

Commentary:

Gillum Upchurch (XID – 6) was the son of Moses Upchurch, head of Upchurch Clan No. 1. He was born in 1782 in Dunn Township in Franklin County, NC. He was a young adult, in 1783, when he and his father moved to Chatham County, NC. For a few seasons he prospered as a land owner on the Wake/Chatham border. But in learning about his wife, Sarah Smith, we come to understand that this 1803 move did not establish a complete breach of Moses and his children with their Franklin County roots. We suspect that Sarah was from Dunn Township. More study of the Smith family there should be revealing. In any case, by about 1840 we find Gillum and Sarah moving back towards Franklin County and living in Marks Creek Township at Eagle Rock in Wake County, NC. The plot thickens in that Gillum's sister Parthenia married a brother of Sarah and they too settled in the Eagle Rock Community. There is a rich story yet to unfold of the descendants of Moses Upchurch in Marks Creek Township.

TRACT 2 – On 05 Oct 1821, Matthew Mills purchased a 162½ acre tract from Gillium Upchurch for \$325, as documented by Wake Co., NC CPQS (Feb 1822 – pg. 321): “A deed from Gillium Upchurch to Matthew Mills was in open court, duly proven by the oath of John Mills, a witness thereto.”. Deed recorded 14 Mar 1822 in Wake Co., NC Deed Book 5, pgs. 106 – 107.

The property is located in Wake Co., near Chatham Co. line, and has about 5000 ft. along Rd. 1605. The S. boundary was about 4,300 ft., the W. about 990 ft., and the E. was a branch to, and part of White Oak Creek, about 2,300 ft. long.

After owning his land for 32 years, Matthew sold it 26 Oct 1853 to Willie J. Fuller for \$325. Deed recorded 09 Dec 1853 in Wake Co., NC Deed Book 20, pgs. 142 - 143. A transcript of both deeds follows:

GILLIUM UPCHURCH TO MATTHEW MILLS } This indenture made this fifth day of October in one thousand eight hundred and twenty one, between Gillium Upchurch of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina of the one part, and Matthew Mills of the County of Wake and state aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Gillium Upchurch for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty five dollars hath bargained, sold, _____ released and confirmed and doth by these presents doth bargain, sell _____ release and confirm unto the said Matthew Mills, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and

being in the County of Wake, containing by estimation one hundred and sixty two and a half acres, be the same more or less. Beginning at the road that goes from Raleigh to Pittsborough at a small branch, thence down the said branch as it meanders to a maple on the bank of White Oak Creek, thence down the creek to a white oak, thence west 260 poles to a pine, Rial Ferrell's corner, then north along Taylor's line 60 poles to the road, thence eastward along the road to the first station. With all rights & profits to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining to him, the said Matthew Mills, his heirs and

assigns forever, free and clear of any right of the said Gilliam Upchurch or any person, his heirs & assigns forever and the same doth hereby warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Gilliam Upchurch has unto set his hand and seal the day & date first above written. Signed, sealed and acknowledged in presence of us.

MATTHEW MILLS TO WILLIE J. FULLER } This indenture made this twenty six of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty three, between Matthew Mills of the first part and Willie J. Fuller of the second part, both of the County of Wake and the State of North Carolina. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Mills do for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty five dollars to me in hand, paid by the said Willie J. Fuller, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do give, grant, bargain, sell and by these presents hath given, granted & bargained and sold unto the said Willie J. Fuller, one certain tract or parcel of land being and lying situate in the county and state aforesaid on the waters of White Oak Creek, known as my old place and bounded as follows, viz - Beginning at the Raleigh and Pittsborough Road a small branch, Fuller's line, thence down said branch as it meanders to a maple on the bank of White Oak Creek, thence down said creek to a white oak, thence west 260 poles to a pine, Nathan Mills' corner, thence north along Bassil M. Yates' line to the said road, thence east along said road to the first station, containing by estimation, one hundred and sixty two and a half acres. TRACT 1 - In 1821, Britain Mills purchased a 47½ acre tract from Gilliam Upchurch for about \$70, as documented by Wake Co., NC CPQS (Aug 1821 – pg. 265) : A deed from Gilliam Upchurch to Britain Mills was in open court, duly proven by the oath of Thomas Jinks, a witness thereto.”. This is the only current documented proof of the *first* recorded land purchase by the NAAMAN MILLS family in Wake Co. This deed was *probably* recorded in Wake Co., NC Deed Book 4.

