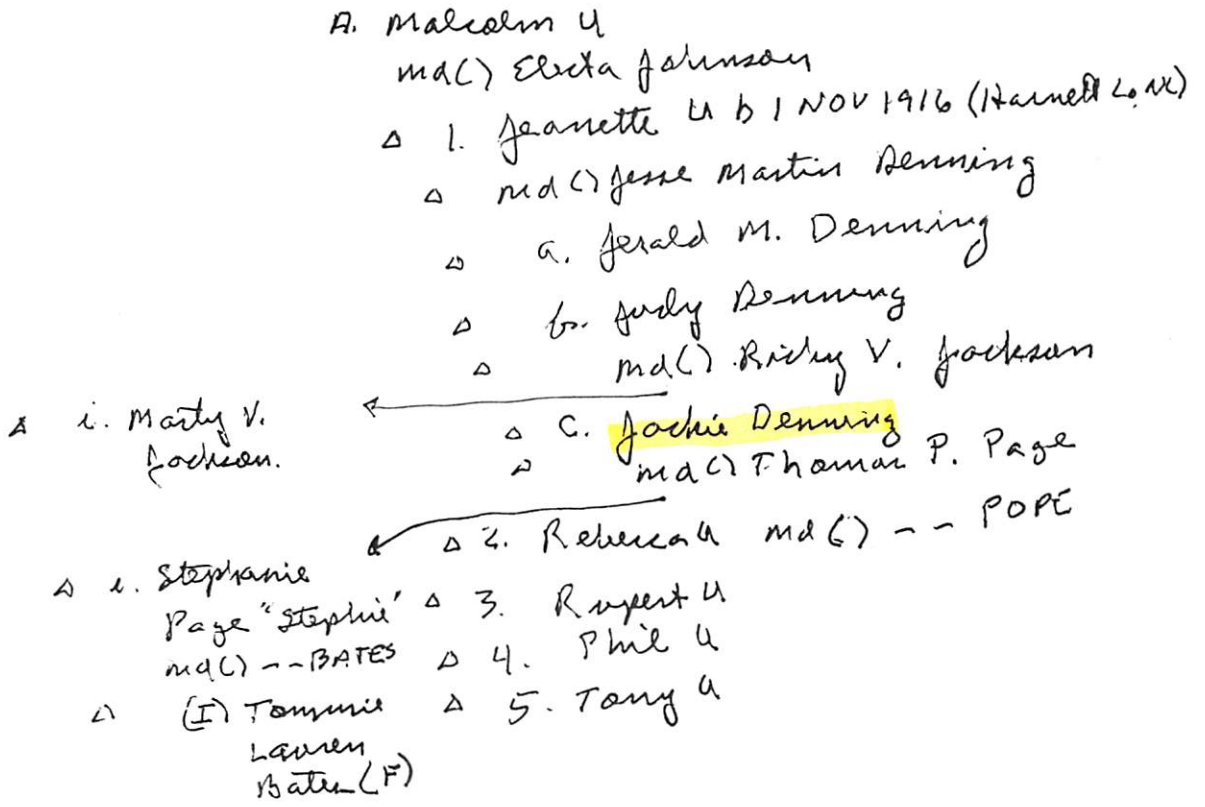

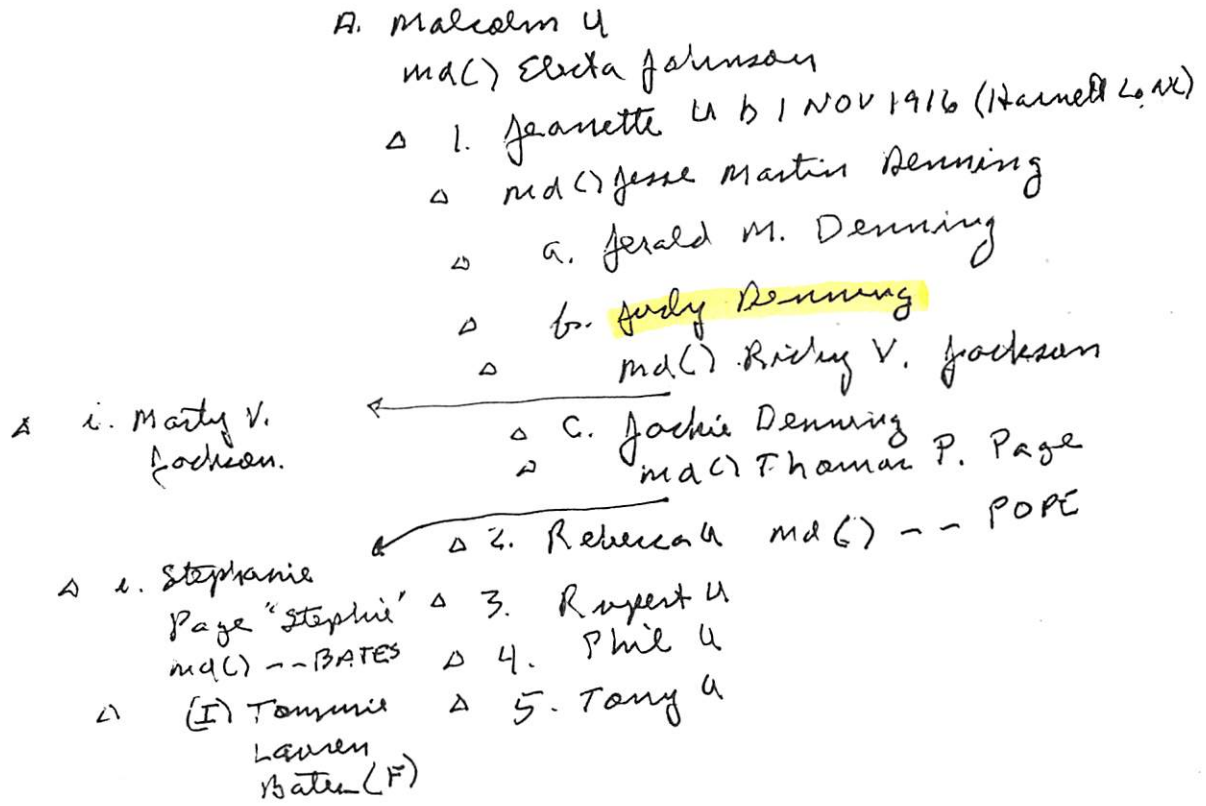

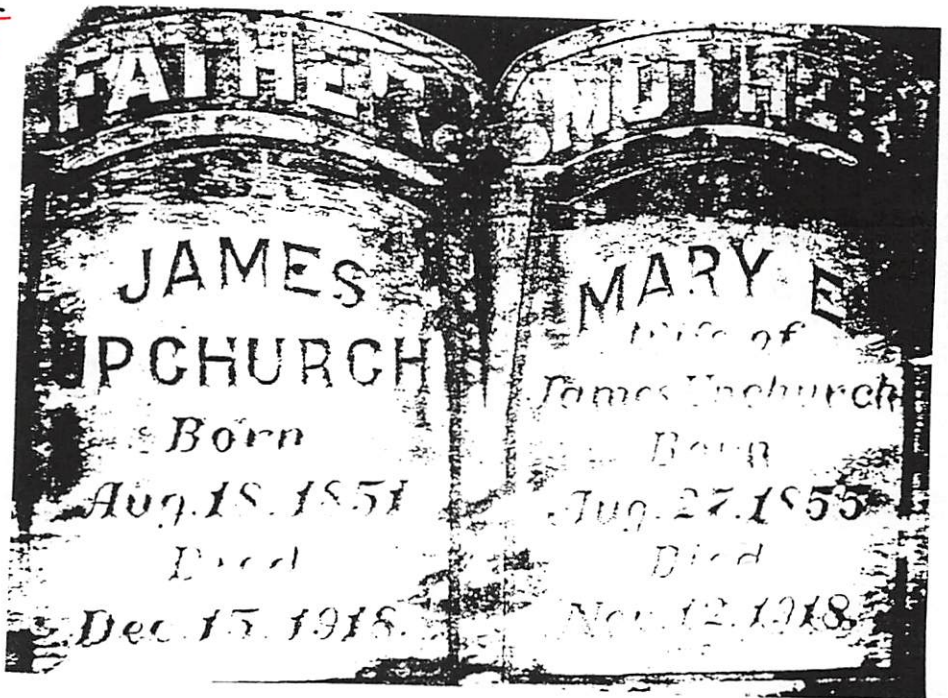

I went to visit my mother's sister Lucille U. Stinson this trip and was able to ask her some questions:

She told me Aunt's Lillye and Ava died from pneumonia. They were in a church program at Christmas time and caught colds that got worse and neither one ever really recovered their strength after that. She said she heard they were never strong. Aunt Lucille could not tell me much more about them as they died before she was born.

Her father was working on the back of a haying machine and developed breathing and lung problems and from there doctors said he had TB, he had not been sick before that she remembers.

