COMMENTARY:

Courtney Upchurch was born in Dunn Township, Franklin County, NC about a decade before his father, Moses, head of Clan 1, moved to Chatham County, NC around 1803. There Courtney grew to adulthood and in 1814 married Cynthia Richardson. It is believed that their family was complete about 1835 when Courtney and his family moved to Marengo County, Alabama, where he would later die. The family dispersed to other nearby counties and westward to other states. Of special note is that son James Courtney was later found residing in Texas, where his son, Tony, was to become a noted minister about which much is written in the <u>Upchurch Bulletin</u>.

RE: Jul 1984 issue of <u>U B</u>. We know <u>Courtney Up.</u> D prior to 1840 as his wife was listed as head of the household on the 1840 census in Perry Co., AL. Apparently the family lived in Marengo Co., AL just before the 1840 census and they moved to Perry Co. after <u>Courtney</u> died. The probate records for him are found in Marengo Co. and show him as "<u>Courtney Upchurch</u> late of Marengo Co., deceased". Of course he could have left the county and returned temporarily at the time of his death. At any rate the first probate records I found were in the NOVEMBER TERM 1841 and from these it appeared that the Administrator, Presley Woodall, had been in Court earlier on the matter. The case was

continued to the Feb 1842 Term, then to the Nov 1842 Term and was supposed to be taken up again in Apr 1843 Term, but no mention could be found of the case in Apr 1843 or later. Apparently Courtney's estate was never fully settled. His estate was declared insolvent at one time and the Administrator was told to hold \$273.13 from the estate until creditors could file a claim. Apparently the matter was never brought up again.

MOSES and MARY (SIMS) UPCHURCH are buried on what is called the "SIMS UPCHURCH" place in Chatham County, N. C., which is on land originally purchased by MOSES when he left Franklin County, N. C.

According to tradition, MOSES UPCHURCH met his death because of an accident at the age of 102 or 103. He was riding horseback across a small stream and fell from the horse and drowned.

Neither MOSES nor MARY (SIMS) UPCHURCH left a will but there is documentary proof of many of their children as listed below:
