In the name of God Amen, Know all that I, Elizabeth W. Crowder, widow of George Crowder deceased of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina having by the blessing of Almighty God, obtained a portion of this world's goods and feeling that I am feeble in health and being desirous to dispose of the same as I wish and desire, and being of a sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby sign seal publish and declare the following writing to contain and be my last will and testament.

First I will and desire that my body be decently interred in the family Burial Ground and that all necessary expenses thereof be paid out of the monies I may have on hand or that may arrive in any way from my estate.

Second I will and give to my daughter Δ Adelia M. Upchurch wife of Δ Alford Upchurch twenty five dollars in money.

Third I will and give to my daughter Helen G. Crowder twenty five dollars in money.

Fourth I will and give to my daughter Helen G. Crowder the bed bedstead and furnishings on which I sleep.

Fifth I will and give to my daughter Helen G. Crowder my negro boy Maddy the said boy I value at seven hundred dollars, and my daughter Helen G. Crowder shall pay to Lewis H. Crowder, one Hundred dollars to William D. Crowder one Hundred dollars to P. henke E. Jewell wife of B. H. Jewell

one hundred dollars to Mary A. T. Crowder  
 one hundred dollars to Angelina Myatt  
 wife of Isaac B. Myatt one hundred dollars  
 to Adelia M. Upchurch wife of Alford  
 Upchurch one hundred dollars. I will  
 and desire that the amount of one  
 hundred dollars to each one of my  
 children as named before be paid  
 and no more, which makes the value

