Phil, Carla and Kim -

I always look forward to hearing from my AF's family 😊

Kim, thank you so much for remembering; that means so much. I can't wait for confirmation of the location of what our branch of the Phillips' family calls the High House. Virginia Dupree Phillips b 10-30-1920, my mother's youngest sibling, grew up there. As did my mother, Meta Pearl Phillips Monteleon b 08-04-1914 (she turns 104, this summer). Recently, Dupree verbally described the close/general area. A few weeks ago my 1st cousin, Emma Sue Richards Edwards, described the location to within about ¼ acre. From the intersection of Lizard Lick Road and Riley Hill Road, go W to Rocky Branch. At the branch and on the N side of Riley Hill Road, go a few hundred feet?/yards? W. It's there, somewhere, as I understand it. So I went there to take another look. The house was razed not all that many years ago, so I'm still looking for the exact site.

My maternal grandfather, Oliver Newton Phillips, b 1880, was the first Phillips to reside in the house. He gave/sold land immediately? next door to his eldest son, Wesley Floyd Phillips b 04-01-1901. My Uncle Floyd's daughter, Stella Phillips Massey b 1930, recently told me she grew up in the latter house.
