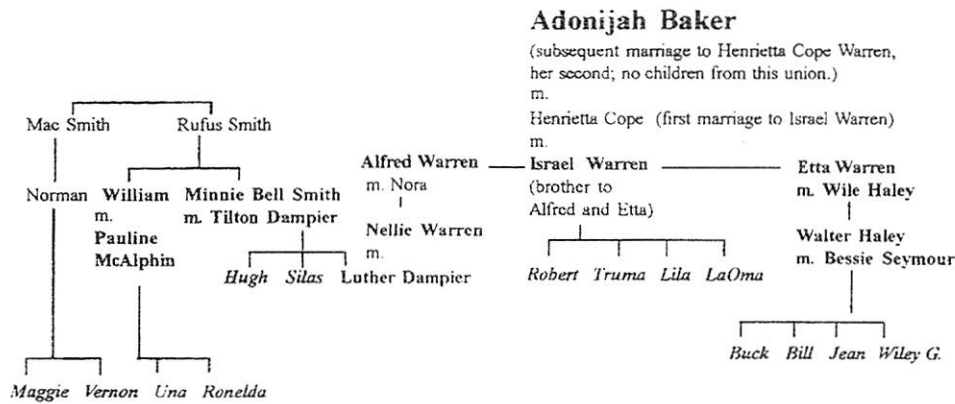
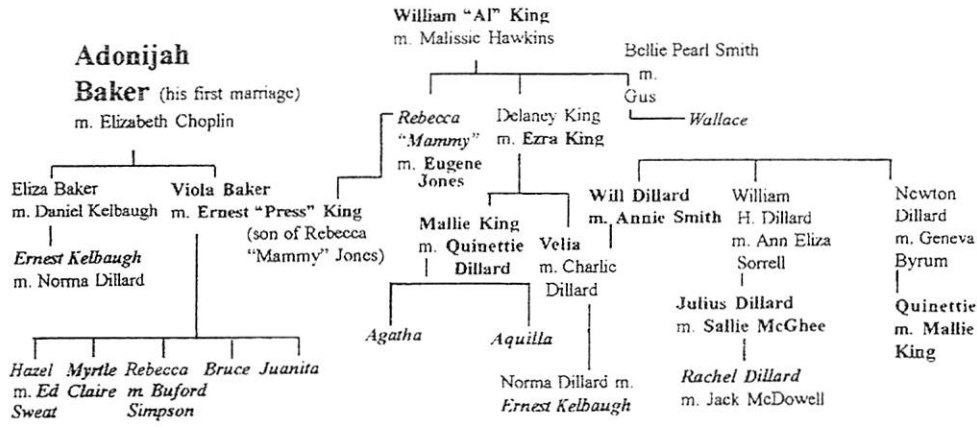

Having 50 such volunteers is a major achievement and shows the strength of our family history approach

We do not have you listed as a remote volunteer computer worker and hereby extend an invitation for you to join our volunteer ranks. You may not be able to accept for whatever reason but do know such help is vital to keeping up the fantastic momentum we have achieved so far in Allied Families dealing with our shared heritage.

In any case please do visit our two websites to stay current on our progress and let us have your comments and advice from time to time.

Hi Kendal---

This email is to thank you for your participation in our Allied Families History Association and to ask for your feedback concerning your future participation. You are among fifty on our list as active Biofile transcribers or as active in helping to create "Trees" on [Ancestry.com](#). This same email is being sent to all cooperators who have volunteered to make computer entries for our family history effort. Our focus has evolved along the way and I may have missed a beat with some cooperators. This email may even cross paths with other exchanges I have with you. Let me describe to you our current priorities to give you more background.

Biofile Projects:

Part I: We are using Volunteers to transcribe the Biofiles of the Patriarchs of enrolled families along with Biofiles of their children and grandchildren and their spouses. This will extend to about 500 Biofiles of which over 100 have been transcribed and are posted on our website. We want to continue this process and to recruit more transcribers.

Part II: In our Chesterfield office we have a team working on preparing Biofiles to be scanned and to be put on-line. This effort goes far beyond the 500 Biofiles of Part II as we probably have about 250,000 Biofiles to scan. We have budgeted about \$7500 to make Part II happen.

Master Outline Projects:

Part III: During forty years of research I manually placed family history records in 50 Notebooks. They are subject to being lost by fire, flood or otherwise. Our current highest priority is to enter the data from these Notebooks into [Ancestry.com](#) trees Clan by Clan and to label them "RPU Legacy Trees" They are not to be changed but the data will be available for adoption or as a source to be cited. If you are familiar with making entries in [Ancestry.com](#) or are will to learn your help as a volunteer Tree Master will be highly valuable.

