Dennis is descended from George Upchurch, Head of Clan through his daughter Lydia Upchurch born 1782 (Brunswick Co, VA) died 1847 (Wayne Co, KY) who married Jefferson Dishman "Jeptha" born 1784 (VA) died 1843 (Wayne Co, KY). Dennis lists 10 children of Lydia and Jefferson but not all records agree with this list. The children of Lydia & Jefferson or given by Love Morgan on Page 68 of Her Upchurch Story are as follows:

Note: Morgan reports on an 1847 (\pm) Land Deal in Wayne Co, NY where mention is made of her 3 minor children/ heirs. They are:

- A. Catherine Dishman
- B. Jane Dishman
- C. Jefferson T Dishman

Morgan concludes these three are NOT children of "Jepha" & Lydia but rather of their son **Archibald Dishman** – RPU

Fentress County, Tennessee Deed Book G p 152: The heirs of Archibald Dishman, dec'd, sell to Andrew Dishman and Calvin Dishman, embracing the old home place where Archibald Dishman lived, bounded by lands of Amy Wood and Christian Reno on the east, Robert Hartfield and Andrew Dishman on the south, John Jennings and G W Crouch on the west. Lands of Eli Hatfield dec'd, and Isaac Crabtree for \$450.00 to each of us given July 28, 187. Signers: G W and Milly Crouch, D G and Jan Upchurch, Jefferson Dishman, Lewis Dishman, Ambrose Dishman, Mary Dishman, Elizabeth Dishman, Nancy Dishman. Attest: T W Upchurch, Sherrod W Pile (Pyle).

This deed provides excellent documentation of the children of <u>Archibald Dishman</u> born 1806 and shows that he lived in Fentress Co. TN. New to RPU records:

- a. Elizabeth Dishman
- b. Nancy Dishman



One could conclude this James died young and was not in the 1879 land records OR possibly Morgan confused the records and thought there was a Jane and a James whereas there was only a Jane – RPU

He was the son of Thomas Dishman and Kizzie Doublehead. Thomas's existence and parentage have been disputed by the present day descendents of Samuel Duchemin.

Jeptha was listed in the 1810 Iredell County, North Carolina census as Jephthru Dishman 1 male 26-45, 1 female 26-45, 2 males 0-10, 3 females 0-

10.

Jeffery Dishman was listed in the 1820 census of Wayne County, Kentucky. Included in the 1820 listing were 4 males 0-9 years old, 2 males 10-15 years old, 1 male 26-44, 1 female 0-9, 2 females 16-25, 1 female 26-44, 1 female 45+, with 3 people engaged in commerce.

Jefferson is listed in the 1830 census living in Morgan County, Tennessee. Included in this listed were 1 male 5-10, 2 males 10-15, 1 male 15-20, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 20-30, 1 female 50-60.

In 1840 they were back in Wayne County, Kentucky, Jefferson is listed with 1 male 50-60, 1 female 20-30, and 1 female 30-40. Their children

She was born 5-4-1804 Tennessee and died 7-4-1873 Fentress County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Thomas Cooper who was a veteran of the War of 1812. Thomas Cooper was born in Pennsylvania. Archibald and Jane are buried Upchurch Cemetery Fentress County, Tennessee.

Archibald is listed in the 1840 census of Wayne County, Kentucky living next door to his brother Thomas. Listed in the household were 2 males 0-5, 1 male 5-10, 1 male 10-15, 1 male 30-40, 1 female 0-5, 2 females 5-10, and 1 female 30-40.

They are listed in the census records of 1850, 1860, & 1870 of Fentress County, Tennessee. In 1850 Elizabeth Province age 1 was living with them. Their children were:

Jefferson Dishman married Lydia Upchurch about 1802 in Virginia. She was daughter of George Upchurch and Rachel Bethshares.

Mary/ Polly Jane Dishman (12-21-1803 – 1843) and Charles Campbell Ramsey married 01-21-1827 in Morgan Co, TN. His parents were William Ramsey and Catherine Gray.

Sinah "Siney Brown" Dishman (1805 – 07-16-1870) married Riley Brown (1824 – 11-19-1857). His parents: Abraham Brown and (?).

<u>Archibald Dishman</u> (12-18-1806 – 06-22-1879) married Jane Cooper (05-04-1804 – 04 Jul 1879)

Marcus/ "Markey" Dishman (1807 – 1894) married Serilda Martha Smith (1813 – 1869). Her parents: William and Mary (?) Smith.

Thomas Jefferson Dishman (1809 – 1860) married Elizabeth (?) (1809 - ?)

Moses Upchurch (1817-08-? – 1864) married Millie Upchurch (1817 – 1861). His [Hers?] parents: Moses Upchurch and Catherine Barker

Burrel/ "Big Bird" Tremont Dishman (10-27-1820 – 05-23-1901) married Nancy Upchurch (04-09-1825 – 1884) on 22 Nov 1843. Her parents: John C Upchurch and Sarah Bertram.

Many of these Dishman families lived in Dry Holler in the southern part of Wayne County and Tennessee.
