James Goodwin Family

1784 - 1861 (son of William Goodwin Sr.)

James Goodwin was born 1784 at Wake County the son of William Goodwin Sr. and Winifred Thwaitell. He married Jency (Jency) Holland at Wake County N. C. on October 7, 1807.

Jency Holland was the daughter of Sampson Holland and was born in 1786 at Chatham County. She died about 1828 at Chatham County.

They had seven known children. (1) Rhodrick Goodwin was born August 28, 1809 at Wake County, N. C. He married (1st) Silla (---) in 1837 at Chatham County. He married (2nd) Elizabeth (Betty) Davis on January 15, 1859 at

Chatham County. (2) Milly Goodwin was born on August 12, 1811 at Wake County, N. C. She married Stephen Wilson at N. C. Stephen was born in 1809 at Chatham and died in 1870 at Chatham, North Carolina. Milly died on March 2, 1877 at Wake County. (3) Rebecca Goodwin was born on

December 27, 1814 at Wake County N. C. She married William Colton about 1835 at Chatham. She was living with her daughter, Isobell, in the 1880 Census. (4) Calvin Goodwin was born on April 30, 1817 at Chatham County, N. C. He married (1st) Sally Ann Colton on November 13, 1839 at Chatham County. He married (2nd) Isabel Ann Spalding on November 21, 1859 at Chatham County. (5) Joseph L.

Goodwin was born on June 15, 1820 at Chatham County N. C. He was an Overseer for William Butler of Raleigh at Vicksburg, Mississippi in 1860. He moved to Perry Georgia where he died about March 1861. James gave Power Of Attorney to Henry Lashier to get what is due James from his son's estate and the proceeds to be divided equally among James's children. (6) John Wiley Goodwin was born on September 15, 1822 at

Chatham County. He died about 1878 in Chatham County. He married Mary Jane Williams about 1844 in Chatham County. (7) James Ruffin, was born June 20, 1825 at

Chatham County. He died between October 18, 1897 and March 23 1900 at Wake County. He married (1) Cynthia Boring on March 20, 1877. He married (2nd) Mary Ann Boring on June 5, 1862 at Chatham County.

James married for a second time. He married Phoebe Lawrence on December 19, 1828, at Chatham County. Phoebe was born in 1802, at North Carolina. There were six known children. Phoebe died in early 1863. Her will dated August 28, 1863 was probated on March 5, 1872. The children are listed as follows: (1) Alfred Goodwin was born on October 7, 1829. He died in June 1892 at Chatham County. He married (1) Louisa Banks in 1860 at Chatham County. He married (2nd) Martha J. Smith on November 25, 1886 at Chatham County. (2) John Goodwin was born on January 10, 1831, at Chatham County. He died on February 8, 1865. He married Lucy Ann Visk on October 20, 1855 at Chatham County. (3) Susan Goodwin was born on October 23, 1832 at Chatham County. She died on July 21, 1922 at Wake County. She married H. C. Lashly on February 12, 1851 at Chatham County. (4) Gaston Goodwin (unmarried) was born on June 18, 1835 at Chatham County. He died in 1902 at Chatham County. He married Sarah A. Koston. He was the only child named in James' will to receive property. Gaston and his sister Mary were named in Phoebe's will as beneficiaries of her estate. (5) Nancy Goodwin (unmarried) was born July 2, 1837, at Chatham County. (6) Mary Jane Goodwin was born on November 2, 1842, at Chatham County, North Carolina. She died on December 30, 1921 at Chatham County. She married Benjamin Franklin Upchurch in 1875 at Chatham County. She was named as a beneficiary in Phoebe's will.

James died on March 17, 1861 at Chatham County, North Carolina.
