This extract seems to provide a reasonably complete listing for Upchurch property owners in Franklin Co, NC for the period 1798-1836. It may be presumed that a number of the Upchurch family members owned the same land year after year. Thus the change of the District in which their tax listing fell represented a change in the District Captain. A careful study of these records could reveal the sequential names of the Captain for the main Upchurch Enclave.

There are some Upchurch listings that seem to fall outside of the main enclave. However, one needs to consider that District lines could have changed. My impression are that most if not all Upchurch listings are quite near each other in any case. Two Captains who are known by their full names are JOHN NORWOODS, SAMUEL TAYLOR & ELEY DENSON. ↑ See additional sheet for a full list of District Captains. Note that their name to be more Upchurches for the 1798-1836 era.
