As regards the report on the Cherokee Nations you sent, I have created a file sheet, copy enclosed, which has been placed in the Biofile system and in the Indian file. In placing these sheets into the system I found several names already there that were similar but no real information that they are the same as the 7 from your report. Thus, at this time we will consider these as 7 new individuals added to our file system. I constantly add new sheets (names) from various sources and at some point we learn how some of them fit into the family.

The information you sent is appreciated. You never know when a new item of information will prove to be of great value.

I hope we can continue to work together and make some progress on the family. Your offer to search for records is appreciated and I have an idea in that regard as indicated below. At this time I suggest three courses of action:

- would you have another look at my letter of 3 SEP 1997 to you and let me know if

you have details to supply that would be useful and if you have questions growing out of this letter to you.

- Do you have any questions for me, generally speaking, about your Upchurch heritage
- As a special activity would you be willing to search for any 1800 or 1900 records for Rutherford Co, TN and Wilson Co, TN where an Upchurch family member (one or more) are mentioned. Although we have some census records they might be profitably revisited. I have in mind also, especially, wills, deeds, marriage records, estate settlements, newspaper articles, etc, etc. These two counties are very important for the Upchurch family and not enough has been done to get all the records in hand. When possible it would be nice to have full copies of original documents. If you undertake this project, at whatever pace suits you, I'll be glad to review any details produced and establish, if possible, relevance to our family tree

Dear Phil,

Hi again. I have been hoping to get a few free minutes to go over these before I sent them because it's been years since I've even looked at them, but it never seems to happen so I thought I would send them off anyway and maybe you can glean something from them before we chat again.

The quality is terrible and I apologize, but the condition of a lot of the microfilm at the Library of Congress isn't too great, and on top of it I'm making copies of copies. What I tried to do was copy the page as it exists on the sheet of microfilm and then enlarge the section that pertains to the Upchurch family.

As you can see, sometimes there's more than one family on a sheet. Also, there is more than one county included. If memory serves me correctly, at the time I was copying these I didn't have a clue which line Julia came from so I tried to get information on whatever I could for the Upchurch line.

The typewritten insert on the Indian claims is something I xeroxed because I thought it would be relevant since Julia was

rumored to have a Cherokee mother. I haven't really studied the contents at all and have done nothing more to pursue this line.

I started out tracing my roots about 7 years ago and did a lot on my paternal grandmother's side but was not able to find out much on the grandfather's side other than what I have sent you here. My grandfather (Luie Delmer Colbaugh) appears to have been absent most of my father's life so much of his side is a mystery.

Again, I apologize for the quality of the copies. I hope you can get something useful out of them. Please let me know what I can do to aid in our search with the resources I have here in D.C. I would be more than glad to do it if I was just directed which way to look next!

Thanks again for your interest. Looking forward to hearing from you soon.

INTRODUCTION

On the 12 rolls of this microfilm publication are reproduced the report and related records of Special Commissioner Guion Miller. In 1906 Mr. Miller was appointed by the U.S. Court of Claims to determine who was eligible for funds under the treaties of 1835-36 and 1845 between the United States and the Eastern Cherokee. Mr. Miller submitted his report and roll on May 28, 1909, and submitted a supplementary report and roll on January 5, 1910.

An act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat. 726), gave the Court of Claims jurisdiction over any claim arising under treaty stipulations that the Cherokee tribe, or any band thereof, might have against the United States and over any claims that the United States might have against any Cherokee tribe or band. Suit for such a claim was to be instituted within 2 years after the act was approved. As a result, three suits were brought before the court concerning grievances arising out of the treaties. These suits were (1) The Cherokee Nation v. The United States, General Jurisdiction Case No. 23199; (2) The Eastern and Emigrant Cherokees v. The United States, General Jurisdiction Case No. 23212; and (3) The Eastern Cherokees v. The United States, General Jurisdiction Case No. 23214.

On May 18, 1905, the court decided in favor of the Eastern Cherokees and instructed the Secretary of the Interior to ascertain and identify the persons entitled to participate in the distribution of more than \$1 million appropriated by Congress on June 30, 1906, for use in payment of the claims. The task of compiling a roll of eligible persons was begun by Guion Miller, then special agent of the Interior Department. In a decree of April 29, 1907, the court vacated that part of its earlier decision that gave the Secretary of the Interior responsibility for determining the eligibility of claimants and appointed Mr. Miller as a special commissioner of the Court of Claims.

