**WHITE WOMAN IS
KILLED BY UNCLE**

**Miss Essie Upchurch, of Eagle
Rock, Shot Late Sat-
urday Night.**

Miss Essie Upchurch, formerly Mrs. Joris R. Bell, and a daughter of W. A. Upchurch, a well known citizen of the Zebulon section, was shot and instantly killed by her uncle, C. L. Cotton, at the home of her sister three miles from Eagle Rock, about midnight Saturday night. Cotton was released under a bond of \$1,000 at the direction of Solicitor Norris yesterday.

Killing of the woman was unintentional. Cotton was aiming at a man whose identity has not been established, who was in company with the dead woman at the time. They had just emerged from a tobacco house on the premises, and when they were accosted by Cotton, the man cursed him and threatened to shoot. Cotton shot first. The woman fell to the ground and the man fled.

Cotton who is a man of 45 and well known in his community, had gone to the house of his niece after supper Saturday night. Members of the family told him that they had suspicious that tobacco was being stolen from the strip-house, and he volunteered to watch the place for possible burglars. Armed with a shotgun he sat down to wait.

Miss Upchurch was seen to leave the dwelling earlier in the evening and go to the strip house. Later she returned to her room, and then went back to the strip house again. Between 11 and 12 o'clock Cotton saw her emerge from the house, accompanied by a man, according to the story he told of the killing to Solicitor Norris yesterday. He called on them to halt.

The man became abusive, cursed Cotton and threatened to shoot him, according to the man who did the shooting. He had a pistol, and was about to open fire when Cotton shot.

The woman dropped, shot through the left breast. She died without uttering a word. The man who was with her at the time ran, entering his automobile which had been left standing two hundred yards away.

Cotton immediately went in search of an officer and gave himself up. W. A. Upchurch, father of the woman who was killed, and brother-in-law to Cotton, signed his bond yesterday afternoon before T. Lloyd Tilley, deputy clerk of the court.

Von Ray and his second wife, Alma Harrison Ray, had seven children during their 24 year marriage (five sons and one daughter--one unnamed child was still born) as listed below:

1. Mack Eunice Ray was born on May 23, 1915. Mack (age 18) married Euva Frances Cotton (also age 18) on November 27, 1933. They had one daughter (Joann). Mack was a Sergeant First Class in the Army in World War II. Mack died at the age of only 33 on February 9, 1949 while on active duty stationed at Ft. Myer in Arlington, Virginia. He is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 1247).
2. Junius Hub Ray born in April 1916. Junius (age 22) married Ola Keith (age 18) on June 25, 1938. Junius and Ola had three children (Alma Lee, Nancy Ann, and Gene). Junius rented out his farm (property formerly owned by his father) and worked at textile mills in Butner and Durham, North Carolina. Junius died at age 69 in 1985 at Rex Hospital in Raleigh, N.C. (The same hospital where his father, Von Ray, died 46 years earlier.) He was over six feet tall and had blue eyes and black hair.
3. Alfonzo Columbus Ray, Jr. was born in April 1917 and was known as Von. Von (age 23) married Elenor Marshall in January of 1941 and they had six children (James, Joyce, Judy, Janice, Jerry and Johnny). Von worked at a lumber yard and also at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Von died of a heart attack at age 49 in 1966.
4. Woodrow Wilson Ray was born on May 22, 1918. Woodrow was named after the 28th President of the United States (1913-1921). Apparently Von Ray was a Democrat. From the age of about 16 until almost 21, Woodrow worked on his father's farm "in the production of crops." Woodrow enlisted in the Army on April 7, 1939 six weeks before his twenty-first birthday. While stationed at nearby Fort Butner in Granville County, North Carolina, Woodrow met his future wife, Coma Watson, at a post dance. Due to World War II, Woodrow's tour of duty was extended and he served six and one half years on active duty. Woodrow attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and spent his last year in the Army in Germany in Battery A of the 903rd Field Artillery Battalion. Woodrow was awarded three decorations and service medals: (1) European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with three bronze stars signifying participation in three combat campaigns (Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe), (2) Good Conduct Medal and (3) American Defense Service Medal. Woodrow married Coma Watson and they had seven children (Ronald Wilson, Linda Carol, Robert Lee, Ann Sherrill, Bradley Wayne, Susan Gayle, and Teresa Lynn). Woodrow was a policeman in Durham from 1945 until his death at age 52 on July 15, 1970. Woodrow was five feet eleven inches tall and had brown eyes and dark brown hair.
5. Frances Caroline Ray born on August 23, 1919. Caroline was a beautiful woman. She married Coy J. Forsythe and they had seven children (J.C., Crystal, Jean, Peggy, Eddie, Ray and David). Caroline died at age 62 on July 1, 1982.
6. Joseph Ray was born on August 29, 1923 and he was 16 years old when his father died in 1939. At age 21, Joe married Nina Dillard on October 28, 1944 and they had one child, Betty Ray. Joe worked as a machine adjuster at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Joe died at age 57 on November 13, 1980. Joe was approximately five feet seven inches tall and had blue eyes and black hair.