With what I know of "current family health" I think the past generations suffered with asthma and allergies which made them susceptible to breathing problems or as in the late 1800's and early 1900's lung problems. I was able to obtain his death certificate—copy enclosed.

Aunt Lucille also told me James & Mary U's oldest son Lonnie died as a small child. She could not remember his age or what he died of, but did say she was sure he was buried in the Buies Creek Cemetery with his parents and siblings.

I went back to the Buies Creek Cemetery and made a photo of what I believe to be his gravestone. I feel sure it is not a rock in the ground as this is not a rocky area and the placement in the family plot makes it possible to be a grave. I have written to the county to try to find out where to get the burial records for the cemetery since I think he died before 1913. I also made a photo of the grave of Lenora U's husband L. Vander Denning at the same cemetery

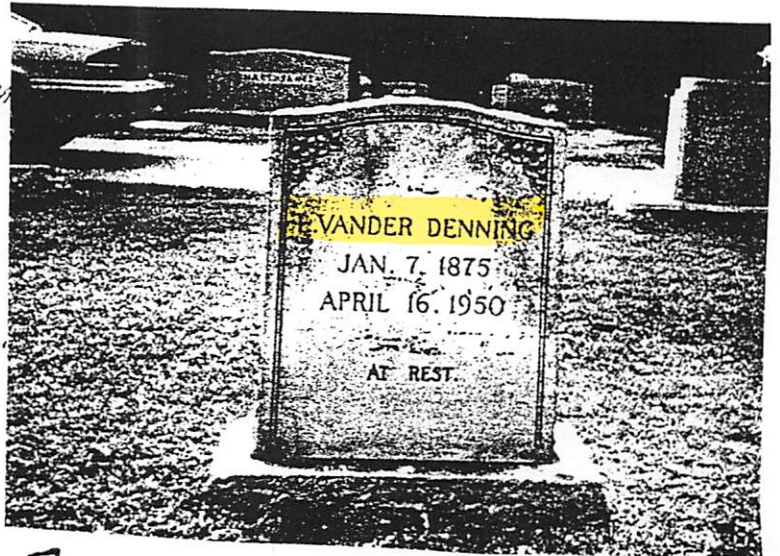

We figure they were brothers and that they had been put in homes in the community under guardianship, sooner or later we hope to find the parents of these three individuals.

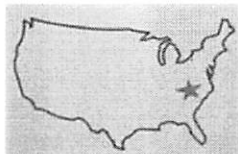

Effective January 1, 2016, Allied Families will open an office at 1130 Kildaire Farm Road, Suite 120, in Cary, NC. In this facility, volunteers will carry out projects to document sites, events, and family records for families enrolled or to be enrolled under the banner of Allied Families. The site manager will be Miley Albert Perry, a board member of Allied Families. Coordinators for specific projects are being recruited. Interested parties should contact Allied Families Manager Phil Upchurch at phil@upchurchstory.com. Donations of office equipment and supplies will be entertained.

