

The excerpt from this letter shown below returns to the issue of land ownership in Western Wake Co, NC treated in earlier letters from June.

In the 182 Tax list it was Benjamin Lewis with 50 acres in the White Oak District. Presumable this is the 50 acres that his wife Cynthia Cole received from Shadrach Cole's estate. The marriage records says Berryman Lewis married Cynthia 14 Dec 1827 Cole, also spelled Berriman. So was he Benjamin or Berryman Lewis? Samuel H Cole should probably be Lemuel H Cole and he received 40 acres. The total land area was 530 area. Alfred Lewis appears with 217 acres in 1830 and this is presumably the land assigned to Mary Ann Cole, some of Shadrack Coles' 530 acres. Maybe she got parts that were to go to Edmond Cole and Henry Cole.
