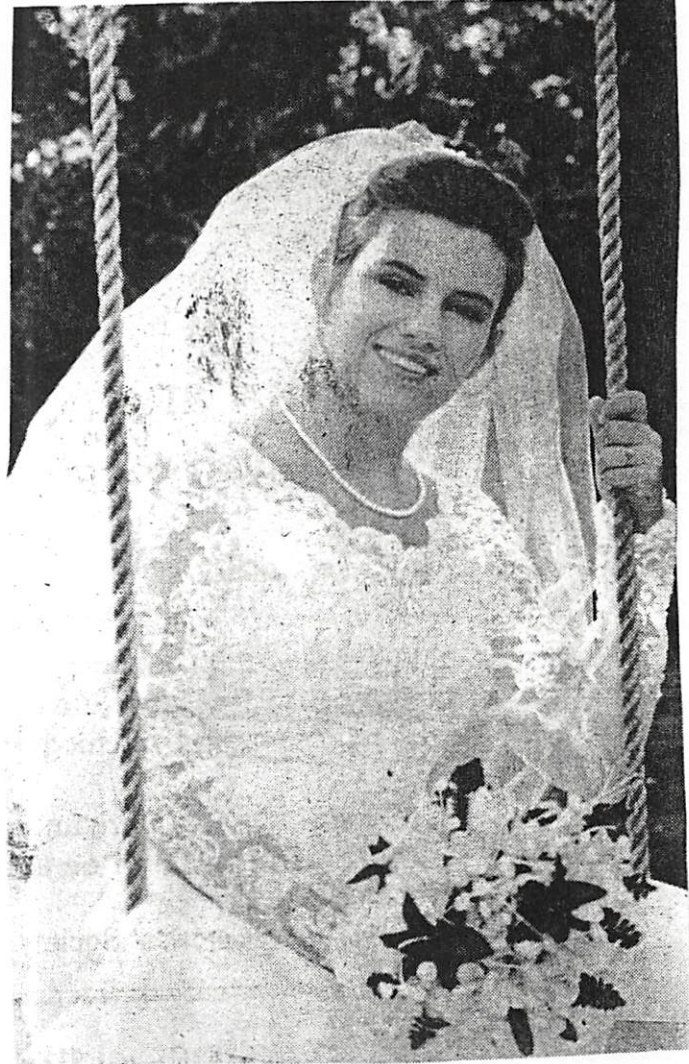

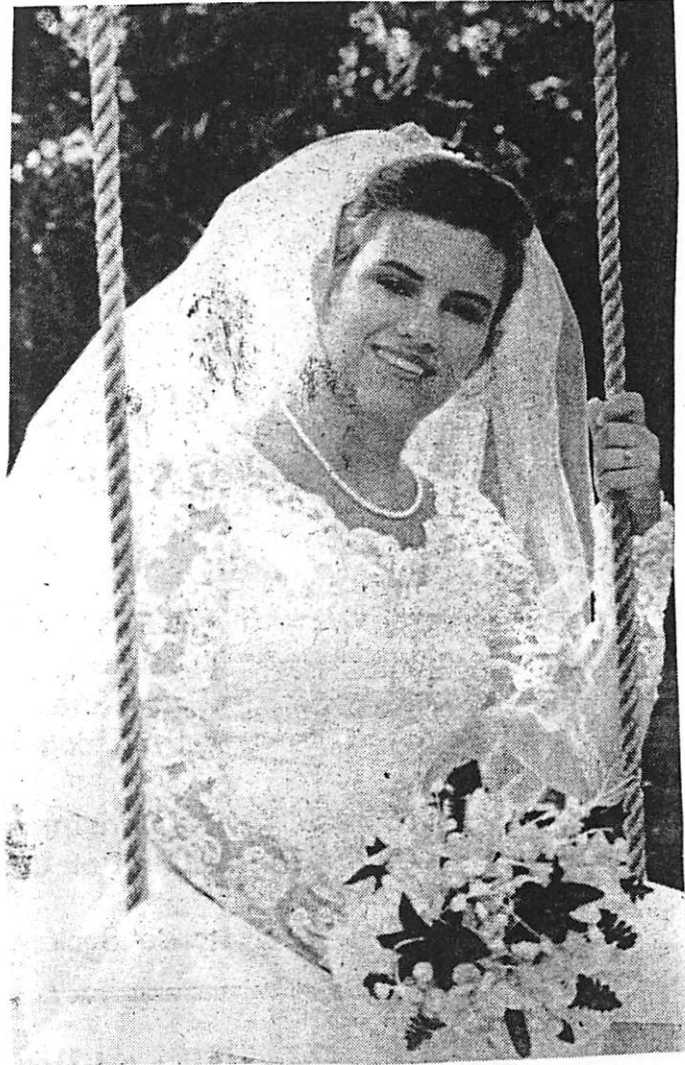

We know a lot about Lucintha Holland Beckwith. thanks to the account written in 1945 by her granddaughter, Ellie Beckwith Stringfield (5/2/1856-12/7/1950). She says, "Grandma Beckwith...was a competent and helpful wife. It was said of her that she kept her first child (Pinetta) so clean that she could not grow. She did grow however and became the wife of J. C. Hunter and mother of Carey and Rufus Hunter. Grandma as I remember her was always busy having work done by her slaves, trying to get the mothers to look after their families.

"They (the Beckwiths) had a big house and kitchen as was common in slave times. The big house was not a very fine one, but with her touch it was well kept and clean. I remember how sweet the pillow cases smelled taken from the lavender scented drawers, ironed so well. Everything in her house was kept in strict order. Her beds (big feather beds, four posters) were smooth and pillows and spread in perfect order.

"The candle stands and bowl and pitchers in guest chambers stand out in my mind, and her work table and a little bureau in her room attracted me. The little bureau became the property of my sister Emma (Mrs. Olive) and now is owned by Exie Casey, her daughter.

"Grandma, after the slaves were freed, had her house maid and lived as before till Grandpa died at the age of 80. Then she lived at her home with servants who farmed for her though on a smaller scale. She always carried her keys in a little basket, and I have followed her many times to the smokehouse to get the meat and other things for the cook to prepare for the meal. She was not very tall and rather stout in those days. When we were coming home from college, she was out watching for us, even if it were 11 o'clock at night. We lived one mile beyond her home. She would take her umbrella and come over to see us (walking) and spend the afternoon. She was now 80. Later she lived with her children and died at her youngest daughter's (Mrs. J. T. Adams) in Holly Spring. She died at the age of 96.

