Commentary: Cloe Jane Upchurch (XID 993) was born about 1802 in Franklin County, NC. She died sometime after 1860 in Madison, TN. She was the daughter of James Upchurch VII – head of the Richard Upchurch III/James Upchurch VII sub-clan. Much still needs to be researched in regards to her life and descendants.

“Cloe Upchurch married John Cooley 19 Mar 1823- Bondsman and witness = Jerh Upchurch and S. Patterson

(2) Per Attach #27 West Letter 18 May 1875- Upchurch will extract= Franklin Co, NC- “Ames Upchurch in 1 May 1833 will names wife Thaney, sons Kearney and Jamison and 3 daughters including Elna, wife of John Cooley, Fr. See James Upchurch for details.

The spelling of the daughter referred to in (2) above appears to be “CLOA” but in view of (1) above will be written henceforth as CLOE. The “Elva” in (2) clearly wrong.

356. James Upchurch 1 May 1833 Mar Ct 1850 (Bk N, p. 318)

To my wife Thany- lend to her for life 400 acres where I now live; also negroes Esther, Richard, Rilly, Abram, Clary & Harriet; livestock, household & kitchen furniture, farming utensils, crops. To my son Kearney-278 acres on Mocoso Creek joining Burkley Upchurch, Larkin Upchurch, John Pearce & others, where he now live; at my wifes death, I also five him half the negroes I have lent her. To my son Jimmison- 400 acres where I now live; the other half of my negroes that I have loaned my wife. At my wife’s death, the residue of my estate to be sold & the money to be divided among my children & granddaughters as follows: Gilly Ray the wife of James Ray, Elizabeth Phillips the wife of John Phillips, Cloa Cooley the wife of John Cooley Jr, Thomas Upchurch, Jimmison Upchurch & my granddaughter Lecy Upchurch.

Note: This is the family of James Upchurch, VII- head of the Richard Upchurch III/James Upchurch VII sub-clan. Since the 1833 will of James Upchurch, VII does not mention a son Williford Upchurch, it is presumed that Williford Upchurch died before 1833- but a best guess is that granddaughter Lecy Upchurch is the daughter of Williford Upchurch. The son Thomas Upchurch, alive in 1833 is yet to be identified otherwise in the records. RPU)
