Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class **James Crews**, whose wife, Sophia, is the daughter of D. Harris of Spring Hope, has returned from a six-month deployment aboard the aircraft carrier USS Theodore Roosevelt, which most recently participated in the NATO air strikes in support of United

Nations operations in Bosnia.

Crews is one of 5,500 sailors and Marines aboard the ship who participated in "Operation Deliberate Force," supporting U.N. forces in Bosnia. Crews' ship was stationed in the Adriatic Sea near the former Yugoslavian republic when it began the air strikes Aug. 30, with other NATO aircraft in support of efforts to compel the Bosnian Serb military to comply with U.N. resolutions. The USS Theodore Roosevelt aircraft flew more than 600 missions over Bosnia before being relieved by the USS America and its air wing.

Crews traveled over 50,000 miles during the six-month voyage, which included going to the Mediterranean Sea, Suez Canal, Red Sea and Persian Gulf. Jordan's King Hussein visited Crews' ship as it traveled through the Red Sea. While in the Persian Gulf, Crews and fellow crew members worked supporting the international effort to enforce the no-fly zone over southern Iraq.

Crews' ship was operating in the eastern Mediterranean Sea and participating in an exercise with Jordanian military forces when the ship was ordered to return to the Adriatic Sea. The 1,096-foot-long ship traveled 900 miles in 31 hours to be in position to assist with NATO air strikes.

During the six-month deployment, the 83 aircraft aboard ship flew over 10,000 missions and completed more than 9,600 arrested landings aboard the carrier. While spending 156 days at sea, Crews and shipmates also visited Greece, Israel, Italy and the United Arab Emirates. He joined the Navy in July 1986.

Hi Lynn---

I am back home in MO now and as they say "digging out". I was in NC when I got your message and could have gone by the Cemetery but this like several other things on my list did not get done . I always run out of time.

I know the Cemetery well. In the 1940's I often passed by it not knowing that I had kin buried there. That was long before I got the family history bug.

This Cemetery has gone by several names. Originally it seemed to be for a Carlyle family and an Upchurch family that had land adjoining and they both buried on the edges of their properties next to each other. So it became the Upchurch-Carlyle Cemetery. Over time it grew to look like one Cemetery but I have references to the Carlyle Section and to the

Upchurch Section. I need to get more verification of this version of the history. Somewhere along the way it became the Upchurch-Carlyle-Bunn-Cemetery although the order of the names varies.

This Cemetery went mostly untended until after a severe tornado in 1996 destroyed trees in it and caused much local damage. I think disaster money became available to restore the area but I am not sure about that. However, it is a fact that a local man James "Hoss" Alford took the lead in restoration and it came to look great. I have an article on this I can send if you so desire. Now that Hoss is deceased I am not sure of ongoing upkeep.

Now to your question. On 3 SEP 1977 I inventoried the Cemetery an listed 75 names--all that were there. I found no reference to William and Ansis Upchurch. I assume you know William G. Upchurch married first Alice Green and second her sister Ansis Green. My other records show there is a marked stone for Alice but not for William and Ansis. These notes show William was buried between his two wives. So, from this one might get an idea of where to place stones for William and Ansis. I think it is a great idea to do this and hope you and your dad will proceed.

You asked about a reunion. There never has been one for the overall Upchurch Family. Someone should organize one.

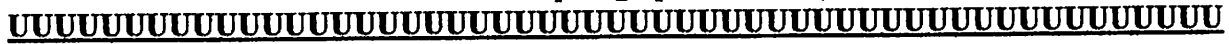

In 1994 we established a working relationship with Professor Ransome in England and

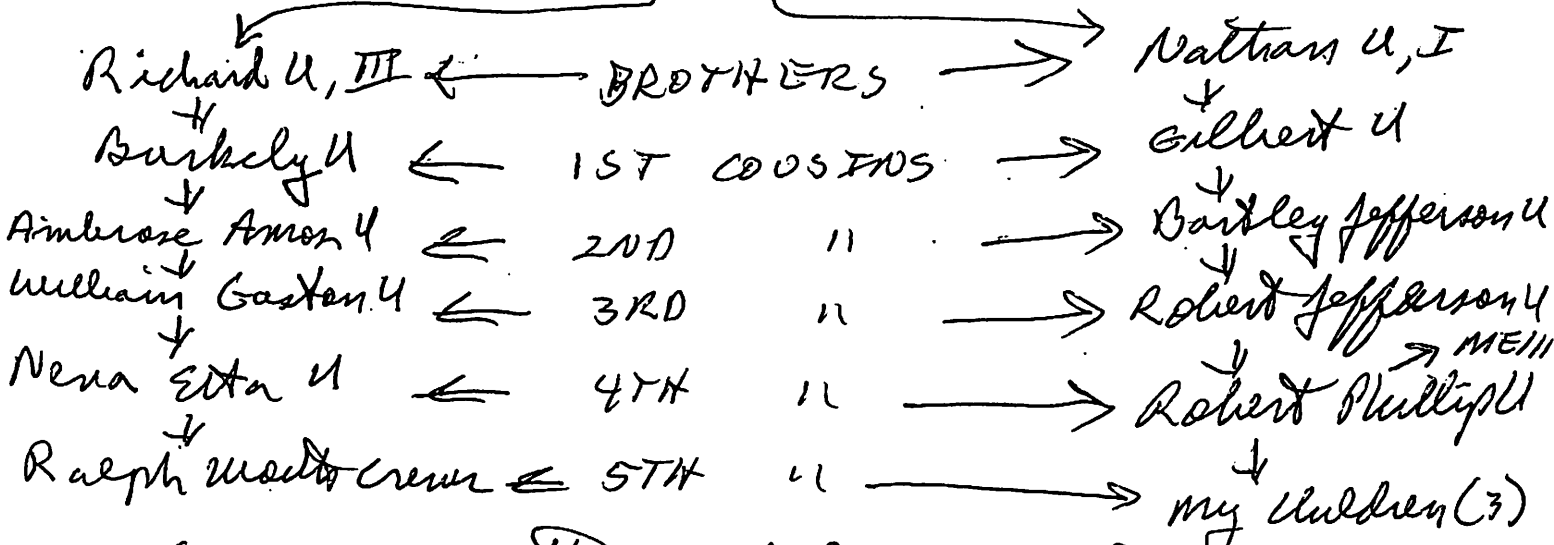