The decree also provided that the fund was to be distributed to all Eastern and Western Cherokee Indians who were alive on May 28, 1906, who could establish the fact that at the time of the treaties they were members of the Eastern Cherokee Tribe of Indians or were descendants of such persons, and that they had not been affiliated with any tribe of Indians other than the Eastern Cherokees or the Cherokee Nation. The decree further provided that claimants should already have applications on file with the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, or should file such applications with the special commissioner of the Court of Claims on or before August 31, 1907. According to the decree, applications for minors and persons of unsound mind were to be filed by their parents or persons having their care and custody, and applications for persons who had died after May 28, 1906, were to be filed by their children or legal representatives.

In his report of May 28, 1909, Guion Miller stated that 45,847 separate applications had been filed, representing a total of about 90,000 individual claimants, of which 30,254 were enrolled as entitled to share in the fund--3,203 residing east and 27,051 residing west of the Mississippi River. On June 10, 1909, the court confirmed and approved the roll of Eastern Cherokees who were entitled to share in the distribution of the fund as submitted by the special commissioner of the Court of Claims with his report of May 28, 1909, except "so much as shall be expected [excepted] to on or before August 30, 1909." After the exceptions had been filed and investigated, Mr. Miller submitted a supplemental report and roll to the court on January 5, 1910. In this report he stated that about 11,750 exceptions had been made; that names of 610 persons, of which 238 resided east and 372 resided west of the Mississippi, had been added to the roll; and that names of 44 persons, 5 residing east and 39 residing west of the river, had been stricken from the roll because clerical errors in enrollment had been discovered. Thus the final figure on the total number of persons entitled to share in the fund was 30,820, of which 3,436 persons resided east and 27,384 resided west of the Mississippi River. On March 15, 1910, the court finally decreed that the rolls be approved and that, after certain deductions for expenditures, payments were to be made equally among the Eastern Cherokees who were enrolled. The court also authorized the Secretary of the Treasury to issue a warrant in favor of each person.

In certifying the eligibility of the Cherokees, Mr. Miller used earlier census lists and rolls that had been made of the Cherokees by Hester, Chapman, Bremen, and others between 1835 and 1884. Copies of some of these rolls and the indexes to them are filed with the Guion Miller records and are filmed as a part of this publication. Other enrollment records used by Mr. Miller are among the classified files of the Bureau and are designated as "33931-11-053 Cherokee Nation."

The records reproduced in this microcopy are in the National Archives and are part of Record Group 75, Records of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, with the exception of the Supplemental Roll of Eastern Cherokee, January 5, 1910, and Supplement to the Siler Roll, Act of Congress, July 31, 1874, which are part of Record Group 123; Records of the United States Court of Claims. A Census Roll, 1835, of the Cherokee Indians East of the Mississippi and Index to the Roll, which have been reproduced on Microcopy T-496, are also part of Record Group 75. Other records relating to the enrollment, including applications submitted by claimants, are in Record Group 123.

I am almost certain that you are a member of the John U, III / Stephen U subclass and of the Samuel Abner U, I line in that Sudan. The "A. U" age 61 on your 1870 Rutherford Co, TN census report would be Samuel Abner U, I.

Enclosed is a copy of my 5 Page Master outline for the Samuel Abner U, I Family including his children & grandchildren. Descendants of grandchildren, if any, if known, are covered in continuation sections (none enclosed) as shown by the numbers on the left hand side of the page. Note that I have penciled in the possibility for your Julia T. U as proposed in your letter. There

in the obvious question as to whether she ⁽²⁶⁾ married
 a Thomas Taylor (+ had a son Tom) as well as
 having married -- COLBAUGH. Perhaps you can
 work on this matter.

Note that I assign 12 children to Samuel Abner
 U, I, 9 from her 1st wife and 3 from his 2nd wife.
 My records show that his 2nd wife was Melissa
 (Chumley) Mullins whereas the 1870 census shows
 her wife as of that date as "ELIE age 42". I
 wonder if Melissa (Chumley) Mullins and "Elie"
 are one and the same or if Elie represents a
 3rd wife? I figure his 2nd batch of children
 (based on the 1870 census) are Anna b 1863, Thomas
