Commentary: Catherine D Gill married David PHILLIP Upchurch in 1832 in Franklin County, Illinois. Phillip was the son of David and the grandson of William IV, head of Upchurch clan #9. There has been some confusion over Catherine which is examined in this biofile.

[Donald first cites records showing that David Phillip Upchurch married Catherine Craig born in 1813 in Wilson Co., TN, daughter of Hugh Craig and Mary Billingsley.] "I have records showing Catherine Gill (also called Kitty) born 1813 (NC) married Phillip Upchurch born 1811 (TN) (David Phillip Upchurch) both buried in Drake Cemetery, IL. The 1850 Census shows that Kitty (Wife of David Phillip Upchurch) was born in NC in 1811. I have now the copy of an application of Mary "Polly" Gill for a pension in which she states that her daughter married Phillip Upchurch. The names and dates of the children (of David Phillip Upchurch and the two females) are the same. David Phillip Upchurch and Kitty D. Upchurch are buried very close to Benozah Gill in the Drake Cemetery. Both Catherine's have a mother Mary!

The Southern Illinois Genealogical Society SAGA Vol. I page 50-54 is on the Gill Family and mentions an application 4 Mar 1853 that Catherine Gill about 38 years old is entered in marriage with Phillip Upchurch. It lists three Gill children.

These Gills lived in Burnside Township, Johnson Co., IL 1830 Benozah Gill is father.

I know that Kitty Gill moved to IL about 1822 at age of about 10 years and lived in Williamson Co., IL.



A new peace of information was found in the libary at Jonesboro Ark. on Kitty D. Gill Upchurch. All those I have met and talked to in Ill. had said that Kitty U. died on the homeplace in Burnside Ill. However I ran accross a Book on Johnson Co. III. published 1893 it was a Review of Johnson County. One of those telling thier story was Steven Gill. He told about his family coming from N.C. to Ill. in a two wheel cart. He tells the names of his father, grandparents, uncles and aunt. He goes on to say that of those that made the trip all are dead except one, his aunt Kitty Upchurch who is in her 80's and living with her daughter in Saline Co. Now we know Kitty U. died 1895 at age 83. I feel like she lived with her daughter untill her death. (I can't picture the daughter sending her 83 year old mother back to the homeplace) I think Kitty died in Saline Co. instead of Johnson Co. most likely Stonefort, we know that two daughters lived in Stonefort, Mary Jane and Caroline. My gr grandfather Ira U. also limed there but the town of 65 houses is in four counties. Mary died in Stonefort in 1906, her house was on the Wison Co. Saline Co. line. I'd almost bet Kitty died in Mary's home.

## DAVID PHILLIP UPCHURCH

David Phillip Upchurch, father of David Crockett Upchurch, was born August 18, 1811 in Tennessee. He was one of eight children, of which two have been identified. William Upchurch is the known brother of David Phillip Upchruch. On the 1830 census we find David Phillip living on the family farm near New Burnsides, Il. Th head of household is a David Upchurch 60 to 70 years of age. This could be the father or the grandfather of David Phillip. (There is some speculation thd David Phillip's father was killed in the war of 1812.) In 1832 David Phillip married Catherine D. Gill, the daughter of Benizah Gill and Mary Bone. They settled on the family farm . having 10 children. James born 1834 James born 1834 Caroline born 1836 <u>David Crockett born 1837</u> Mary J. born 1840 John born 1843 Stephen born 1844 Patsy born 1845 Amristy born 1847 Ina W. born 1849 Melvine born 1853 Metvine born 1853 David Phillip Upchurch died September 10, 1852.