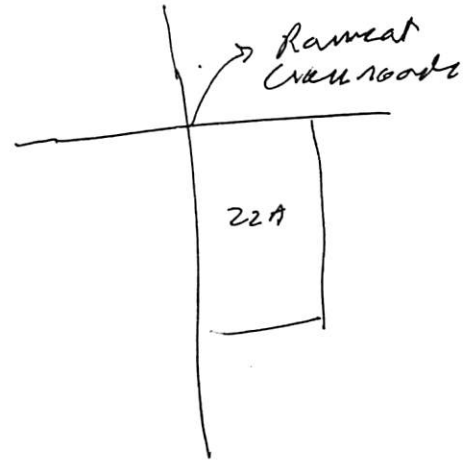

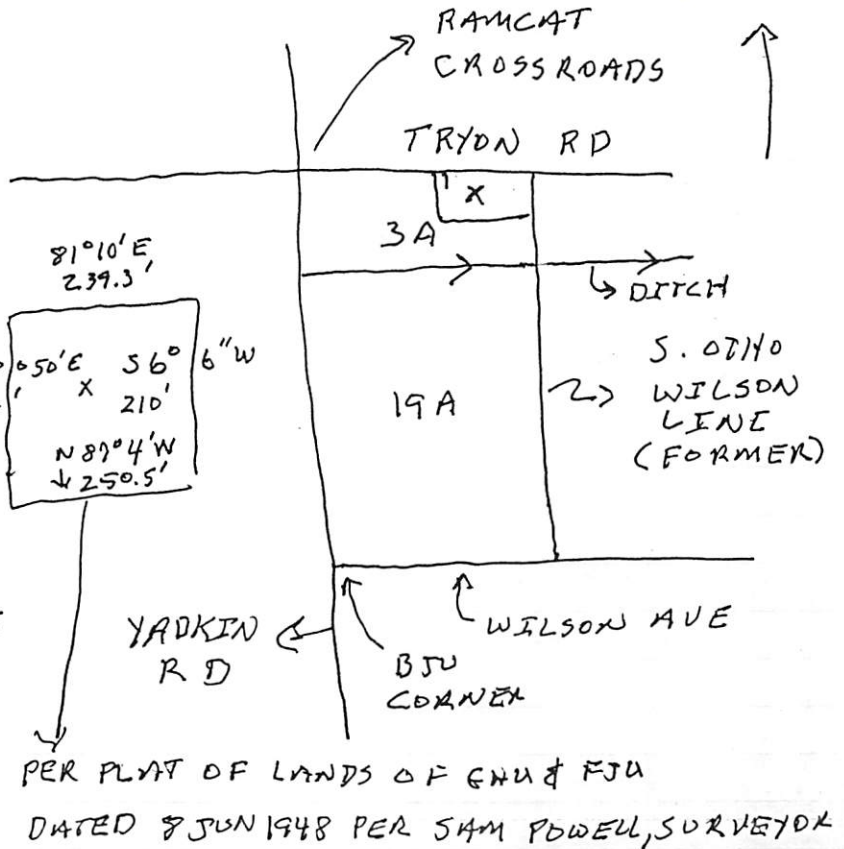

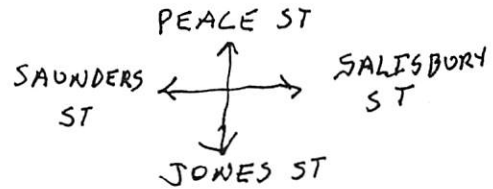

MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION

During 1871 local merchants "and business men generally" were urged to attend a meeting to discuss ways to cooperate and build the city's economy. The resulting Raleigh Board of Trade elected banker William E. Anderson president and Alonzo I. Adams secretary. Their charter gave the directors authority to appoint the required cotton weigher for the city, as well as the inspector and weigher of flour and salt fish, and the inspector of spirits "and other fluids." One of the board's first activities was naming a committee of arbitration, the first chairman of which was merchant Len H. Adams. Another was a campaign to bring about a reduction of railroad freight rates, considered excessive by Raleigh's mercantile community. The 1871 board functioned for an apparently brief period. Soon after securing a charter, officers issued a notice inviting not only merchants but also manufacturers, mechanics, printers, and all interested to attend a meeting to decide "whether the Board of Trade shall be established." The group was apparently no longer functioning in the late 1880s, when the Raleigh Chamber of Commerce was established.<sup>2</sup>

A dozen years after that, however, a more successful start brought about the Merchants Association of Raleigh. By this time, the era of emphasis on industries had begun. In October 1900, A. B. Stronach, M. Rosenthal, J. F. Ferrall and J. S. Wynne, and others formed a nonprofit corporation, its purpose "to foster trade and commerce and the interests of those having trade, business and financial interests in common in the city of Raleigh." Within two weeks representatives of 115 firms were involved. Grocer J. B. Hill of J. R. Ferrall & Company was elected president. The group established headquarters at 210 Fayetteville Street in the Holleman Building, where the Chamber of Commerce also had its offices. They issued invitations to people of nearby towns to visit Raleigh for special events. They also participated in a drive for public playgrounds for children; conducted "Pay Up Week" to remind customers of bills owed to merchants; and in 1914 made free storage facilities available to aid Wake County's cotton merchants. The association engaged in civic drives such as the nationwide celebration of Electrical Prosperity Week in November 1915, organizing an annual Fall Festival beginning about 1915, boosting and taking leading roles in the Great White Way effort in the 1910s, and purchasing street decorations for State Fair Week.<sup>3</sup>

There was evidently close cooperation with the Chamber of Commerce in many of the members' activities. Gradually the association was merged into the Chamber. During 1919 the majority of merchants forming the Chamber's mercantile department reached an agreement with a group of clerks in their retail businesses who had formed a clerks' union; the agreement established uniform closing hours and holidays. The plan was designed to give the clerks more freedom. By the following year, a movement toward again becoming separate organizations had begun.<sup>4</sup>

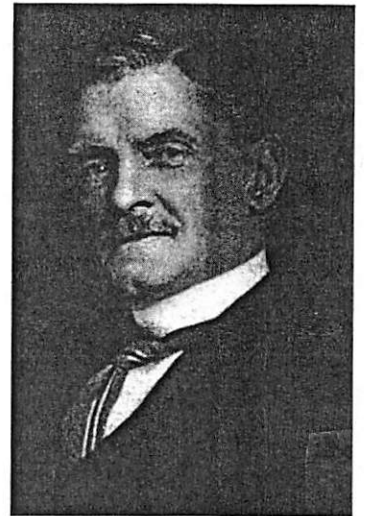

SAVINGS BANKS

The North Carolina General Assembly passed a law in 1887 to encourage the creation of savings banks, mainly for the thrifty factory worker who might make weekly deposits after paying living expenses. While not as profitable as national banks, they were allowed to open with much less capital stock. The same year the law was passed, Capt. J. J. Thomas, John T. Pullen, W. C. Stronach, J. Stanhope Wynne, and other Raleigh men chartered Raleigh Savings Bank, the state's first such institution. Pullen was made cashier from the bank's inception and later served as president for the rest of his life. A bachelor and devout Christian, he was known for keeping his pockets filled with candy and religious tracts which he distributed to anyone he met, both inside and outside the bank. He endeared himself to many of the city's poorest citizens by visiting them in their homes to offer counseling or give them money for basic necessities. "He never thought that his religion was helping the bank," Josephus Daniels later wrote, "but people had such confidence in him that widows and many others who had a few pennies they wished to save, would deposit their money in 'John Pullen's bank.'" Practically everyone in town owned small shares of stock at first, according to Daniels, but in the early 1900s a contest for controlling interest ensued between Pullen and cashier James O. Litchford. When Mrs. Daniels learned that

her two shares would give either of the men majority ownership, she declined to sell but gave Pullen her voting power. By the time of Pullen's death in 1913, Raleigh Savings and Citizens National had identical ownership and management personnel, although the two institutions did not officially merge until 1927.<sup>27</sup>

Other savings banks included Mechanics Dime (started 1896, with "Dime" dropped from the name in 1907) and Wake County Savings Bank (1905). Wake County Savings, initially located in the former elevator shaft of the Commercial and Farmers Bank, achieved notoriety as the smallest bank in the United States, or maybe even in the world, as one source speculated.<sup>28</sup>
