Commentary: Dicey Maynard (Mainard) was born in 1827 and died in 1908. She married Jubal Upchurch (1829 – 1863) in Wake County, North Carolina on 8 Jan 1855. Jubal was the son of Burtis Upchurch and the grandson of Nathan Upchurch I, head of Upchurch clan #3. Jubal would die at the battle of Gettysburg and Dicey would later marry Peter Pleasant Pendergrass in 1871. She lived her entire life in Wake County, NC

RPU Note: The above extracts wee made as a result of Susan Murry [Murray] being in the 1870 home of <u>Dicey</u> Upchurch in Cedar Fork Township of Western Wake Co, NC as a 24-year old domestic servant (white) born about 1846. Dicey is nee <u>Dicey A Maynard</u> widow of Jubal Upchurch, II, son of Burtis Upchurch and grandson of Nathan Upchurch, I – Head of Clan.

Question: Is this Susan A relative of $\underline{\mathbf{Dicey\ Maynard}}$ or of her husband Jubal Upchurch. $\underline{\mathbf{II}}$. (Not able to link yet)

Question: Is the Susan Murry on the above 1880 Census the same as the Murry entry in the 1870 home of **Dicey**. There is a good fit age and location-wise. Assuming Susan Murry was single in 1870 and 1880 there is a good prospect that Mr Martha Lasater on the 1880 Census was nee Martha Murray.

Conclusions:

- A & B = same family
- Susan Murry in C & D is likely the same person
- If Susan Murry and proposed Martha Murry are sisters it is unclear if they are daughters of Daniel Murray

This Wake Co, NC Deed is dated 27 Dec 1899 and concerns land (presumably in the area of Morrisville, NC) known as land of Dicie Upchurch [**Dicie A** (**Maynard**) (Upchurch) Pendergrass] [She was widow of Jubal Upchurch who died in Civil War – son of Burtis Upchurch and grandson of Nathan Upchurch, I.] [The land could have come to her from Jubal Upchurch but no record of his acquiring land has been found so she could have inherited or bought the land – RPU]

I. Substance of Deed [For copy see biofile of Jubal Upchurch]

George A Upchurch [George Atlas Upchurch, I] and wife Catharine Upchurch [Also in deed as Catharine Upchurch] [nee Catharine Davis "Kate"] of Orange Co, NC for \$40 sell a 1/4th interest in the land to J T Upchurch [John T Upchurch AKA John Dicey Upchurch]. Adjoins land of Eliza Maynard & Joseph Maynard [relationship unknown – RPU] B. Upchurch (could be any of several, need more clues). W G Clements (assume William G Clements, MOG – RPU), Heirs of T C Sears. George signed whereas Catharine placed her mark. W C Sears, JP certified that Catharine signed willingly on 24 Apr 1900.

II. Added info – RPU Index of Wake Co, NC Grantors shows above is likely the item filed in Deed Book 177, Page 267, 24 Aug 1903

III. RPU Conclusions: A, B, and C represent 4 of the children of Jubal Upchurch. <u>Dicey</u>

<u>Maynard</u> selling their 1/4th share to child #4 – John T Upchurch. I interpret D as being the wife of George Atlas Upchurch, I and the wife of Josiah C Upchurch as Jacob Upchurch (Both named Martha) being somehow listed separately. A 5th childe [Edward or Elwood Upchurch] probably died young without heirs. [Note: Large version of deed attached reduced copy appears as (10)B, C – pages 13, 14 of biofile.