"Grandpa and Grandma were very faithful in their religious obligations. They attended all the Raleigh Association (meetings), traveling in a buggy of course. Grandma loved flowers and had two choice rose bushes, a pink and dark red (ever blooming). She would carry little bouquets to church for us children. They were so pretty fla__ed with thyme and lavender blooms. It made her and us happy. We all loved her very much. She loved us too and was so proud of her grandchildren. She was careful of her appearance and wanted to be dressed so we would not be ashamed of her, and sure we never were for she appeared well in any place and we were proud to call her Grandma.

"Grandma had five children.

"Pinetta who married J. C. Hunter and lived near Apex. They were the parents of Frances, Adolphus, Carey, Rufus, and Texanna Hunter. Texanna married John Hardaway, a preacher and they have two or three preachers (____ & husband dead.)

"Grandma's 2nd child was Margaret, who married Holloway Olive. They had two children _____ & _____.

"My father, Calvin Holland Beckwith, was next. He married Ann Hasseltine Holleman. They lived near grandpa, who gave him 100 acres of land to start with and he (pa) built them two log houses, a big house and a kitchen, and went to living. They lived at Grandpa's for two years after marriage. Sister Emma was a baby now and I followed sixteen months after. The next was Alice, then Exum, born 1860. Civil (War) was coming on. I was four years old now and remember my uncles who volunteered for the service, both died in the war. Uncle Silas (Ma's brother) died of mesels, and Uncle Daniel Green (Pa's brother) died of typhoid fever in Petersburg, Va. Grandma went to see him and brought him home dead. The negroes had death bells in their ears as a warning that he was dead, and sure enough when they saw Grandma coming with the corps (sic) you never heard such screaming and shouting these negroes did. I remember all that well. I am about to get off Grandma on my parents. Uncle Daniel Green was next to pa and Aunt Lucy Ann was the baby and was Mrs. J. T. Adams, where Grandma died.

"Uncle Daniel Green and Aunt Lucy Ann both walked to Holly Spring to High School. It was four miles. They were well _____ in Latin and Greek and Mathematics.

"Now I am going back to my pa's and ma's family. Emma the oldest child married Jackson Olive and has living five children: Ethel (Mrs. R. D. Holt), Frank, Exie (Mrs. Joe Casey), _____, Alfie (teacher in Howard College in Ala.) and Judge Hubert Olive.

"I, (Ellie Beckwith Stringfield), was next to Emma. I married Oliver L. Stringfield and had seven children. Mozelle (Mrs. J. E. Savain, for whom I am writing this paper). Then Preston Calvin came next. He is a teacher in Mars Hill College. Next is Bernice (Mrs. FitzWilliam McKay) who is teaching music in Mars Hill College. Oliver is next, who is _____ L. Stringfield, a baby doctor in Stanford, Conn. Miriam next who is (Mrs. Paul Brantley) wife of a druggist in Wendell, N.C. Lamar is a flutist and _____ of music and Vann the baby is in hosiery business at Thomasville, N.C. Emma died last March at the age of 90. I will be 90 next May if I live till then."

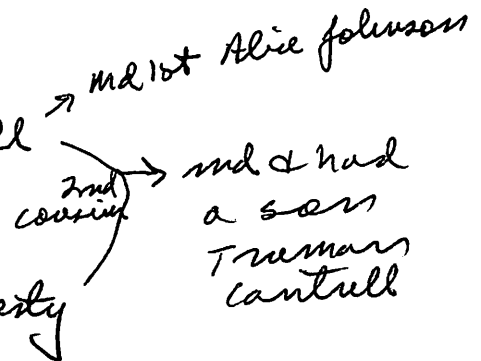

This excerpt concerns John Bartlett U, Sr & his wife nee
Julia Rebecca Hardison and is from a 5-Page
document Juanita prepared about her 2^d grandpa's Heritage.

John B. was a large, strong and determined man. He used his business savvy and brut strength to build a large, successful farm. They had renters and hired help. Their main source of income came from gathering up hogs in Sulpher Bottoms for sale. This work went on year round, regardless of rain, sleet, snow or heat.

In the early days the settlers had to travel to Jefferson, a port town in east Texas to purchase some needed supplies such as seeds, salt, sugar, furniture and blacksmith supplies. Some supplies came in 55 gallon wooden stave barrels. It was said that John B. would load and unload these by himself.

John B. married Julia Rebecca Hardison 2 Feb 1877. Julia was born in Miss. 4 Feb 1860 to Benjamin Hardison and his second wife Mary Cathrine Rebecca Alexander. Mary Catherine R. Alexander Hardison was born 22 June 1836 and died 12 Feb 1864. Benjamin Hardison moved his family to Texas in 1870 and settled in Sulpher Bottoms on what became known as Hardison; Knoll.

John and Julia had nine children and raised six. They sent all the children to school, boarding them out with families in Bogota, Detroit, and Clarks ville TX.

Julia died a tragic death. She was outside at the washpot with a fire around it when her clothing caught fire. She screamed and ran. By the time she was caught and the flames extinguished, she was severely burned. She died 20 Apr 1898.

John B. bought land by paying off back taxes. Some land was deeded to him by the state. He co-signed notes for people, often paying off the notes. The acreage owned by Sarah M. and John B combined with Julia's inheritance probably was over three thousand acres. Someone stole a deed from John B. and the property was claimed by another large landowner. They went to court and the other landowner won the land.

John was a hard worker and taught his children to work. He took care of his family and hired help, whether ill or in other troubles. When Riley came down with typhoid fever, John brought him home. He told Mary she would have to care for Riley during the day and he would care for Riley at night after he worked all day.

Once a week John killed hogs to feed the family and all the workers. They grew their food, ground their corn, and made their syrup, rendered lard, and made lye soap.

John B. and Julia built a large, two-story house and furnished it with walnut furniture. They had a very large parlor for entertaining. John liked to play the fiddle. He liked his daily "drink" and kept a supply on hand. In his later years, he wore an old slough hat and rode a mule rather than a horse. He said the mule was much easier to ride.

John B. had a heart attack. He was instructed by the doctor to change his diet, reduce the amount and stop eating pork. He told the doctor that as a child he had to go to bed hungry most every night and that he promised himself if he ever could afford food he would never go hungry again. Needless to say, he died of a heart attack on 10 Sept 1910. He is buried at Boxelder Cemetery.

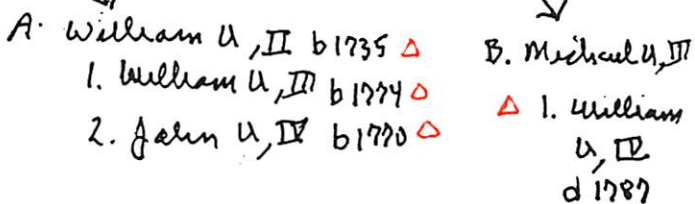

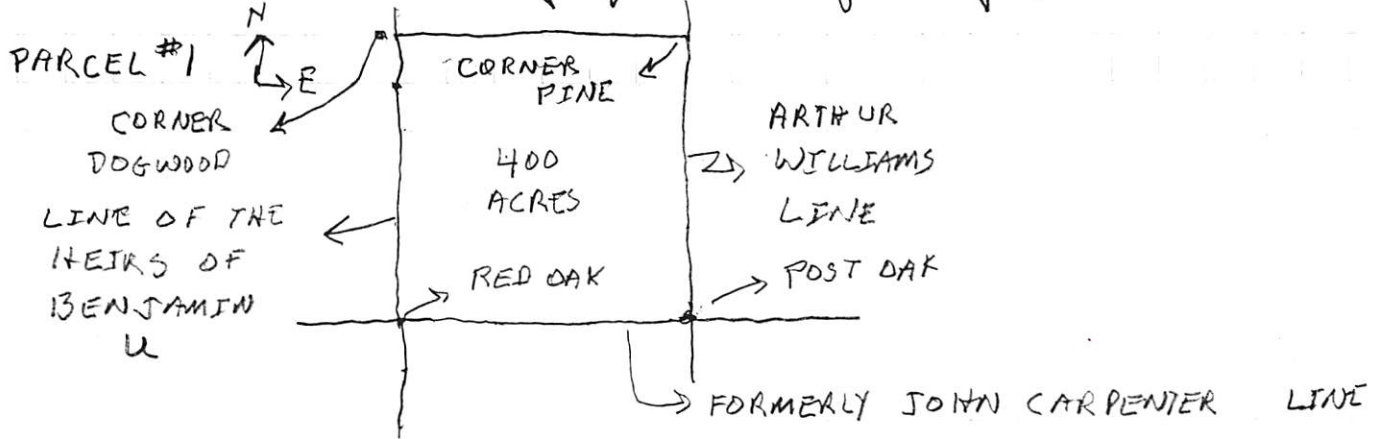

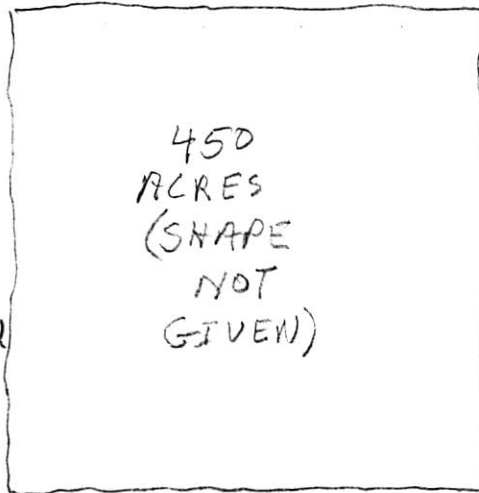

Henry b 1830 (NY) ^{d 20 MAY 1913} came to OH age 14. He was there when EDWIN
DRAKE struck oil (first time ever) & this led to Henry & John D. Rockefeller
& Cleveland Refinery Owners, creating the Standard Oil Company. They
were the first Robber Barons & had the first modern company.
They gobbled up companies worldwide & Henry did the dirty work
& John was the front man. In 1881 Henry withdrew to seek
other challenges. About then his 1st wife Mary Harkness died of TB
& partly of his neglect. He & she had met FL in the 1870's and
