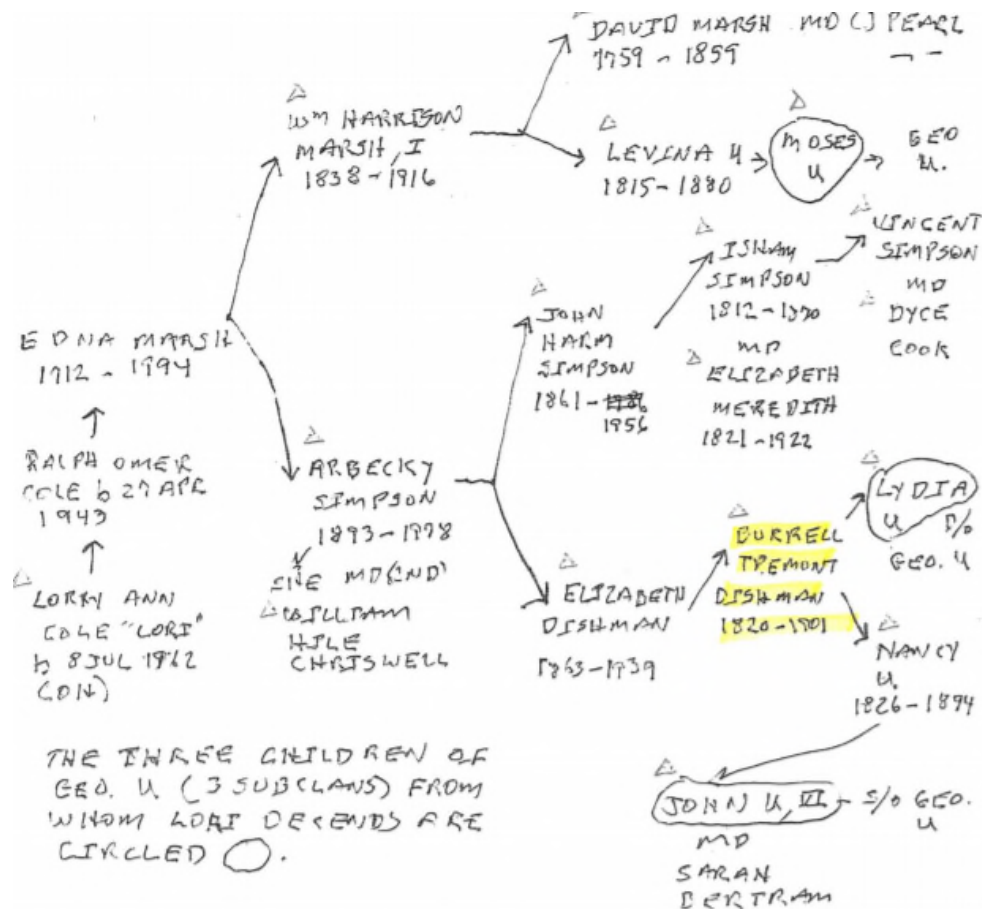

The commonwealth of KY grants on 5 Apr 1890 50 acres on Otter Creek in Wayne Co, KY to Shadrack Upchurch adjoining land he already owns – joins **Burrel Dishman**, William Marsh

**(no number)** RPU analysis of information in letter 10 Apr 2000 Melva Doris Upchurch to RPU  
9 Sep 2000

#1 An undated court document probably from Wayne Co, KY probably in the period 1905 – 1925 involved what must have been Upchurch land on Otter Creek near Slick ford in Wayne Co, KY. The court granted title to the Frankfort Bank and to the Sutton Brothers Oil and Gas Co.

The tract bordered Upchurch Land – of Shadrack Upchurch (Shadrack Allen Upchurch?) and possibly other Upchurches not named; Burrell Dishman, William Marsh.

The court document recorded input from individuals shown as [ ] which RPU links as follows:

Input also shown for Thomas Abbott [possibly the Thomas N Abbott in Tuggle – Sandusky Cemetery, Wayne Co, KY. (Page 630 in Cemetery Book) born 20 Aug 1880 died 25 Mar 1962 “Perk”, several Watsons in Cemetery, No Upchurches – RPU]

#2 Testimony of Mrs Slaven re: property in #1 above [assume she is likely mother of Ruth (Slavens) Upchurch\* who got the Dyer Tract it being part of the 100A left by Shade Upchurch [Melva says Shadrack Allen Upchurch] near Slickford bought from Pete Marsh. The Otter Tract went to Becky Watson [Mrs Rebecca Watson]\*, Alf Upchurch [William Alfred Upchurch]\*, and Guy Upchurch [Giles Berry Upchurch]\*. Land joins Will Marsh

**BTD** and his wife Nancy lived on Otter Creek in Wayne Co, KY. They were the grandparents of Arrisa Jane Dishman who married William Albert Morris.

