## Haseltine Upchurch XID – 105

**Commentary:** Haseltine Upchurch was born in 1839 to Gilbert and Lucretia Mills Upchurch. She was, in turn, the granddaughter of Nathan I, the head of Upchurch Clan #3. She lived her entire life in Wake County, NC, dying there of consumption in Mar 1862.

(1) Hasseltine Upchurch was daughter of Gilbert and Lucretia Upchurch. 1850 Census records in hands of Ada Morgan show her to be 12 years old on the day of census taking 17 Aug 1850 (hence born  $1838 \pm 1$ ). At the time she was at home with mother, father having deceased.

Haseltine Upchurch age 20, female – is in home headed by her mother Lucretia Upchurch age 59. Bartley Jefferson Upchurch is also in the home.

Haseltine Upchurch age 12 M (must be female - RPU) is in home headed by her mother Creecy (Lucretia) Upchurch age 46 F.

Of consumption, at the residence of her mother in Wake County, on the 5th inst., Miss HASLETINE UPCHURCH, in the 28d year of her age. She had been an acceptable member of the Baptist Church for several years, and was consistent in her profession. She bore her long illness with fortitude and when death came fell asleep in the arms of Jesus.
