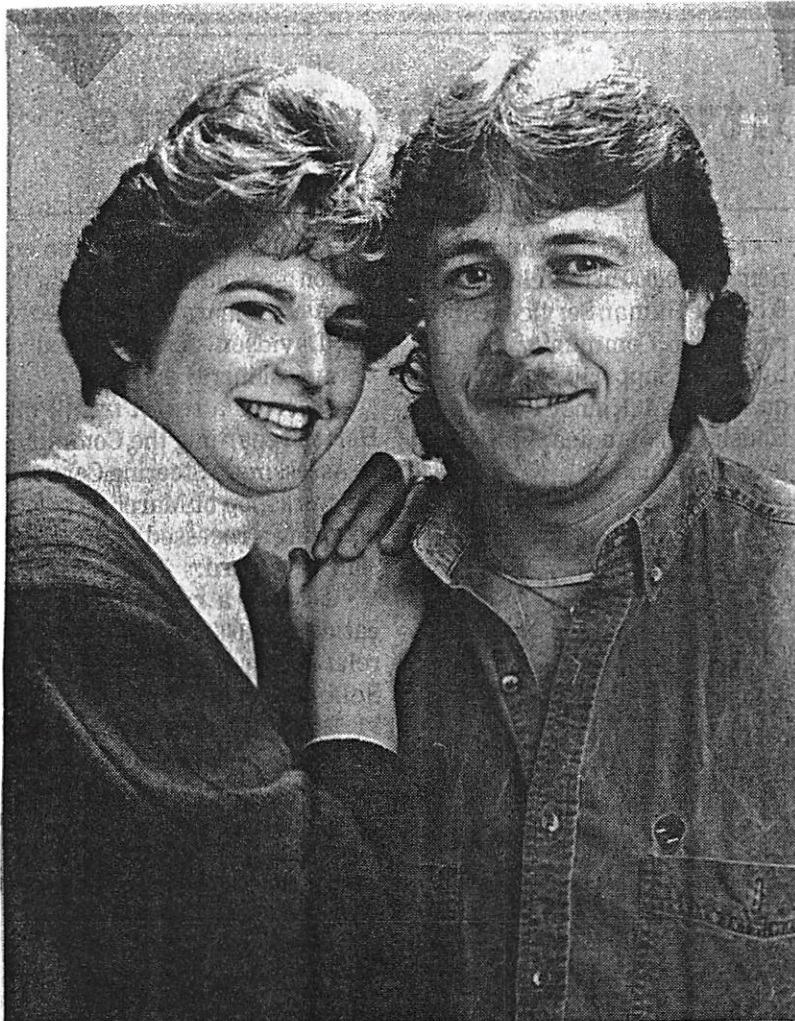

PRIVATE WILEY CARROLL, CSA

Wiley Carroll, the son of James and Lucinda Carroll, was born in Wake County in 1839. He departed the farm of his widowed mother and enlisted as a private in the Confederate Army at Holly Springs, May 29, 1861. The young farmer was a member of the "Wake Guards," Company D, 26th North Carolina Regiment, under Colonel Zebulon B. Vance. His first company commander was Captain Oscar R. Rand.

On March 14, 1862, Union General Ambrose Burnside advanced on the coastal town of New Bern with 11,000 men. He was opposed by 4,000 Confederates under General Lawrence O'B. Branch. Vance's Regiment was placed on the Confederate right.

The Federals pushed forward and a Union Colonel stated that the 26th Regiment "fought the most gallantly of any of the enemy's forces." The untrained State Militia retreated in confusion and Vance's Regiment was flanked. The order to retreat never reached Captain Rand, who Vance noted was "almost surrounded by a large force." Rand's men, including Private Carroll, continued the fight. For over three hours, said Rand, "Our men from the first to the last poured in their fire with deliberate aim." At 11:30 a.m., out of ammunition and surrounded, Rand surrendered with about 150 men. Private Carroll was now a prisoner of war.

Carroll was confined to Fort Columbus in New York Harbor until his exchange at Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, on August 16, 1862. He returned to his company just in time to bid farewell to Colonel Vance, who had been elected governor. Colonel Henry K. Burgwyn became the new regimental commander. Captain James Theophilus Jones was the new company commander.

On July 1-3, 1863, Wiley Carroll fought at the Battle of Gettysburg, where Colonel Burgwyn was killed and succeeded by Colonel John Randolph Lane. Private Carroll participated in the heroic charge of Generals George E. Pickett and Johnston Pettigrew against the Union position on Cemetery Ridge. The Regiment advanced over 1300 yards under heavy enemy artillery fire. Said Confederate Major John T. Jones, "Nothing daunted the brave men of the Twenty-sixth." Though the ranks were decimated, they reached the wall with Pickett's men before being thrown back by superior numbers. Of the 800 men of the Regiment who entered battle on July 1, only three officers and sixty-seven privates, including Wiley Carroll, survived.

