Long-time Cary resident

Long-time Cary resident Jessie Conner Heater, 88, died Oct. 27 at New Hanover Hospital in Wilmington. She was the wife of former Wake County Commissioner Russell O. Heater and the mother of county commissioner Robert Heater.

Mrs. Heater was a veteran of World War I — having joined the Navy Yeomen (F) in 1918 — as well as a charter member member of Cary American Legion Post 67. She also was a member of Cary United Methodist Church and a former member of the Cary Gourd Club. Mrs. Heater, who frequently was known as "Miss Jess" around Cary, traced her ancestors back to the 16th-century settlers of Virginia and the Carolinas. She was born in Rich Square, N.C., near Norfolk, Va. and attended Women's College in Greensboro.

Her service in the Navy came after then-Secretary of the Navy

Josephus Daniels — who was the publisher of the Raleigh News and Observer — decided that branch of service needed a new source of personnel for non-combatant jobs because the war had created such a huge demand for people.

And thus the Yeomen (F) — with the "F" standing for "female" — was born in 1917. The adventurous Mrs. Heater — then Jessie Conner — could not resist.

"The papers down (in Rich Square), the Virginia Pilot, I think, had a lot about it," said Mrs. Heater in an interview

with *The Cary News* a year ago. "Go and take the place of the boys," it said, and I just got on the train and went there (to Richmond) and enlisted."

But life in the Navy for Mrs. Heater didn't include exciting sea duty. For the most part, it consisted of working in the Navy shipyard in Portsmouth, Va., where she gave the men in a machine shop their daily work assignments.

She married Russell Heater in 1920, and shortly afterward the pair moved to Cary, where his father had a well company.

Russell Heater soon started

his own well company and eventually was elected to the board of commissioners, where he served for many years before he died in 1971. His extensive resume of service for the county, in civic organizations and his business earned him the nickname "Mr. Cary."

Their son Robert has served on the Wake County Board of Commissioners since his election in 1974.

Mrs. Heater is survived by: her son, who lives in Cary; three daughters, Mrs. Margorie Herring of Dallas, Mrs. Dorothy Bland of Topsail Island, and

Mrs. Ann Morgan of Smithfield; a sister, Mrs. Barbara Giertz of Libertyville, Ill.; 12 grandchildren; and 11 great-grandchildren.

The funeral was scheduled for 2 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 31, at Cary First United Methodist Church, and burial was to be at Hillcrest Cemetery.

The family was to receive visitors at Brown-Wynne Funeral Home in Cary from 7 to 9 p.m. on Friday.

The family has suggested that memorials be made to the Town of Cary Beautification Fund, Cary, 27511.

Original lady sailor recalls

Sitting in a chair in her living room, the elderly woman draws her legs up under her like a teen-ager and tells a male visitor 63 years her junior that if she were a few years younger, he'd have to watch out.

At 88 years old, Jessie Heater is still a little rambunctious, but that's no surprise. Four children, 12 grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren and 68 years ago this month, Mrs. Heater, who now lives on Dry Avenue, was one of the first women to join the Navy.

It was 1917, World War I was on, and Josephus Daniels, long-time publisher of the Raleigh News and Observer, was Secretary of the Navy. The war was draining the country of sorely-needed domestic manpower, and Daniels saw a way to fill the need.

"The Navy found itself in a very serious situation as to sufficient and capable stenographers, secretaries, clerks, intelligence officers and other positions of trust and responsibility," Daniels later recalled. "I said, 'Let me see the appropriations bill. It does not say that a yeoman must wear breeches, and it does not say anywhere that a yeoman must be a man.

"Enroll as many girls as you need in the Navy and save us in this emergency!"

And thus was born the Navy's Yeoman (F), often mispronounced as "Yeomanettes."

Mrs. Heater, then Jessie Conner, was living in Rich Square, N.C., near Norfolk Va. when she heard about the Yeoman (F).

"The papers down there, The Virginia Pilot, I think, had a lot about it, 'Go and take the place of the boys,' it said, and I just got on the train and went there and enlisted," she said.

And of all her experiences in her Navy service, the one she tells about with the most horror came right at the beginning, during her physical examination.

"I was a little bit bashful back then," she said. "They stripped me and gave me a sheet to put around me and took me back to a room and there was a boy from back home with just a sheet around him. I'll tell

you one thing, if there'd been a been a hole, I would have crawled in it. You should've seen us, me in one corner and him in another."

She enrolled Sept. 14, 1918, in Norfolk, and was assigned to the Navy shipyard in Portsmouth, Va. There she worked in a machine shop giving daily assignments to workers around the yard, including some dangerous ones.

"Well, I knew they were going to get killed, and then they would come to me and want me to identify them," she said.

And she had a mind of her own back then, too. Once one of her bosses came to her one day and

asked her to identify the body of a sailor she had assigned work to that morning. "He told me I had to do it," she said. "I told him I wouldn't. He said I would, and I told him 'I'd like to see you make me open my eyes.'"