**BTD** born Wayne Co, KY married Nancy Upchurch born and died Wayne Co, KY.

Dennis is descended from George Upchurch, Head of Clan through his daughter Lydia Upchurch born 1782 (Brunswick Co, VA) died 1847 (Wayne Co, KY) who married Jefferson Dishman “Jeptha” born 1784 (VA) died 1843 (Wayne Co, KY). Dennis lists 10 children of Lydia and Jefferson but not all records agree with this list. The children of Lydia & Jefferson or given by Love Morgan on Page 68 of Her Upchurch Story are as follows:

Note: Morgan reports on an 1847 (+) Land Deal in Wayne Co, NY where mention is made of her 3 minor children/ heirs. They are:

- C. Jefferson T Dishman

Morgan concludes these three are NOT children of “Jepha” & Lydia but rather of their son Archibald Dishman – RPU

- #1 I show Joseph Upchurch and Sarah J Matthews had a daughter Rebecca L Upchurch born 3 Jan 1857 (Wayne Co, KY)
- #2 My records do not show that **Burwell Tremont Dishman** had a son George Washington Dishman. However, he did have a daughter Lucinda Dishman who married George Washington Dishman, son of Burrell Tremont Dishman. I do not show that Lucinda and George Washington Dishman had a daughter Arco Sarah Dishman.

Sarah “Arco” Dishman married Hiram Watson who is a member of the Rebecca Upchurch Line in the George Upchurch/ Shadrack Upchurch Sub-clan. See reports on information passed down by “Arco” as follows:

- Arco said her mother was Wayne Upchurch and her father was George Washington Dishman “Washie”.
- Arco mentioned Burrell [**Burrell Tremont Dishman**] and a “Lindy”.
- Arco also said something about a maiden name of Bayers or Bar or something similar.
- Arco may have been wrong but Nellie [nee Nellie May Watson, daughter of Arco] said Arco always said her mother was Wayne Upchurch.

Sue reports – my husband Danny was raised by his great aunt Sarah “Arco” Dishman. Sue reports Arco gave her names and dates before she died but Arco was old and may have been in error in her memory per Sue.

31. Lydia Upchurch was born ca 1782 Brunswick County, Virginia and died ca 1845 Wayne County, Kentucky. Her husband was Jefferson (Jeptha) Dishman. Jefferson was born 1770-77 in North Carolina and died ca 1847 Wayne County, Kentucky. He was the son of Thomas Dishman and Kizzie Doublehead. Thomas's existence and parentage have been disputed by the present day descendants of Samuel Duchemin.

Jeptha was listed in the 1810 Iredell County, North Carolina census as Jephthru Dishman 1 male 26-45, 1 female 26-45, 2 males 0-10, 3 females 0-10.

Jeffery Dishman was listed in the 1820 census of Wayne County, Kentucky. Included in the 1820 listing were 4 males 0-9 years old, 2 males 10-15 years old, 1 male 26-44, 1 female 0-9, 2 females 16-25, 1 female 26-44, 1 female 45+, with 3 people engaged in commerce.

Jefferson is listed in the 1830 census living in Morgan County, Tennessee. Included in this listed were 1 male 5-10, 2 males 10-15, 1 male 15-20, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 20-30, 1 female 50-60.

In 1840 they were back in Wayne County, Kentucky. Jefferson is listed with 1 male 50-60, 1 female 20-30, and 1 female 30-40. Their children

Melva has been in touch with Sue Rogers in Monticello, KY in an attempt to locate more information on a "Washel" Dishman who was possibly the father of Wayne Upchurch who married Sam Cooper. Washel Dishman and Washie Dishman may have been the same. Sue looked up the 1860 & 1870 Census Records for **Burrell Tremont Dishman** and found no evidence for a son Washie or Washel. As of 1870 there were 8 children (1 having died young per RPU records) and the youngest in the Burrell Tremont Dishman household was Elizabeth age 6. Presumably if B T Dishman would have had a son Washie/ Washel he would have been born by 1870.