A 16-Day Family History Visit to North Carolina Brings Great Results

Since the last Allied Families E-Newsletter to our large omnibus list on September 15, 2015, there have been a number of significant developments.

We have continued to enroll more families on our website - www.alliedfamilies.com. Use the password 2014allied#. Much new resource material has been assembled to be put online. We have embraced the Cloud by linking our operation to a Dropbox account where almost unlimited content may be stored.

But the most significant development of all came as a result of Manager Phil Upchurch traveling from Missouri to Wake County, NC to perform 16 days of family history research, October 7-22, 2015. More details on this trip will be reported in the 2015 issue of the *Upchurch Bulletin* now in preparation. About 75 people were contacted and several field trips to nearby counties were undertaken.

While in North Carolina, Phil was able to negotiate an arrangement to open an Allied Families office in Wake County, NC, effective January 1, 2016. This location will be Suite 120 at 1130 Kildaire Farm Road in Cary, NC. This is in West Central Wake County where many Upchurch and allied families lived starting in the late 1700's. The office arrangement was made possible due to the generosity of Cousin J. Michael Edwards, who is an investor in the local area. We are now recruiting volunteers to work in the facility, which will serve as a combined work space/repository/library/museum.

RUPERT TOMSON JACKSON

260

Born February 24, 1903 in Sampson County, Rupert T. Jackson was the son of Hinton Miles Jackson and Jenett Eliza Tew Jackson. His daughter tells us that her father came to Angier in 1930 from Sampson County to work in his sister's (Malissa Jackson Denning) husband's grocery store. He worked for Mr. Webb Denning for six years then bought the store from him and changed the name to Jackson's Market. It was located on the northeast corner of North Broad Street East and Williams Street. He worked twelve to fourteen hours a day, six days a week but Sundays were his Lord's days. Most Saturday nights it would be midnight before he got home, but he was up in plenty of time to ring the bell at Angier Baptist Church where he also served as a Deacon. He was a member of Angier Kiwanis Club and served as Town commissioner.

His daughter Nancy stated that in his free time her daddy enjoyed fishing and baseball, especially since his son Kenneth played with a Tobacco State League team. She also said he was a man with little formal education but a man with a big heart; he was the *best* husband, father, and grandfather a person could be and he loved people. He fed many families when they had no money; he was Santa's helper when Santa was running short of goodies or when children needed shoes to wear to school. He commented once that he couldn't believe a man had gone to the moon,

but IF they did, the weather would never be the same. She agrees with her dad ... the weather hasn't been the same!

Finally, his daughter said, her father did not have many worldly goods but he must be very rich in heaven because he always wanted to give rather than receive. He was honest, truthful, dependable and he was much loved by his family.

Mr. Jackson was married to Eliza Jeanette Jackson for sixty-five years; she came to Angier in 1930 with her husband. Mrs. Jackson was born in Sampson County, October 25, 1903. Her parents were Everette Anson Jackson and Ada J. Jackson.

Her daughter described her in this manner: "She loved her family and stayed busy at home looking after her children and her mother-in-law who lived with them. In later years she started working in Jackson's Market with her husband. They were partners in work as well as in life. She was a great cook — as her family, many preachers, soldiers in World War II, and many young people of Angier can attest. She loved people and could find something good about everyone. She enjoyed her church and loved her Lord. She was a good woman. She, like her husband, enjoyed the game of baseball, probably because their son was involved in the game. Most of all she loved her family and devoted her life to caring for and helping them. Many people called her 'Mama Jack' even though they were not related. She was a person who was easy to love and her family really loved her."

They have five children: eleven grandchildren, eighteen great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grand child. They are listed by families.
