We discussed Green Level Church which Rachel attends. There is a history but it is not printed. A former pastor wrote this in long hand. Rachel says the land for the church came from A M Council. The present minister wanted to tear down the church but enough members objected to overcome his intent.

14. HILLIARD JACKSON MILLS, son of Shadrack Mills and Patsy Wilson, was born 1 Jul 1845 in Wake Co., NC, and died 25 May 1920. He married 29 Jun 1873 Mary Hellen Yates (b 14 Sep 1839, d 6 Nov 1909), daughter of Anderson Yates and Julie Hellen Smith. They were married by JP A.C. Council, in Green Level, NC. They are buried at Rock Springs Church Cem., Apex, NC.

Hilliard served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. For more info see ch GRANDSONS OF NAAMAN MILLS: SOLDIERS IN THE CIVIL WAR.

Hilliard was a farmer. He resided in Chatham Co., NC (Grove P.O.) with his father on FC/1860; and Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) with his cousin, Elijah L. Mills and family on FC/1870. Hilliard and his family resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1880-1920. The FC/1880 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedule regarding Hilliard's farm:

1880 - 40 acres of tilled land. 12 acres of woodland and forest. Value of farm, including land, fences and buildings - \$400. Value of farming implements and machinery - \$50. Value of livestock - \$150. Cost of fertilizers purchased in 1879 - \$22. Amount paid for wages for farm labor in 1879, including value of board - \$55. 18 weeks of white hired labor in 1879 upon farm. Estimated value of all farm productions sold, consumed, or on hand for 1879 - \$400. 1 mules and asses of all ages on hand 1 Jun 1880.

In Hilliard's compiled military service record from the Civil War, he is described as being 5 feet, 6 inches tall. On 10 May 1902, he applied for a soldier's pension from the State of NC, for wounds that he received during the Civil War. His application was approved.

After Mary Hellen's death, Hilliard m 2ndly 10 Nov 1910 Kiddie Holt (b ca 1838, d 19\_\_). Hilliard left a will. He lived to age 74.

9. NATHAN MANLY MILLS, son of Nathan Mills and Candis Wilson, was born 18 May 1845 in Wake Co., NC, and died 22 Dec 1924. He married 18 Jan 1872 Martha Ann Womble (b 31 Oct 1851, d 15 Feb 1924). They were married by JP A.C. Council, at John Womble's residence in Wake Co., NC. They are buried at Womble Fam. Cem., Apex, NC. Their gravesites are marked with an upright tombstone - epitaph: *"Resting in hope of a glorious resurrection"*.

Nathan served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. For more info see ch GRANDSONS OF NAAMAN MILLS: SOLDIERS IN THE CIVIL WAR.

Nathan was a farmer. They resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1880-1920. The FC/1880 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedule regarding Nathan's farm:

1880 - 25 acres of tilled land. 32 acres of woodland and forest. Value of farm, including land, fences, and buildings - \$600. Value of farming implements and machinery - \$50. Value of livestock - \$250. Amount paid for wages for farm labor in 1879, including value of board - \$20. 5 weeks of colored hired labor in 1879 upon farm. Estimated value of all farm productions sold, consumed, or on hand for 1879 - \$500. 1 mules or asses of all ages on hand 1 June 1880.

On 7 Jul 1924, Nathan applied for a soldier's pension from the State of NC for his Confederate service during the Civil War. His application was approved. Nathan lived to age 79. Their children:

38. Aug 1853 - pg. 524 - "Ordered that Jephtha Mills, an orphan child, now of the age of eight years, be bound out as an apprentice to Elijah Mills, until he arrives at the age of 21 years, to learn farming. And the indentures are accordingly executed."

43. Feb 1855 - pg. 41 - "Ordered that E.L. Mills does have leave to retail spiritous liquors by the small measure at Green Level, in Wake County, and that the Sheriff issue a license for the same, upon his complying with the revised law, for one year."

52. May 1863 - pg. 445 - "On motion, Elijah Mills is appointed administrator with the will annexed of John Crocker, Sr., deceased. He enters into bond in the sum of four thousand dollars, with Albert Council, G.A. Upchurch as his sureties, which is approved by the Court. Whereupon he took the oath prescribed by law."
