

Commentary: Claburn Upchurch I was born in 1789 in Franklin County, North Carolina, and died in 1862 in Clayton County, Georgia. He was a son of Richard Upchurch III, head of Upchurch Clan #4. Claburn married in 1809 in Franklin County, North Carolina. His wife was Amey Bunn from one of the Bunn neighbors of the Upchurches in Dunn township of Franklin County. The couple moved to Georgia following the Charles Upchurch family (Charles being the uncle of Claburn. This was one of several Upchurch streams of migration that took different parts of the Upchurch family to Georgia. Two of the twelve children born to Claburn and Amey Upchurch would marry Upchurch cousins.

They moved to Hancock, GA in 1822, then to Henry Co, GA in 1832 to join a colony of Upchurches who had gone to GA from NC. Claburn and Amey died in Clayton Co, GA, their property having been separated from Henry County” “Sarah Elizabeth Upchurch the 12th child of Claburn and Amey (Bunn) Upchurch was born on 11 Oct 1838 and died 18 Dec 1825 – married 28 Sep 1852 James Monroe Upchurch (1834 – 1892). They died in Cass Co, TX.” (28)

Harbird Upchurch is a new unidentified Upchurch. At this point I speculate that Abner and Harbird were both sons of Eaton Upchurch. Slots are available for both and they would have been old enough to have been awarded Land Grants in 1832. Note that Camp A. Upchurch named as son Harbird Upchurch possibly after his brother – RPU 16 Feb 2004]

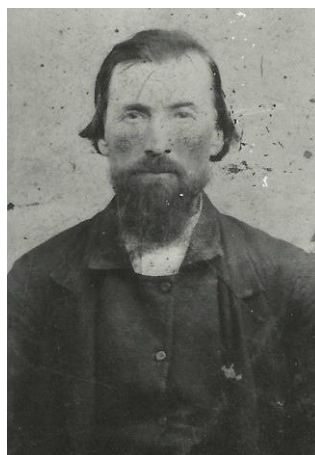
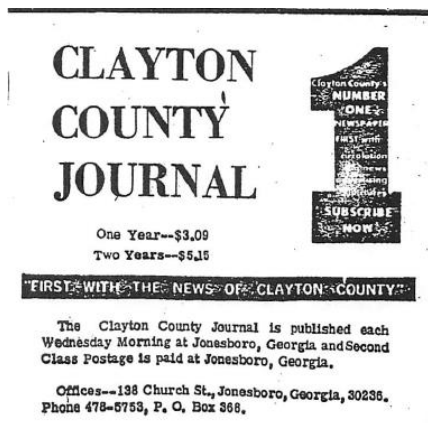

2. William Upchurch [William Claburn Upchurch] married () Catherine --- ---and moved to TX – Hallasville or Hemphill [Has to be Hallettsville, Lavaca Co, TX – RPU] – before the “Old Revolutionary War” [Had to be Civil War – RPU]
 3. *Jasper Upchurch – went to TX with William Upchurch (#2) and stayed 6 years – came back to Henry Co, GA in 1860 before war broke out. He died 1911 (Henry Co, GA) Father of Jessie Tyre Upchurch
 4. *Britt Upchurch [James Britton Upchurch] married () Susan Elizabeth Chaffin. They moved to AR 1859. She lived corner of Choctaw Ave. & Vine St in Hackett, AR until she died about 1912.

[Note: The above report by Jessie Tyre Upchurch that her Uncle William **Claburn Upchurch** moved to TX brings conflicting information which needs to be resolved:
