Lewis was already wealthy and had a farm, a plantation large enough for 20-some slaves on what is now Old Garner Road that Wm. took over when his father and brother went west. (I have seen a 1938 deed with a map that showed that road was even then clearly marked as Holleman Road.) And I think I now know how Lewis acquired that property. He had already bought several of the original lots as laid out in the 1792 Plan of Raleigh and they are shown on an 1832 update map.