Part IV: After Part III has been completed we will ramp up our effort to create "Living" Trees on [Ancestry.com](#) for each of our enrolled families. Some of this work has been started but we prefer to concentrate on Part III covering the the Master Outlines for now.

Our correspondence with Cooperators has been somewhat irregular as we have juggled duties and my health issues and as the above process has unfolded. Sorry about that--now we hope for more orderly exchanges going forward. This brings me to ask you for your response to the following:

Von Ray and his second wife, Alma Harrison Ray, had seven children during their 24 year marriage (five sons and one daughter--one unnamed child was still born) as listed below:

1. Mack Eunice Ray was born on May 23, 1915. Mack (age 18) married Euva Frances Cotton (also age 18) on November 27, 1933. They had one daughter (Joann). Mack was a Sergeant First Class in the Army in World War II. Mack died at the age of only 33 on February 9, 1949 while on active duty stationed at Ft. Myer in Arlington, Virginia. He is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 1247).
2. Junius Hub Ray born in April 1916. Junius (age 22) married Ola Keith (age 18) on June 25, 1938. Junius and Ola had three children (Alma Lee, Nancy Ann, and Gene). Junius rented out his farm (property formerly owned by his father) and worked at textile mills in Butner and Durham, North Carolina. Junius died at age 69 in 1985 at Rex Hospital in Raleigh, N.C. (The same hospital where his father, Von Ray, died 46 years earlier.) He was over six feet tall and had blue eyes and black hair.
3. Alfonzo Columbus Ray, Jr. was born in April 1917 and was known as Von. Von (age 23) married Elenor Marshall in January of 1941 and they had six children (James, Joyce, Judy, Janice, Jerry and Johnny). Von worked at a lumber yard and also at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Von died of a heart attack at age 49 in 1966.
4. Woodrow Wilson Ray was born on May 22, 1918. Woodrow was named after the 28th President of the United States (1913-1921). Apparently Von Ray was a Democrat. From the age of about 16 until almost 21, Woodrow worked on his father's farm "in the production of crops." Woodrow enlisted in the Army on April 7, 1939 six weeks before his twenty-first birthday. While stationed at nearby Fort Butner in Granville County, North Carolina, Woodrow met his future wife, Coma Watson, at a post dance. Due to World War II, Woodrow's tour of duty was extended and he served six and one half years on active duty. Woodrow attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and spent his last year in the Army in Germany in Battery A of the 903rd Field Artillery Battalion. Woodrow was awarded three decorations and service medals: (1) European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with three bronze stars signifying participation in three combat campaigns (Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe), (2) Good Conduct Medal and (3) American Defense Service Medal. Woodrow married Coma Watson and they had seven children (Ronald Wilson, Linda Carol, Robert Lee, Ann Sherrill, Bradley Wayne, Susan Gayle, and Teresa Lynn). Woodrow was a policeman in Durham from 1945 until his death at age 52 on July 15, 1970. Woodrow was five feet eleven inches tall and had brown eyes and dark brown hair.
5. Frances Caroline Ray born on August 23, 1919. Caroline was a beautiful woman. She married Coy J. Forsythe and they had seven children (J.C., Crystal, Jean, Peggy, Eddie, Ray and David). Caroline died at age 62 on July 1, 1982.
6. Joseph Ray was born on August 29, 1923 and he was 16 years old when his father died in 1939. At age 21, Joe married Nina Dillard on October 28, 1944 and they had one child, Betty Ray. Joe worked as a machine adjuster at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Joe died at age 57 on November 13, 1980. Joe was approximately five feet seven inches tall and had blue eyes and black hair.

Ola Keith married Junius Ray in 1938 and she lived with her husband in the home of Von Ray, her father-in-law, for the last eighteen months of his life. Ola recalls Von stating that Joe was his seventeenth son. Joe is still referred to as Joe #17. Von Ray had twenty children — 17 sons and 3 daughters, but only 11 lived to be adults. Two of Von's sons, Percie and Mack, and one of his grandsons, Albert Ray, are honored by burial at Arlington National Cemetery. They rest on Virginia land across the Potomac River from the Lincoln Memorial on property once owned by Confederate General Robert E. Lee. Best known of more than one hundred national cemeteries in the United States, Arlington's green slopes shelter veterans from every war that has involved this nation. Percie (1893-1948) was a Corporal in the Army during World War I. Mack (1915-1949) was a Sergeant in the Army during World War II. Albert Ray (1923-1992), son of Percie and Elsie, served in the Navy for twenty years during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Albert retired as a Petty Officer First Class.

 period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of
 the company was compiled principally from company
 muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864,
 and 15 September through December 1864. No
 company muster rolls were found for the period prior
 to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September
 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In
 addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor
 records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war
 records, and other primary records, supplemented by
 state pension applications, United Daughters of the
 Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and
 histories, all provided useful information.
