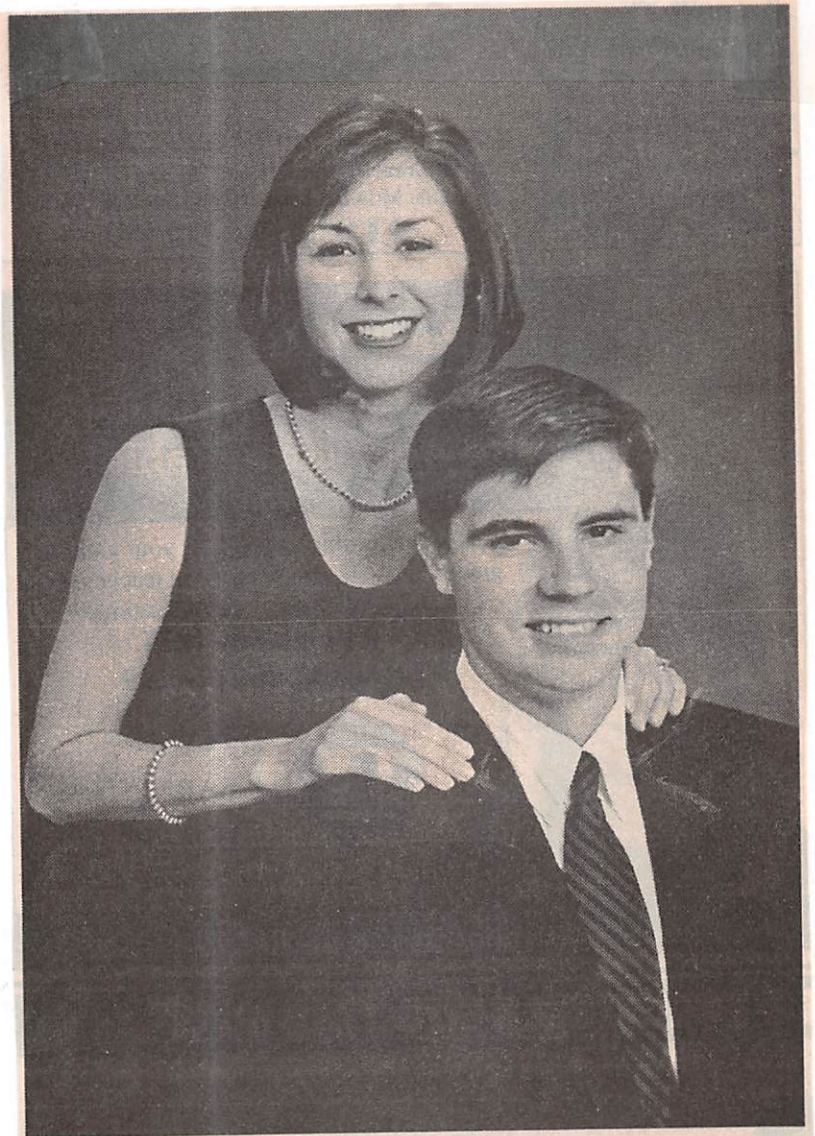

Corinth Baptist packs pews for 125th anniversary celebration

There is a phrase known in Baptist churches: "pack-a-pew."

When used, it means that a normal church pew usually holding 10 to 12 people comfortably has suddenly fit in as many people as humanly possible —

shoulder to shoulder with hardly any breathing room.

"Pack-a-pew" fit nicely, and tightly, Sept. 26 as Corinth Baptist celebrated its 125th anniversary.

"We're having a great day. This

is as big of a crowd as I can remember," said E.J. Corbett, a 78-year congregation member.

In honor of the historic feat, Corinth Baptist celebrated via its homecoming service. Corinth native the Rev. Ricky Anderson preached the sermon.

During its existence, 20 different pastors have handled pulpit duties. Pastor A.A. Pippin holds the record for the longest term (23 years spanning 1898-1920).

C.W. Driver, Corinth's first full-time pastor, was on hand for the celebration. "I think 125 years is great. I'm glad to be a part of that history," he said. "I also have experienced a highlight of my life today. What is now more than a couple years ago, I married a young couple named the Congletons. Today both of their children confessed to God."

A myriad of special events are recorded in the Corinth Baptist legacy. The plot of land where the church still stands was presented December 1874 by W.E. Pulley, his wife, Emma, and his brother, James.

Pulley operated a lemonade stand across the road from the church each year. It was his request to be buried on the site of that lemonade stand. The request was granted in 1905.

On Sept. 17, 1932, five members were forgiven for breaking church rules against dancing. On July 17, 1945, the parishioners voted to have their first vacation Bible school.

After the homecoming service on their recent celebration day, everyone was invited into the fellowship hall for a feast. Ham biscuits, deviled eggs, fried chicken and carrot cakes were just a few of the dishes filling eight or nine long tables.

Jason Hinton, 29, said, "I have been going to this church all my life. We have a good group of people here. I can't complain about the people or the food."

As members of Corinth Baptist waited patiently for their share of sustenance, they stopped to catch a glance at commemorative T-shirts and coffee mugs being sold.

A bulletin board also stood near the buffet line with an example of time's flight: In 1954, Corinth spent \$115.83 per year on insurance; now, it pays \$6,300 per year.

