Colonial Upchurch Head of Clan No. 19

Commentary: Edith Upchurch was probably born in Brunswick County, VA in the 1740s. She was head of Upchurch Clan #19 and one of the five children of James Upchurch III. She is known to have married a man with the name of Mosley, presumably a brother of Benjamin in Brunswick County. Presumably she died there as well. This Mosley Family is ripe for further research.