But for the most part, she recalled, she did what she was told, because the men in the Navy didn't exactly enjoy the idea of female sailors.

"And the boys didn't like us being in the Navy. Lord help us," she said. "They didn't have anything to do with us. They didn't like us being in the Navy, but they didn't say what they thought, otherwise they'd have gotten in trouble."

So much for women's liberation in the early part of the century.

When the war was over, the Yeoman (F) women were discharged. Mrs. Heater's honorable discharge certificate, dated Oct. 26, 1919, lists "sex" as the reason she was discharged, a subject of much mirth in the Heater family over the years.

"Mother, it says they discharged you for reason of sex," said her daughter, Dorothy Bland, who lives on the coast and was visiting Sept. 19.

"Oh shut up," retorted her mother in a bemused tone. "Then, sex didn't mean the same thing it means now."

Mrs. Heater's hearing was damaged by the constant clamor in the machine shop, and after her discharge, the Navy paid her a disability pension, which continued until recent years.

She went back to Rich Square and got a job in a dress shop, where Russell Heater of Cary, who had been a lieutenant in the Army during the war, saw her one day in 1919. They were married in 1920, a union that made for some heated squabbles during radio broadcasts of the Army-Navy football game, Mrs. Bland recalled.

The pair eventually came to live Cary, where Russell Heater's father owned C.R. Heater Well Co. Russell Heater started his own well company, which became Heater Well Co., Inc. and eventually became a Wake County commissioner, an office he held for many years before he passed away in 1971.

Russell and Jessie's son Robert is a county commissioner now.

Besides Dorothy, they had two

other daughters, Marjorie and Anne, who are both married.

Though Mrs. Heater said she knew of only one other North Carolina woman who became a Yeoman (F), more than 11,000 were signed up during the war.

When they were disbanded, many of them joined the American Legion to keep their camaraderie alive. Mrs. Heater was one of these, becoming a charter member of the Cary post.

The Yeomen (F) also were granted a charter from Congress, on June 15, 1936, for their own organization, the National Yeomen F. This year, the organization would have had its golden anniversary but for the fact that the advanced age of the surviving members has not allowed them to keep the organization active.

Efforts have been made, and, to some extent, still continue to have a naval vessel named after a Yeoman (F) and to have a postage stamp printed to commemorate the group.

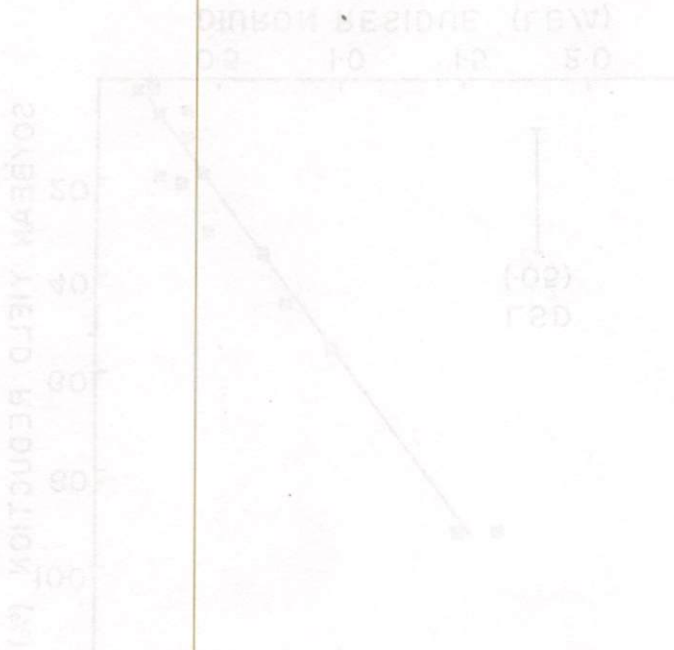

James Inglis b. About 1829 (Scotland) migrated to Randolph Co, NC where about 1855 (Coddwell Co; NC) he married Mary Ann U, Head of a line in the Richard U, III / Bookner U Silas U. This couple had 3 children before James was killed in the Civil War in GA. The Article imparts much information about

- John Inglis and his family some of which are listed here.
- James Inglis lived with his Uncle George Greenfield at first
 - The Greenfields in Randolph Co, NC in 1850 lived next door to the Silas U family who had a daughter Mary Ann U
 - In 1860 the Silas U & James Inglis families lived in Caldwell Co, NC
 - After the war the widow Mary Ann (U) Inglis moved with her parents (Silas U) to Greene Co, TN where she wd. widower Ambrose Usher who had several children.
 - Mary Ann & Ambrose had one child Navy Ann Usher who wd. William Taylor Conner
 - In the late 1870's Mary Ann was living with her G.P. Maggie Usher [D/o Ellie Inglis] and her husband in Loudon Co, TN.