The most unusual, yet creative, part of the gala involved outfits worn. Everyone was encouraged to dress in old-fashioned clothes. And every decade seemed to be

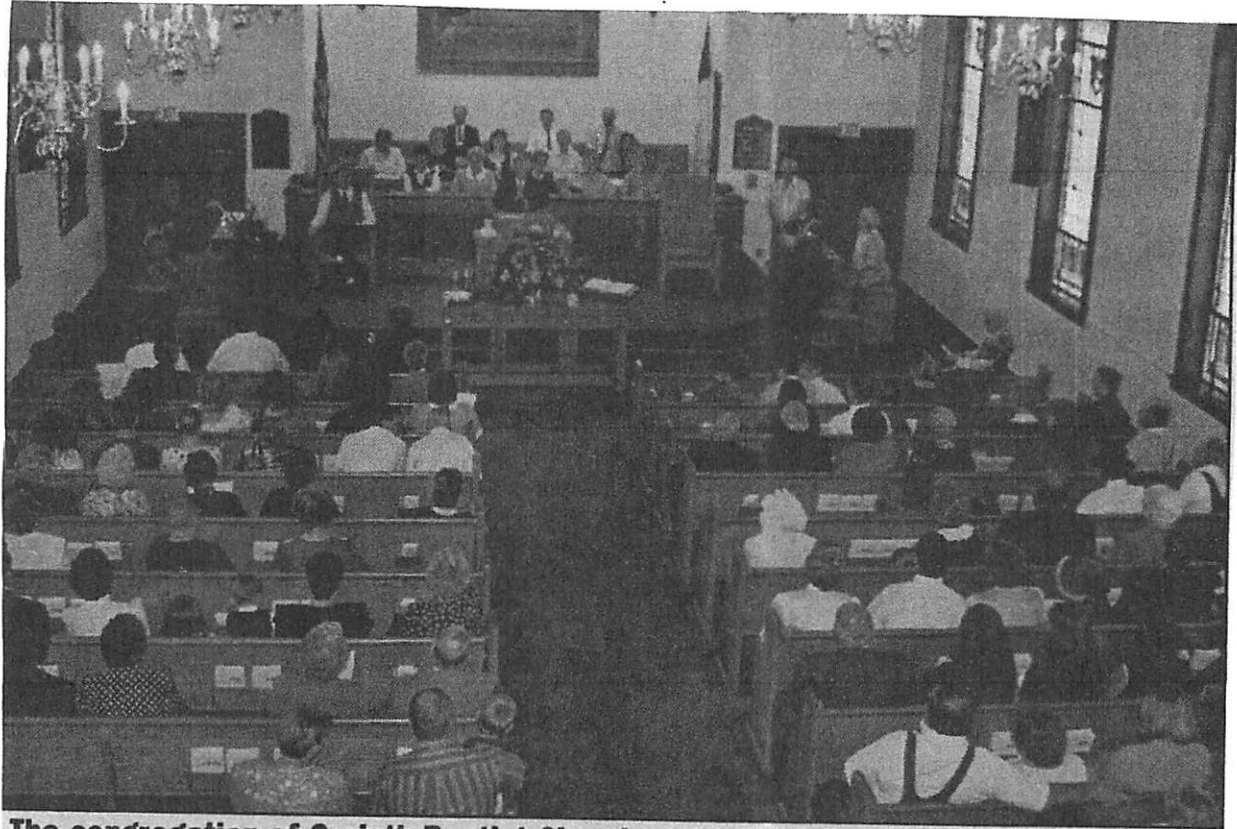
represented.

Some ladies displayed long dresses, others hung bonnets on their heads, and some carried shawls or umbrellas with lace. Men wore overalls, or suits with top hats. One man even drove his tractor to church and parked it in a paved parking space.

Homecoming is a special time of celebration in the life of churches. For Corinth Baptist, especially, the festivities touted more of a homecoming back — year after year after year.

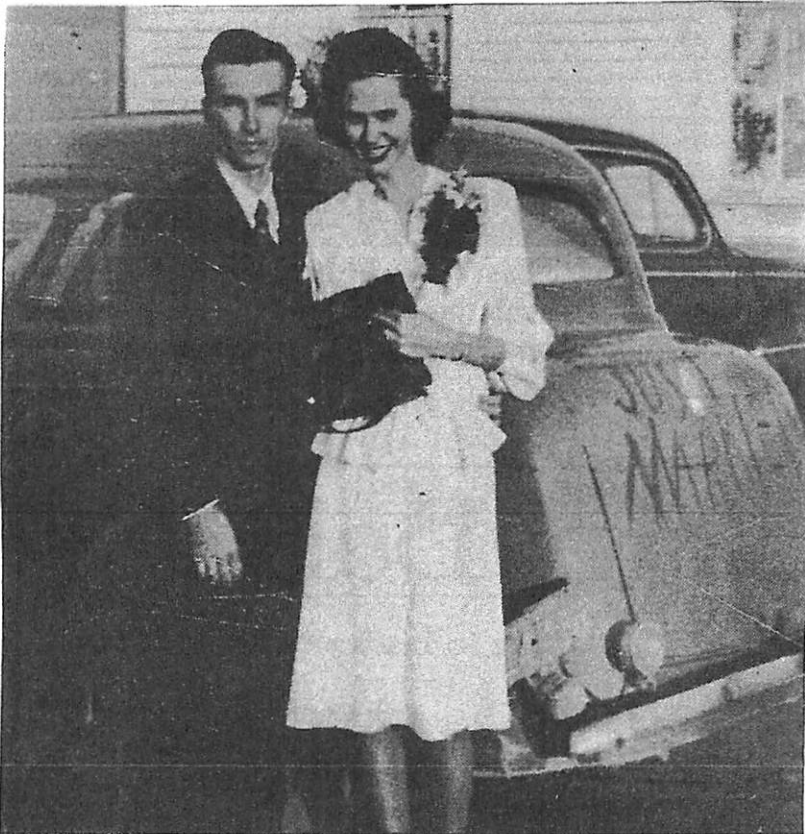