The property is located in Wake Co., near Chatham Co. line, and has about 700 ft. along Rd. 1605. The N. boundary was about 2,700 ft. The E. and W. boundaries were branches that connected White Oak Creek.

After owning his land for 11 years, Britain sold it 27 Jan 1832 to Willie J. Fuller for \$70, as documented by Wake Co., NC CPQS (Aug 1832 – pgs. 91, 94) : “A deed from Britain Mills to Willie J. Fuller was in open court, duly proven by the oath of Seth Jinks, a witness thereto, and was then ordered to be recorded.”. Deed recorded 06 Feb 1833 in Wake Co., NC Deed Book 11, pg. 18. A transcript of the deed follows:

BRITTON MILLS TO WILLIE J. FULLER } This indenture made and entered into this the twenty seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty two. Between Britton Mills of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina of the first part, and Willie J. Fuller of the county and state aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seventy dollars to him in hand, paid by the said Willie J. Fuller, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Britton Mills, hath bargained, sold, and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain, sell, confirm and deliver unto the aforesaid Willie J. Fuller, his heirs & assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Wake and State of North Carolina and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a maple, Bartly Upchurch's corner in the deep bottomed branch and Mede Rogers' line, thence west along Mede Rogers' line to the spring branch, thence along the meandering of said branch to the Raleigh Road, thence down the said road east to the first small branch, Jones' line, thence up said branch to Jones' corner, thence north to the beginning. Containing forty seven and a half acres be the same more or less, together with all and singular, the appurtenances thereunto or in anywise belonging with all its profits, benefits and privileges unto the aforesaid Willie J. Fuller, his heirs & assigns forever, and the said Britton Mills promises for himself, his heirs & assigns, that he will forever warrant and defend the right and title of the above bounden land & promises unto the said Willie J. Fuller, his heirs and assigns, against the lawful claim or claims of any person or persons, forever. In witness whereof, the said Britton Mills hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & date above written. Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of Seth Jinks, Duncan Winston.

Jones stated that the dec'd died 1810 leaving 3 sons & 4 daughters, that Redding Jones became admr that same year, that in 1812 an audit indicated he owed money to the estate & the sd Redding died with will without paying & leaving Edward Pride & Jas Grant his excrs; mentioned as other legatees were Francis Jones & Peggy; also that sd Redding had been excr of T. Jones Sr dec'd.

Spring 1834. Alexander McKnight & his wife Penny vs Willie Fuller and his wife Polly, Jones Cook & his wife Sally, Simon J. Jones & Willis Jones. Sd McKnight & wife Penny stated that sd Penny had Tignal Jones for father, as did Polly Fuller, Sally Cook, Simon J. & Willis Jones; that sd Tignal had died owning lands in Wake Co, that the land had been divided, but sd plaintiffs had not been paid their difference.

Mar 1834. Willie Fuller & his wife Mary[Polly] answer the complaint of Alexander McKnight & wife Penny[Penelope]. They stated that Tignal Jones died owning land in Wake Co & the plaintiffs had received \$125; that Charles A. Hill was gdn of sd Penny & accounted for it many years ago.

The Chatham Co., NC Court records show that Gillium U. was the guardian of two Kelly children. Apparently, they they were the children of Barbee Kelly and their names were Delpha Kelly and Henry Kelly. He served as their guardian at least as early as 1817 but I don't know if they were in his home or not. Gillium U. was still the guardian for Henry Kelly as late as 1826. Gillium U. was also the administrator of the estate of Barbee Kelly.

Questions/Comments about Gillium U. – Head of the Moses U./ Gillium U. Subclan.

1. His locations. He was presumably born in Franklin Co., NC grew to adulthood and married there prior to his move to Chatham Co., NC presumably when his father Moses U. moved there

about 1804. Gillium acquired land in the Green Level area of Wake Co., NC but we still need to determine if he lived on the land. By 1840 he moves to Eastern Wake Co., NC to Marks Township where he is presumed to have died in 1854.

2. During the lifetime of Gillium U. XID – 6 there is no evidence there was any other Upchurches with the name Gillium in NC.

3. There was a Gillium U. b abt 1810 (TN) s/o William U. b abt 1778 (NC). So far there is no evidence that the two Gillium's were closely related by virtue of their same given name. If they are “closely” related one would have to involve William U. b abt 1778 (NC) – who would have been roughly the same age as Gillium U. XID – 6. However, William U. b abt 1778 (NC) remains unconnected.