Ola Keith married Junius Ray in 1938 and she lived with her husband in the home of Von Ray, her father-in-law, for the last eighteen months of his life. Ola recalls Von stating that Joe was his seventeenth son. Joe is still referred to as Joe #17. Von Ray had twenty children — 17 sons and 3 daughters, but only 11 lived to be adults. Two of Von's sons, Percie and Mack, and one of his grandsons, Albert Ray, are honored by burial at Arlington National Cemetery. They rest on Virginia land across the Potomac River from the Lincoln Memorial on property once owned by Confederate General Robert E. Lee. Best known of more than one hundred national cemeteries in the United States, Arlington's green slopes shelter veterans from every war that has involved this nation. Percie (1893-1948) was a Corporal in the Army during World War I. Mack (1915-1949) was a Sergeant in the Army during World War II. Albert Ray (1923-1992), son of Percie and Elsie, served in the Navy for twenty years during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Albert retired as a Petty Officer First Class.

△ Eleanor Lewis Whitley attended Peace College in Raleigh and on July 16, 1938, married Joris Rickman Bell, Jr. of the Bethany commu-

nity. They built their home on the farm in that community, which was the home of Joris's grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Waylon Upchurch. Mr. and Mrs. Upchurch gave a section of this land for the building of Bethany Baptist Church and the establishment of a church cemetery in the early part of the century. After they inherited the farm, "Snooky" and "Joe," as they are better known, contributed another section of land for the enlargement of both the church and the cemetery and provided water also for the church.

△ Mrs. Waylon Upchurch was the former Ala O. Cotten of Creedmore. Her mother died at her birth and her Aunt, the well-known Sally Southall Cotton, took her into her home and raised her as a daughter. Mrs. Upchurch came to Bethany as a bride in 1897.

△△ Eleanor and Joris Bell have two children, △ Joris Rickman Bell, III, born Aug. 27, 1939, and Eleanor Florence Bell, born Aug. 22, 1941.

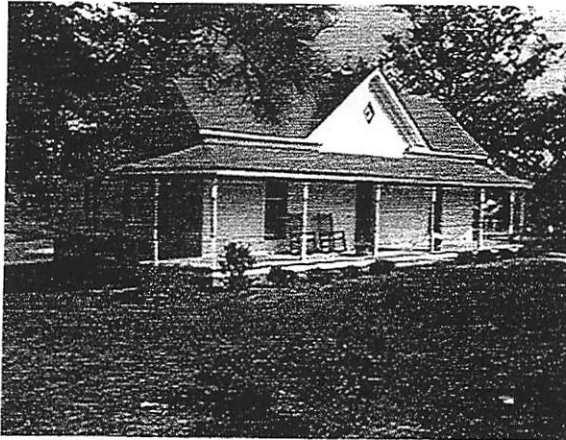

1910 Seagroves Farm House
1617 Center St, Apex, NC



John Henry Seagroves, a tenant farmer, bought this 92 acre farm for \$540 in 1904. In 1910, Seagroves and his wife, Nevada Pearl Mann, built this one-story house with a wrap-around porch. The Seagroves had 2 sons and 2 daughters.

The home is typical of the style built locally in that era, the one-story triple "A" house popular in western Wake County in the late nineteenth century. The Seagroves grew corn, cotton and tobacco.

One of the sons, J Q Seagroves, lived in the house until he married Margaret Jones Rogers in 1946. J Q and his wife then built and moved into a brick rancher behind the restored Seagroves Farm House. J. Q. is remembered by many long time residents of Apex as a rural mail carrier they "could set their clocks by."

All of this property was later inherited by Lelia Seagroves Womble, the only remaining child at that time of John Henry and Nevada. **Bill Cotton** of Cotton Custom Homes purchased the property in 2007 and restored the Seagroves House to be used as an office. The house, which was in bad disrepair, was moved to a new foundation, so that the road could be widened.

A small park with an old farm pond has been preserved from the farm and is located directly behind the Seagroves House. The Town of Apex plans to make it available as a public park.