Having participated in dozens of engagements, Private Carroll's Company was ordered to dislodge Federal Troops from a railroad station near Globe's Tavern, Virginia, on August 20-21, 1864. The Confederate's called the struggle "The Battle of Yellow House." In a charge on August 21 Wiley Carroll was wounded in the right arm. His arm was amputated.

On December 15, 1864, Carroll retired to the Invalid Corps. He took the oath of allegiance to the U. S. on May 29, 1865, exactly four years from the day he had enlisted against the Union.

Wiley Carroll was said to be a stern man. He married twice and had numerous children. With his first wife, Melinda, he had William (b. 1866), Mollie (b. 1872), Etta (b. 1876), Melinda (b. 1879), and Wiley Britton "Brit" (1881-1966). By his second wife, Alice, he had Texana J. (b. 1888), James Thomas (b. 1890), Joseph C. (1892), and Wiley A. (1898). Wiley Britton, a farmer, married Mary Malon Dupree (1890-1958), daughter of Joseph Dupree, the adopted son of Thomas and Alley Dupree of Johnston County. They removed to Harnett County and had children of their own: Mildred (b. 1913), James W. (b. 1917), Wiley Adofes "Doc" (b. 1919), Donnie A. (b. 1922), Tommy Young (b. 1925), Melzie Lee (b. 1927), Julia Catherine (b. 1931), and Mary Etheline (b. 1933).

Melzie and Wiley Adofes died without issue, though Melzie, who married Nellie Hall Upchurch, had stepchildren. Mildred married James Bullock, removed to Baltimore, Maryland, and had seven children: Gerald, Melvin, Stacey, Doris, Mary Alice, Carmadine, and Shirley. James married Mozelle Spivey and had a son, Linwood; Tommy married Helen Godwin and had two sons, Robin and Wren; Donnie married Hilda Partin and had three children, Danny, Ann, and Donna Jean; Catherine married Charlie Raford Smith and had five children, Glenda, Charlie Jr., Elaine, Ricky, and Joy; and Etheline married Silas Salmon Faulkner and had five children, Ronnie, Mary Connie, Joan, S. Keith, and Barbara.

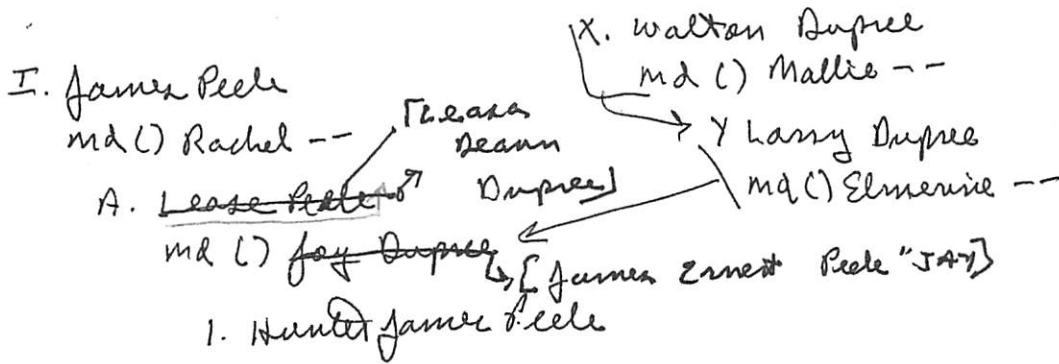

RE: EARLY CHURCHES IN RALEIGH

The Baptists were next to organize a congregation. This was in 1812, and a church building of an humble character was erected on Moore Square, or in what was then known as the Baptist Grove. The bell was of the size and sound of those generally in use by tobacco factories. In this Grove the founders of the First Baptist church worshipped. There is high authority for the statement that the members were accustomed each to take a tallow candle to this humble building in order to produce a "dim, religious light" (so conducive to spirituality, it was thought) for services at night. The membership of the church, says Mr. W. C. Upchurch, was never more than eighteen—seven males and eleven females. Of the former there

were Madison Royster, Jas. Nunn, J. D. Briggs, Mark Williams, and W. C. Upchurch; the late Mrs. Alfred Williams was among the female members.

About 1835, owing to differences of opinion among the members, dissension arose, and a new and better edifice was accordingly erected at the southeast corner of Wilmington and Morgan streets. The pastors of this church, in the order named, were Revs. Amos J. Battle, Louis Dupree, T. W. Toby, J. J. Finch, G. W. Johnston, T. E. Skinner.

