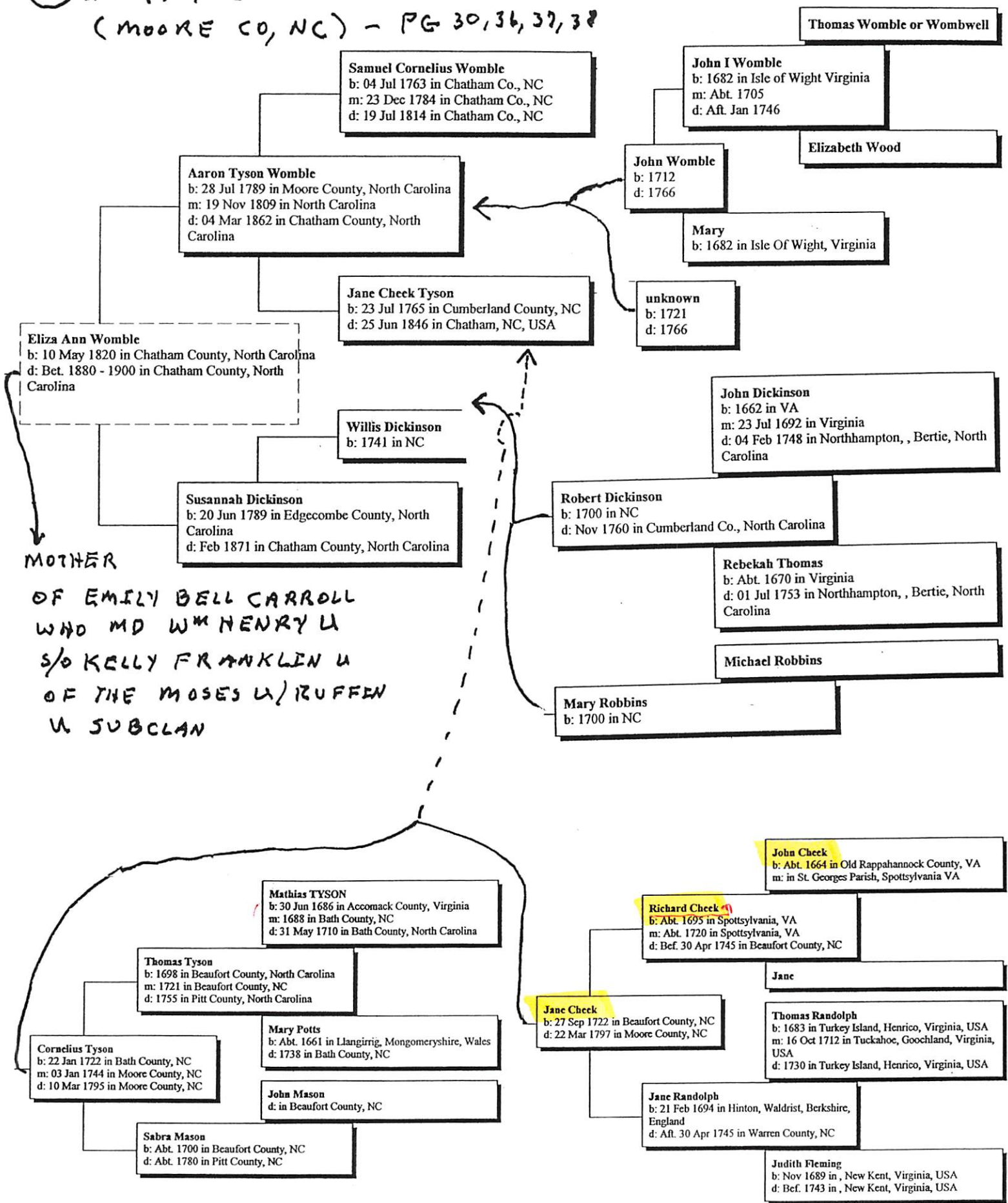