In 1858 the present imposing First Baptist Church was erected. Rev. Dr. T. E. Skinner, one of our most distinguished theologians (who is yet living and much beloved by all) was the first pastor. The late Rev. Dr. T. H. Pritchard was another of the early pastors.

Among the members of this church in the old days were, Mrs. Alfred Williams, Miss Lucinda Briggs, P. F. Pescud, J. J. Biggs, Miss Sallie Towles, M. B. Royster, Jas. D. Royster, Lynn Adams, W. D. Williams, Caswell Lee, Jas. D. Nunn, Jordan Womble, Jr., Robert Jones, Miss Selina Jenkins.

A prominent feature of the Sunday School of this church is the Infant Class, which numbers one hundred and sixty-five. The class was organized in 1865, with but twelve pupils. Dr. W. I. Royster was the first teacher in charge. It is now conducted by Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Dodd and Miss Elizabeth Briggs.

In 1874 a few members of this church, led by Messrs. N. B. Broughton and J. S. Allen, organized a new congregation, and purchased on Swain street a house of worship and denominated it the Second Baptist Church. The congregation assumed in a year or two such proportions that it became necessary to secure a more commodious structure, and a site was accordingly purchased on the corner of Hargett and Person streets, upon which was erected the present edifice,

known as the Tabernacle Baptist Church. Its seating capacity is about one thousand. The Sunday School is the largest in the city and its fame in this department of religious work extends throughout the country, due, in a great measure, to the zeal and popularity of Mr. N. B. Broughton, known throughout the State as foremost in all that makes for the advancement—moral and material—of the people.

PRIVATE WILEY CARROLL,

Wiley Carroll, the son of James and Lucinda Carroll, was born in Wake County in 1839. He departed the farm of his widowed mother and enlisted as a private in the Confederate Army at Holly Springs, May 29, 1861. The young farmer was a member of the "Wake Guards," Company D, 26th North Carolina Regiment, under Colonel Zebulon B. Vance. His first company commander was Captain Oscar R. Rand.

On March 14, 1862, Union General Ambrose Burnside advanced on the coastal town of New Bern with 11,000 men. He was opposed by 4,000 Confederates under General Lawrence O'B. Branch. Vance's Regiment was placed on the Confederate right.

The Federals pushed forward and a Union Colonel stated that the 26th Regiment "fought the most gallantly of any of the enemy's forces." The untrained State Militia retreated in confusion and Vance's Regiment was flanked. The order to retreat never reached Captain Rand, who Vance noted was "almost surrounded by a large force." Rand's men, including Private Carroll, continued the fight. For over three hours, said Rand, "Our men from the first to the last poured in their fire with deliberate aim." At 11:30 a.m., out of ammunition and surrounded, Rand surrendered with about 150 men. Private Carroll was now a prisoner of war.

Carroll was confined to Fort Columbus in New York Harbor until his exchange at Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, on August 16, 1862. He returned to his company just in time to bid farewell to Colonel Vance, who had been elected governor. Colonel Henry K. Burgwyn became the new regimental commander. Captain James Theophilus Jones was the new company commander.

On July 1-3, 1863, Wiley Carroll fought at the Battle of Gettysburg, where Colonel Burgwyn was killed and succeeded by Colonel John Randolph Lane. Private Carroll participated in the heroic charge of Generals George E. Pickett and Johnston Pettigrew against the Union position on Cemetery Ridge. The Regiment advanced over 1300 yards under heavy enemy artillery fire. Said Confederate Major John T. Jones, "Nothing daunted the brave men of the Twenty-sixth." Though the ranks were decimated, they reached the wall with Pickett's men before being thrown back by superior numbers. Of the 800 men of the Regiment who entered battle on July 1, only three officers and sixty-seven privates, including Wiley Carroll, survived.

Having participated in dozens of engagements, Private Carroll's Company was ordered to dislodge Federal Troops from a railroad station near Globe's Tavern, Virginia, on August 20-21, 1864. The Confederate's called the struggle "The Battle of Yellow House." In a charge on August 21 Wiley Carroll was wounded in the right arm. His arm was amputated.

On December 15, 1864, Carroll retired to the Invalid Corps. He took the oath of allegiance to the U. S. on May 29, 1865, exactly four years from the day he had enlisted against the Union.

Wiley Carroll was said to be a stern man. He married twice and had numerous children. With his first wife, Melinda, he had William (b. 1866), Mollie (b. 1872), Etta (b. 1876), Melinda (b. 1879), and Wiley Britton "Brit" (1881-1966). By his second wife, Alice, he had Texana J. (b. 1888), James Thomas (b. 1890), Joseph C. (1892), and Wiley A. (1898). Wiley Britton, a farmer, married Mary Malon Dupree (1890-1958), daughter of Joseph Dupree, the adopted son of Thomas and Alley Dupree of Johnston County. They removed to Harnett County and had children of their own: Mildred (b. 1913), James W. (b. 1917), Wiley Adofes "Doc" (b. 1919), Donnie A. (b. 1922), Tommy Young (b. 1925), Melzie Lee (b. 1927), Julia Catherine (b. 1931), and Mary Etheline (b. 1933).

Melzie and Wiley Adofes died without issue, though Melzie, who married Nellie Hall Upchurch, had step-children. Mildred married James Bullock, removed to Baltimore, Maryland, and had seven children: Gerald, Melvin, Stacey, Doris, Mary Alice, Carmadine, and Shirley. James married Mozelle Spivey and had a son, Linwood; Tommy married Helen Godwin and had two sons, Robin and Wren; Donnie married Hilda Partin and had three children, Danny, Ann, and Donna Jean; Catherine married Charlie Raford Smith and had five children, Glenda, Charlie Jr., Elaine, Ricky, and Joy; and Etheline married Silas Salmon Faulkner and had five children, Ronnie, Mary Connie, Joan, S. Keith, and Barbara.

Humbly complaining your orator Buckner Ray, administrator of Jesse Gill, sheweth to your honor that at May Term 1860 of Wake County Court he qualified as administrator of Jesse Gill deceased and at said time letters of administration were issued to him and by virtue thereof he possessed himself of the personal estate and effects of said intestate to an amount more than sufficient to pay his just debts and funeral expenses, an account of which said property and effects is herewith exhibited marked (A). Further that your orator paid out a large amount of money in discharge of the debts of said intestate and his funeral expenses as appears by exhibit marked (B).

Your orator further sheweth that there was a large surplus on hand to which the distributees of the said Jesse Gill were entitled as appears by exhibit marked (C) and that he has paid to a number of the distributees large sums as follows: (SEE REPLETION)

Your orator further sheweth that his intestate Jesse Gill, as he is informed and believes & so charges, advanced to each of his children a handsome property.

Your orator further sheweth that he had to die upon his hands four hundred fifty dollars in Confederate money or bonds as appears by exhibit (C) and he alleges that it came about in this wise. He held the Confederate money and put it in Confederate certificates to pay the taxes of the estate while the law authorised such certificates to be received in payt thereof but the Revenue laws of said Confederate states were so changed that the collectors were not authorised to receive certificates in payment of taxes and your orator was compelled to raise other funds to satisfy same.

Your orator further sheweth that as fast as he collected the money of his intestate's estate he either paid the debts and distributive shares as stated above or deposited the money in the bank as he was advised it was safest to do so in the then unsettled condition of the country.

Your orator further sheweth that he is anxious to settle said estate and to that end he prays that an account may be ordered, that the distributees may be required to file their schedule as required by law and that advertisement may be made as required by law for those of the defendants residing beyond the limits of the state and that copies and subpoenas issue to those defendants residing in the state.

CHILD No. 5. Burton Gill's children to wit: B.J. Gill, D.C. Gill and L.T. Gill who are of age and paid as stated above, and Caroline Gill who has intermarried with Peter Dupro, and Susan Gill, Joseph Gill and S. Gill who are minors and to whom nothing has been paid & who are without guardians.

This information comes from two source documents, so to speak, neither of which are primary documents, a record Dan Olds found in the library in Macon, GA, the original Wake Co. page constructed from Mrs. Clark's book, records that I (FOC) had found, and a record in the Gill Gazette. I emphasize again that none of these are primary records, and therefore they are prone to error in interpretation, until we get the original records from Wake Co., NC (which Dan and relatives are now getting and are on this link)

Jesse Gill, documented in his will as a son of David Gill of Wake Co., NC. Jesse Gill b<1767, listed in 1788 will. Married Tabitha Pace. Jesse Gill of Wake Co. makes affidavit that Wm. Barler was a soldier in the Revolutionary War. 1800 Wake Co., NC census page 732, 00010-40010-04.

Fortunately much is known about the descendants of Jesse and Tabitha Pace Gill. Tabitha was the daughter of Buckner Pace. Little is known of this Buckner Pace, although some researchers think that he was the son of John and Ann Russell Pace of Brunswick County, Virginia. Jesse Gill and Tabitha Pace were married in Wake County on 26 October 1792. The reason that much is known about the descendants of Jesse and Tabitha is because Jesse left a rather large estate at his death and this estate was contested in the Wake County Courts for many years. The many papers in this file contains the names of Jesse's children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. These papers also list many death dates, first and second husbands and wives, and places of residence of the different descendants. 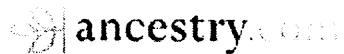

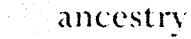

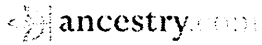
